**N**SEIT, the IT-services focused subsidiary of the National Stock Exchange, said on Friday it has acquired Aujas Networks Ltd, which provides information security consulting and IT risk management services.

Founded in 2008, Aujas has operations in India, West Asia and North America. It employs about 400 cybersecurity professionals and has over 390 customers globally. The service portfolio includes information risk advisory, identity and access management, threat management and security analytics.

NSEIT currently provides technology solutions across industries such as capital markets, financial markets, banking and insurance.

According to data from Crunchbase, Aujas has raised \$11 million since 2008 from a slew of early stage venture capital funds in India.

Aujas last raised \$5.4 million from the 3 investors in 2013.

Sameer Shelke, chief executive officer, Aujas said, “Aujas is now a significant company in the cybersecurity market, working with organizations globally to build and transform their security strategies and controls.”
