Presently, KSHEC is engaged in implementation of National Education Policy 2020 in the space of higher education. Developing collaborations between HEIs of the state of Karnataka and organisations including professional bodies to enrich the HEI ecosystem of the state vibrant and relevant to the needs of the stakeholders is another important dimension of KSHEC functioning.

A workbook in Kannada language on 'Financial Education and Investment Awareness' was launched in Bengaluru by Karnataka Governor Thawarchand Gehlot and NSE MD and CEO Ashish Kumar Chauhan.

NSE Academy has tied up with Karnataka State Council of Higher Education to bring skills related to financial management to the young generation of Karnataka.
