Sub: Introduction of API Facility in NMASS-Margins-FO

On receipt of the request from members, NSE Clearing shall enable the super admin for API access management in NMASS. The super admin shall then follow the procedure for API registration as specified in the user manual on API access management provided below.

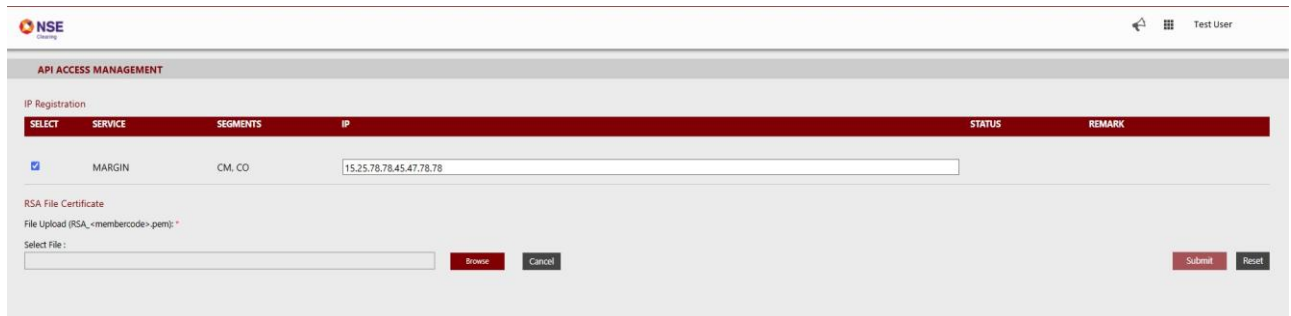

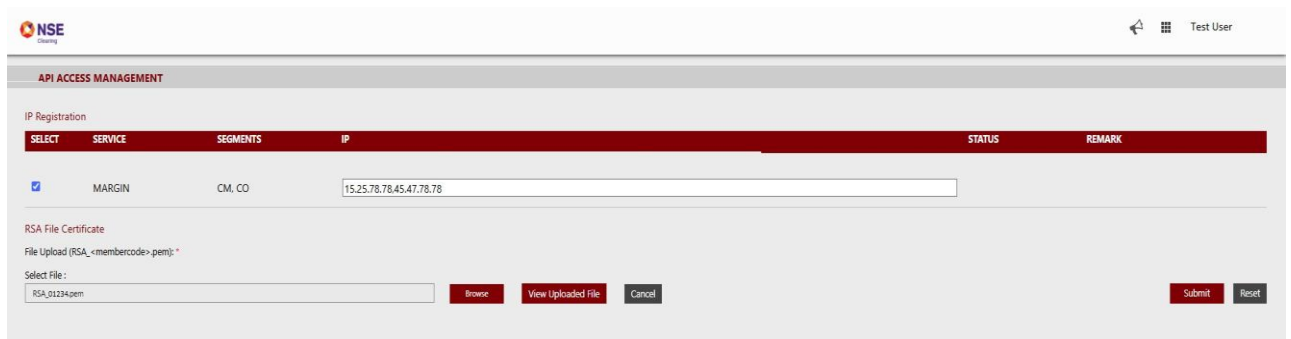
USER MANUAL FOR MEMBERS

INFORMATION REGARDING API ACCESS MANAGEMENT

1. The super admin of the members shall be provided with access to 'API ACCESS MANAGEMENT' menu on NMASS for API registration.
 - i. 'API ACCESS MANAGEMENT' screen will display the service name, list of eligible segments, IP field and RSA File Certificate.
 - ii. On selection of service, members will be required to provide the list of IPs in comma separated format and RSA certificate through file upload.
 - a. Members will be allowed to register maximum twenty-five nos. of IPs to call the API end point.
 - b. Members will have to upload the RSA '.pem' certificate for encryption. The file nomenclature of '.pem' certificate is "RSA_<membercode>.pem"

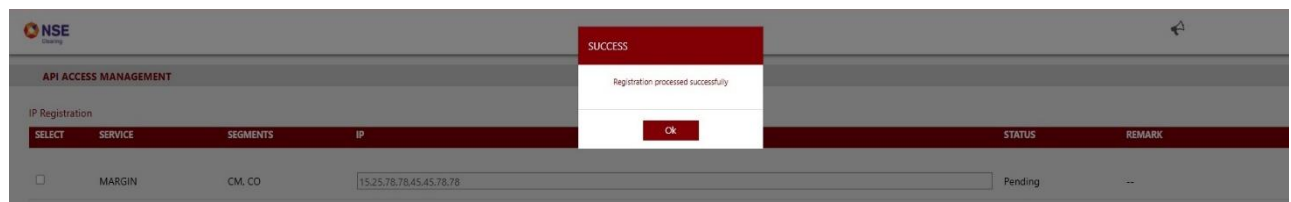

Such request will be subject to NCL approval. On approval, mail will be sent to the registered email address of super admin providing details of Username (Consumer Key) and Password (Consumer Secret).

3. Members shall be permitted to update the existing list of IP addresses as well as the '.pem' certificate. The system shall always maintain a consolidated list. When modifications are made, the previously registered IP addresses and certificates shall be replaced with the updated IP list and certificate. This functionality allows for the updating of both IP addresses and certificates as and when required.
4. Member can also download the uploaded '.pem' file through 'View Uploaded File' button.
