Sub: Notice of the proposed offer for sale of the equity shares of face value of Rs. 5 each (“Equity Shares”) of HDFC Asset Management Company Limited (the “Company”) by one of its promoters, Standard Life Investments Limited (the “Seller”, and this notice, the “Notice”)

Dear Sirs,

We hereby notify that the Seller proposes to sell up to 6,000,000 Equity Shares (representing approximately 2.82% of the total issued and paid-up Equity Share capital of the Company) (“**Base Offer Size**”) on June 17, 2020 (“**T Day**”) (for non-retail investors only) and on June 18, 2020 (“**T+1 Day**”) (for retail investors and for non-retail investors who choose to carry forward their un-allotted bids), with an option to additionally sell up to 6,000,000 Equity Shares (representing approximately 2.82% of the total issued and paid-up Equity Share capital of the Company) (the “**Oversubscription Option**” and in the event the Oversubscription Option is exercised, the Equity Shares forming part of the Base Offer Size and the Oversubscription Option will, collectively, hereinafter be referred to as the “**Sale Shares**”, but in the event the Oversubscription Option is not exercised, the Equity Shares forming part of the Base Offer Size will hereinafter be referred to as the “**Sale Shares**”), through a separate, designated window of BSE Limited (“**BSE**”) and National Stock Exchange of India Limited (“**NSE**” and together with BSE, the “**Stock Exchanges**”), and in accordance with:

- a) the “Comprehensive Guidelines on Offer for Sale (OFS) of Shares by Promoters through the Stock Exchange Mechanism” issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (the “**SEBI**”) through its circular no. CIR/MRD/DP/04/2013 dated January 25, 2013, CIR/MRD/DP/17/2013 dated May 30, 2013, CIR/MRD/DP/24/2014 dated August 8, 2014, CIR/MRD/DP/32/2014 dated December 1 2014, CIR/MRD/DP/12/2015 dated June 26, 2015, CIR/MRD/DP/36/2016 dated February 15, 2016, CIR/MRD/DP/65/2017 dated June 27, 2017 and SEBI/HO/MRD/DOPI/CIR/P/2018/159 dated December 28, 2018 (the “**OFS Circular**”), and section 21 of chapter 1 of the “Master Circular for Stock Exchange and Clearing Corporation” issued by the SEBI through its circular no. The Sale shall be undertaken exclusively through the Seller’s Broker (named below).

The Sale is being undertaken by the Seller primarily for achieving the minimum public shareholding in the Company, as prescribed under Rules 19(2)(b) read with 19(A) of the Securities Contracts (Regulation) Rules, 1957 and Regulation 38 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.
