- Members using direct connection via NNF may note that existing broadcast parameters shall be discontinued from September 06, 2025 (circular reference [NSE/MSD/69328](#)). Accordingly, they shall plan to migrate to new market data broadcast parameters on priority if still using existing broadcast parameters.

Particulars	Details
<b>Connectivity Parameters:</b>	Refer to circular NSE/MSD/67674 dated April 24, 2025 for interactive connectivity details.
<b>Installation Guide:</b>	Available on NSE Extranet at /faoftp/faocommon/Installation_Procedure.
<b>Software Version:</b>	Ensure migration to latest version of NEAT+ 7.8.3 before discontinuation of old Version 7.8.2 which is September 06, 2025.
<b>Order Purge:</b>	All outstanding orders will be cleared before each session. Members using NNF software must manually clear orders in their systems.
<b>Software Testing:</b>	Refer to circular NSE/MSD/46441 and SEBI circular SEBI/HO/MRD1/DSAP/CIR/P/2020/234. Members may use either Mock Trading or Simulated Environment to meet regulatory requirements.
<b>No Financial Obligation:</b>	Trades during mock sessions will not result in any fund pay-in or pay-out.
<b>UCC/PAN Validity:</b>	Only valid and compliant UCC/PAN uploaded and approved before cutoff will be allowed. For queries, contact uci@nse.co.in. UCC Validation will be skipped during contingency time for order entry.
<b>NOTIS Availability:</b>	The NOTIS application will not be accessible during the mock session.
<b>Extranet / Member portal availability</b>	Connect2NSE and Extranet facility shall remain available.
<b>Participation:</b>	Members should participate using all trading software and re-login into live environment to ensure smooth connectivity for Monday, September 01, 2025.

## Annexure – 2

### Pre-requisites / General guidelines for participating in the Mock environment

Pre-requisites / General guidelines Heads	Details
<b>Eligibility</b>	All members enabled for trading in the Futures & Options (FO) segment in the live market are automatically eligible for mock trading. Participation is enabled using existing User IDs, IPs, and Box ID mappings from the live environment.
<b>Telnet Connectivity</b>	Ensure you can successfully <b>telnet the Exchange host</b> from the IP address you intend to use.
<b>Box ID Setup</b>	Confirm that the <b>Box ID</b> is created on the IP with appropriate messages for the segment you wish to trade in.
<b>NNF Application Users</b>	If using Non-NEAT Frontend (NNF): a) User ID must be of dealer type. b) It must be converted for NNF. c) It must be mapped with the IP.
<b>Branch/User Limits</b>	Set appropriate branch and user limits from the Corporate Manager Terminal before placing orders in the mock session.
<b>Exchange Requests for Mock Participation</b>	Send email requests for the following actions with User ID and segment details: a) Pro Enablement b) CTCL Conversion (only dealer IDs) c) Password Reset for Corporate Manager User ID d) Unlocking of Corporate Manager User ID e) Change of Trading Rights (e.g., PRO to CLI, PRO+CLI)
<b>Password Management</b>	Corporate Manager User ID: Exchange will assist with reset/unlock via email. Other User IDs: Members must reset/unlock these themselves using the Corporate Manager Terminal.
