Advisory – Review of existing Non-Neat Frontend (NNF) products

This is in continuation to Exchange consolidated circular NSE/MSD/57331 dated June 28, 2023, with respect to Non-Neat Frontend (NNF) Facility and circular NSE/MSD/58387 dated September 14, 2023, with respect to Revision in fees/charges for Empaneled Vendors providing NNF facility.

Members developing Non-NEAT Frontend (NNF) software / application i.e. CTCL / IBT / STWT / DMA / Algo etc. through In-house vendors or procured software from Empaneled vendors are required to test the software in Mock/Simulation environment of the Exchange as applicable and register the same with the Exchange prior to deployment in production environment. Further members are required to ensure that their applications are rigorously tested on regular basis in Mock/Simulation environment of the Exchange.

The Software applications may be subjected to updates/changes over a period, for which members should register the newer/latest versions of NNF application by submitting relevant request to the Exchange as per captioned circular.

Further it has been brought to the attention of Exchange by Empaneled vendors that members have not yet surrendered NNF applications registered with the Exchange even after the contracts have ended / licenses discontinued with the said vendors.

Exchange strongly recommends all Trading members to review their existing NNF applications (CTCL / IBT / STWT / DMA / Algo etc.) registered with the Exchange and identify the software that are obsolete, not in use, **software's running on old version number**, support not available etc. as per their business requirement and consider surrendering their old NNF software/s which are not in use through the online portal of the Exchange.

Facility for the same is provided by Exchange under the following path:

**'ENIT-NEW-TRADE' > Trade > NNF Surrender > Surrender Request.**
