To All Members,

Sub: Connectivity - POP network changes.

As per circular NSE/MSD/69495 dated August 05, 2025, the Exchange notified its members that the existing POP facilities provided by Sify at STT Ultadanga – Kolkata, Jivan Vihar – Delhi, and Kohinoor – Mumbai will be phased out and transitioned to new Sify POP locations for both managed and self-service connectivity links.

Members are strongly advised to adhere to the migration timelines specified below:

Existing POP	New POP	Timeline for Migration	Existing POP discontinuation Date
STT Kolkatta	SIFY KOL	120 Days from the effective date of Circular i.e. August 11, 2025	09-Dec-2025
JIVAN VIHAR	SIFY OKHLA	120 Days from the effective date of Circular i.e. August 11, 2025	09-Dec-2025
MUMBAI-KURLA	SIFY PARLE	180 Days from the effective date of Circular i.e. August 11, 2025	07-Feb-2026

As outlined in the circular, Sify will coordinate directly with members who have subscribed connectivity under “Managed Service” to execute the migration of Lease Lines connectivity to the new POPs.

It is re-iterated that Members who have subscribed links under “Self-Service” model from Existing POP’s referred above are required to take note of following and ensure completion of the migration of the links by the aforesaid Existing POP discontinuation dates to have continued connectivity to Exchange for trading.

Self Service Members:

- Self Service members will have to inform respective service providers about shifting to new POP’s.
- In case of any shifting cost change to new POP it will have to be borne by Self Service member.
- Shifting must be completed within the Migration timeline shared in the above table.

- Once link is ready to be shifted to new POP, member should get in touch with Sify NOC/Migration team for activity execution with 72 hours advance notification.

All members are urged to kindly cooperate with the TNI and expedite migration at the earliest as connectivity from the aforesaid existing POP's will be discontinued on the respective discontinuation dates.
