To All Members,

### Sub: Connectivity - POP network changes – Final Extension

As per circular NSE/MSD/69495 dated August 05, 2025, the Exchange notified its members that the existing POP facilities provided by Sify at Kohinoor–Kurla will be phased out and transitioned to new Sify POP locations for both managed and self-service connectivity links. Members were advised to undertake the necessary migration activities to ensure seamless and uninterrupted connectivity to the Exchange.

Subsequent to the above, based on requests received from members and feedback from the Telecom Network Integrator (TNI), the Exchange provided multiple extensions to facilitate completion of migration activities and ensure a smooth transition to the new POP.

In continuation to circular NSE/MSD/74468 dated May 29, 2026, along with all prior circulars referred to therein after, members were informed that the migration of Lease Line connectivity to the new POP was required to be completed by June 08, 2026, after which the existing POP at Kohinoor–Kurla, Mumbai was scheduled to be discontinued.

As confirmed by the Telecom Network Integrator (TNI), substantial progress has been achieved in the migration of self-service connectivity links subscribed by members to the aforesaid POP. However, considering the pending migrations and with a view to facilitating completion of the same, the timeline for migration of self-service links is being extended for the final time up to EOD of June 15, 2026.

After this date, the existing POP, as detailed below, will be discontinued by TNI.

**It is re-iterated that Members who have subscribed links under “Self-Service” model from Existing POP referred above are required to take note and ensure completion of the migration of the links by the aforesaid final date to have continued connectivity to Exchange for trading.**

**No further extension shall be granted beyond June 15, 2026, and the existing POP shall be discontinued by TNI thereafter. Members failing to complete migration by the stipulated date may experience disruption in connectivities pending migration to the Exchange. Members with pending links are required to plan accordingly.**
