ट्रंप शुल्क के दबाव में लड़खड़ाया शेयर बाजार

निवेशकों को दो दिनों में 9.69 लाख करोड़ की चपत

शेयर बाजार में पिछले दो कारोबारी सत्रों की गिरावट से निवेशकों को कुल 9.69 लाख करोड़ रुपए का नुकसान उठाना पड़ा है। इन दो दिनों में ही सूचकांक 1,555 अंक टूट चुका है। अमेरिका द्वारा भारत पर लगाया गया 25 फीसद अतिरिक्त शुल्क बुधवार से लागू हो गया। इससे कुल मिलाकर भारत पर अमेरिकी शुल्क बढ़कर 50 फीसद हो चुका है।

हीरा पालिश उद्योग के राजस्व में 30 फीसद गिरावट की आशंका

मुंबई, 28 अगस्त (भाषा)।

अमेरिका के भारतीय निर्यात पर 50 फीसद का भारी शुल्क लगाए जाने के कारण देश के प्राकृतिक हीरा पालिश उद्योग का चालू वित्त वर्ष में राजस्व 28 से 30 फीसद कम होकर 12.50 अरब डालर तक आने का अनुमान है। गुरुवार को जारी एक रपट में यह अनुमान लगाया गया। अमेरिका के राष्ट्रपति डोनाल्ड ट्रंप का रूसी तेल की खरीद के लिए भारत पर लगाया गया 25 फीसद अतिरिक्त शुल्क बुधवार से प्रभावी हो गया। भारत पर अमेरिका द्वारा लगाया गया कुल शुल्क अब 50 फीसद हो गया है। क्रिसलर रेंटैरिस की एक रपट के अनुसार, वित्त वर्ष 2024–25 के दौरान भारत में प्राकृतिक हीरा पालिश उद्योग का राजस्व लगभग 16 अरब डालर था। पिछले तीन

वित्त वर्षों में प्राकृतिक हीरों की कीमतों और बिक्री की मात्रा में 40 फीसद की गिरावट के बाद यह झटका आया है, क्योंकि अमेरिका और चीन में मांग कम हो गई है और प्रयोगशाला में विकसित हीरों से प्रतिस्पर्धा बढ़ गई है। रपट में बताया गया कि इस हफ्ते से लागू हुए 50 फीसद शुल्क की वजह से अमेरिका को निर्यात करना मुश्किल हो गया है। इसके दो कारण हैं—पहला, हीरा उद्योग का मुनाफा कम होने की वजह से ये अतिरिक्त शुल्क देना बहुत कठिन है और दूसरा, मांग कम होने की वजह से ये शुल्क सीधे ग्राहक पर डालना भी आसान नहीं होगा। रपट के अनुसार, इसके परिणामस्वरूप परिचालन क्षमता कम हो सकती है, जिससे हीरा पालिश से जुड़ी इकाइयों के लाभ में 0.5 से एक फीसद तक की गिरावट आ सकती है।

नैनीताल में आग लगने से ओल्ड लंदन हाउस राख, वृद्धा की मौत

उत्तराखंड के नैनीताल में डेढ़ सौ साल से ज्यादा पुराने ‘ओल्ड लंदन हाउस’ में भीषण आग लगने के कारण झुलसकर एक बुजुर्ग महिला की मौत हो गई। पुलिस ने यह जानकारी दी। घटना में जान गंवाने वाली महिला प्रसिद्ध इतिहासकार और पर्यावरणविद अजय रावत की बहन थीं।

पुलिस ने बताया कि मल्लीताल क्षेत्र में मोहनको चौहाट पर स्थित इस इमारत में बुधवार रात आग लग गयी जिस पर अग्निशमन सेवा, पुलिस, वायुसेना फायर टेंडर एवं अन्य बचाव दलों की मदद से कई घंटे बाद रात करीब दो बजे काबू पाया जा सका। घनी आबादी वाले क्षेत्र में

लगी आग पर नियंत्रण करने के लिए बचाव एवं राहत अभियान में विभिन्न एजंसियों के 40 से अधिक कर्मी जुटे रहे। घटना की सूचना मिलते ही कुमाऊँ की पुलिस महानिरीक्षक रिद्धिम अग्रवाल और नैनीताल के वरिष्ठ पुलिस अधीक्षक प्र’द्वारा नारायण मीणा भी मौके पर पहुंचे और बचाव अभियान की निगरानी की।

रावत ने बताया कि उनकी 82 वर्षीय बहन शांता बिष्ट की आग में झुलसकर मृत्यु हो गई है। इमारत के पास ही अपनी मोबाइल फोन की दुकान के मालिक विनोद कुमार वर्मा ने बताया कि उन्होंने रात करीब 10 बजे धुआँ निकलते देखा जिसके तुरंत बाद आग की लपटें दिखाई देने लगीं। उन्होंने तत्काल अग्निशमन विभाग को सूचना दी, और आग बुझाने का प्रयास किया गया।

निर्माण क्षेत्र में एआइ का प्रयोग करेगा सड़क परिवहन मंत्रालय

नई दिल्ली, 28 अगस्त।

देश में बनने वाले राजमार्ग के लिए केंद्र सरकार कृत्रिम बुद्धिमत्ता (एआइ) की मदद लेगी। केंद्र सरकार ने व्यवस्था को प्रभावी तौर पर लागू करने के लिए एक विशेष सेल बनाने का निर्णय लिया है। यह सेल मार्ग व परियोजनाओं से संबंधित एआइ तकनीक को स्थापित करने की दिशा में काम करेगा।

इससे सड़क परिवहन मंत्रालय को सड़कों व अन्य परियोजनाओं में आने वाली तकनीकी परेशानियों का पहले ही पता चल सकेगा और उनका हल निकाला जा सकेगा।

माना जा रहा है कि इससे आम जनता के लिए केंद्र सरकार की परियोजनाओं को जमीनी स्तर पर तेजी से लागू किया जा सकेगा। इस सेल के लिए मंत्रालय को संबंधित क्षेत्र के विशेषज्ञों की जरूरत होगी। इसके लिए इस क्षेत्र के पुराने सक्रिय विशेषज्ञों को इस टीम से जोड़ा जाएगा ताकि वे नई टीम को अपने अनुभव के आधार पर सलाह दे सकें।

मंत्रालय ने इसकी प्रक्रिया शुरू कर दी है और तीन अधिकारियों को इस क्षेत्र के लिए नियुक्त किया है। यह टीम किसी भी निर्माण की योजना और प्रारूप तक के काम में संबंधित एजेंसी की मदद करेगी। इसके अतिरिक्त व्यवस्तम मार्ग पर चल रहे निर्माण कार्य में यातायात के संचालन की भी रूपरेखा को अपनी कार्य योजना से जोड़ेगी।

ताकि किसी भी मार्ग का प्रयोग करने वाले वाहन चालकों को जाम या अन्य परेशानियां से जूझना नहीं पड़े। यह मंत्रालय की नई पहल है, इसलिए इस यूनिट के लिए जल्द ही मंत्रालय के विशेषज्ञों के साथ इनका प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम भी शुरू किया जाएगा। निर्माण संबंधित योजनाओं के अतिरिक्त इस सेल के पास मंत्रालय से संबंधित योजनाओं के आंकड़े एकत्र करने का

यह पहल सड़क मार्ग को लेकर लगातार बढ़ती जा रही मांग को तेजी से पूर्ण करने के लिए की गई है। परियोजना के बीच में आने वाले निर्माण, पेड़, या अन्य कारणों की वजह से होने वाली देरी का आसानी से पता चल जाएगा, इससे संबंधित विभाग की विभिन्न मंजूरियों को लेने की प्रक्रिया में बर्बाद होने वाले समय की भी बचत होगी और कार्य बिना रोकटोक के तय समय सीमा में पूर्ण किया जा सकेगा।

केंद्र सरकार का लक्ष्य है कि देश में इस वित्तीय वर्ष में करीब दस हजार किलोमीटर मार्ग का निर्माण किया जाएगा। हाल ही में केंद्रीय परिवहन मंत्री नितिन गडकरी ने लोकसभा में एक लिखित सवाल में यह जानकारी दी थी कि 1240 राजमार्ग संबंधित परियोजनाएँ हैं, जिनकी लंबाई 29406 किलोमीटर है।

इन परियोजनाओं को करीब 7.80 लाख करोड़ रुपए खर्च करके तैयार किया जा रहा है। इनमें से अब तक 15674 किलोमीटर का काम पूर्ण किया जा चुका है।

ट्रंप शुल्क के दबाव में लड़खड़ाया शेयर बाजार

निर्यातकों को राहत देने पर काम, जल्द व्यापार वार्ता की उम्मीद

नई दिल्ली, 28 अगस्त।

अमेरिका में भारतीय वस्तुओं के आयात पर 50 फीसद का भारी शुल्क लगाए जाने से परेशान निर्यातकों को राहत देने के लिए केंद्र सरकार कई उपायों पर काम कर रही है। इनमें निर्यात संवर्धन मिशन की शुरुआत, ऋण लौटाने को लेकर मोहलत और नकदी से जुड़ी मदद शामिल हैं। एक वरिष्ठ सरकारी अधिकारी ने गुरुवार को यह जानकारी दी।

अधिकारी ने कहा कि अमेरिका का भारतीय वस्तुओं पर लगाया गया ऊंचा शुल्क देश के लिए एक चेतावनी होने के साथ निर्यात में विविधता लाने का एक अवसर भी है। इस संदर्भ में निर्यातकों की तरफ से की गई अपीलों पर उन्होंने कहा, ‘सरकार निर्यातकों की समस्याओं से पूरी तरह अवगत है और उन्हें राहत देने के लिए ठोस प्रयास किए जा रहें हैं।’ अमेरिका ने 27 अगस्त से भारतीय उत्पादों पर कुल 50 फीसद शुल्क

लगाना शुरू कर दिया है। इसमें रूस से तेल खरीद जारी रखने के जुमाने के तौर पर लगाया गया 25 फीसद अतिरिक्त शुल्क भी शामिल है। यह फैसला भारत पर दबाव बनाने की अमेरिकी कोशिश के रूप में देखा जा रहा है। इससे मशीनरी, इीगा, वस्त्र, चमड़ा-फुटवियर और रब एवं आभूषण जैसे श्रम-प्रधान क्षेत्रों के निर्यात पर गहरा असर पड़ने की आशंका है।

सरकार अब सूक्ष्म, लघु एवं मध्यम उद्यमों (एमएसएमई) से जुड़े निर्यातकों के लिए आपातकालीन ऋण गारंटी योजना, ऋण पर एक साल तक की मोहलत और निर्यात भुगतान की समय-सीमा बढ़ाने जैसे कदम उठाने पर विचार कर रही है, ताकि नकदी प्रवाह की समस्या को हल किया जा सके। सरकार ई-कामर्स निर्यात हब योजना को भी तेजी से लागू करने की दिशा में प्रयास कर रही है। बजट में घोषित निर्यात संवर्धन मिशन को 2025 से 2031 तक छह वर्षों के लिए लागू करने की योजना है जिसके तहत करीब 25,000 करोड़ के समर्थन उपाय प्रस्तावित हैं।

भारत को 2.5 अरब डालर का शुद्ध वार्षिक लाभ

नई दिल्ली, 28 अगस्त (भाषा)।

रूस से रियायती दर पर कच्चा तेल आयात करने से भारत को होने वाला वार्षिक शुद्ध लाभ महज 2.5 अरब डालर है, जो पहले जताए गए 10 से 25 अरब डालर के अनुमान से बहुत कम है। एक शोध रपट में यह आकलन पेश किया गया है।

ब्रोकरेज कंपनी सीएलएसए की गुरुवार को जारी रपट के मुताबिक, ‘रूसी कच्चे तेल के आयात से भारत को होने वाला लाभ मीडिया में बढ़ा-चढ़ाकर बताया गया है। हमारे अनुमान के मुताबिक, यह लाभ भारत के सकल घरेलू उत्पाद (जीडीपी) का सिर्फ 0.06 फीसद यानी करीब 2.5 अरब डालर है।’ फरवरी, 2022 में रूस-यूक्रेन युद्ध शुरू होने के बाद भारत ने रूस से
