

# Ladakh protests: Wangchuk arrested, slapped with NSA

Being made a scapegoat, says activist; mobile internet snapped in Leh

Climate activist Sonam Wangchuk was arrested Friday and slapped with the stringent National Security Act (NSA), two days after violent protests over statehood and constitutional protection left four persons dead and 90 injured in the Union Territory of Ladakh, officials said.

Police have shifted Wangchuk out of Ladakh, while the Ladakh administration has snapped all mobile internet connections within the jurisdiction of Leh district as a precautionary measure, they said.

In a day of fast-paced developments, the arrest of Wangchuk was sudden. He was scheduled to address a press conference in Leh at 2:30 pm but when he failed to arrive, the organisers became concerned.

They soon found the reason — the climate activist had been arrested from his village Ulyaktopo by a strong team of Ladakh Police, led by Director General SD Singh Jamwal.

The administration also snapped mobile internet services in the Leh area as a precautionary measure.

Wangchuk, a leading voice for the Leh Apex Body (LAB) and the Kargil Democratic Alliance (KDA), has been spearheading the five-year-long agitation for statehood and constitutional safeguards for the residents of Leh and Kargil, which form part of the Ladakh Union Territory carved out from erstwhile state of Jammu and Kashmir in 2019.

The Centre has blamed him for inciting the recent violence but Wangchuk denied all the allegations.

“To say it was instigated by me is to find a scapegoat, rather than addressing the core of the problem, and this will lead us nowhere,” Wangchuk said on Thursday, adding that the violence was a symptom of frustrated youth.

The arrest came a day after the Union home ministry cancelled the FCRA licence of the Students' Educational and Cultural Movement of Ladakh (SECML), an organisation founded by Wangchuk, citing alleged financial discrepancies and a fund transfer deemed to be against “national interest”.

“He was treated like a criminal without any reason,” was an angry outburst from Gitanjali Angmo, the wife of Sonam Wangchuk. Angmo, who is also the co-founder of HIAL (Himalayan Institute of Alternatives, Ladakh), fiercely condemned her husband's detention and accused the government of spreading “false narratives” to tarnish his image.

She alleged that their house was “ransacked by the police” and alleged that Wangchuk was being unjustly portrayed as “anti-national”. “It is the worst form of democracy... without any trial, without any reason, they have just taken him like a criminal,” Angmo told PTI.

Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah on Friday said the arrest of Soman Wangchuk was unfortunate, and

accused the BJP-led NDA government of backtracking on its promises.

“This (Wangchuk's arrest) is unfortunate. The way the central government was after him since yesterday, it seemed they would do something like this,” Abdullah told reporters on the sidelines of the inaugural ceremony of the third Junior Asian Pencak Silat championship here.

“Promises were made with the people there... I don't understand what compulsions does the Central government have to backtrack after making promises,” he said.

On the other hand, Congress termed the arrest as “unwarranted” and blamed the administration of the Union territory for “mishandling” the situation.

“His arrest is unwarranted. There was no need to take this step; he is the most respectable person, who has always believed in Gandhian ideology. He dedicated himself for the interests of Ladakh,” All India Congress Committee (AICC) general secretary Ghulam Ahmad Mir told reporters in Anantnag. Mir said the Ladakh administration has mishandled the situation and should take its responsibility.

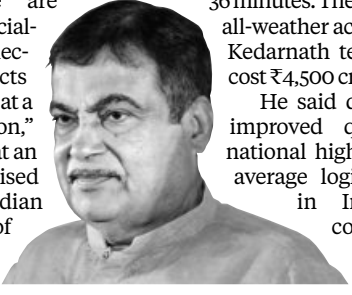
## Port connectivity projects worth ₹1 trn in the works: Gadkari

Work is in “full swing” at port connectivity projects that will draw investments worth ₹1 trillion by 2030 in coastal states, said Nitin Gadkari (*pictured*), minister for road transport and highways, on Friday.

Every ₹100 invested in roads and highways adds around ₹321 to the country's economy, he said. Better highways help the growth of smaller businesses and they also create jobs.

“Infrastructure is the backbone of our economy, and among the major infrastructure sector achievements. We are setting up specialised port connectivity projects over 2,700 km at a cost of ₹1 trillion,” Gadkari said at an event organised by the Indian Chamber of Commerce in New Delhi.



“We are setting up 25 green-field expressways with a length of 10,000 km and at a cost of ₹5 trillion. Similarly, many projects focusing on religious tourism are under construction which will attract investment of ₹1 trillion.”

He said the Delhi Decongestion Plan will lead to an investment of ₹1.4 trillion, of which work worth ₹1 trillion is already on. “We are also working on the Govindghat-Hemkund Sahib ropeway projects with a length of 12.4 km and costing ₹4,000 crore.”

The 12.9-km ropeway to connect Sonprayag and Kedarnath will reduce the travel time for a 9-hour trek to 36 minutes. The project for all-weather access to the Kedarnath temple will cost ₹4,500 crore.

He said due to the improved quality of national highways, the average logistics cost in India has come down by 5 per cent.

## Maha invites realty firms to develop 13K acres of MSRTC land

Maharashtra has invited real estate companies to develop commercial and residential premises on 13,000 acres owned by its bus corporation across the state. Land parcels of Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation (MSRTC) will be developed under public-private partnerships on a build-operate-transfer deal.

The government will issue about 150 tenders next month, said Pratap Sarnaik, transport minister and chairperson of MSRTC, at the fourth edition of ‘Homethon 2025’, a three-day property exhibition organised by Naredco Maharashtra in Mumbai on Friday.

The MSRTC owns land parcels in prime locations across the Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR), including Mumbai Central, Kurla, Vidyavihar, Borivali, Chinchbunder (South Mumbai), and Thane. It also has land parcels in Pune, including Swargate

and Sangvi, as well as in Nashik and Nagpur.

The minister said that the land lease period will be 98 years. “In order to develop these lands and the bus depots, the government has decided that these bus depots will be given on a long-term lease of 98 years by increasing the period from earlier 30 years. These ST Bus Depots will be developed as public-private partnerships on a build-operate-transfer deal.”

Developers will rent out commercial parts, including offices, hotels, shopping, and retail, while also building hospitals on district-level land parcels and facilities for MSRTC.

MSRTC will sanction development plans under one roof to facilitate approvals from various government entities. It will also build the capacities of its technical team.

Developers will be granted floor space index (FSI) according to the Unified Development Control and Promotion Regulations (UDCPR).

# Engaged with US over H-1B issue, hopeful they will relent: MEA

The ministry of external affairs (MEA) on Friday said India would remain engaged with the Donald Trump administration and the industry on the issue of H-1B visas, and impress upon all concerned that skilled talent mobility and exchanges have helped both countries. New Delhi is hopeful that the White House's increase in H-1B visa fee is still an evolving situation and the White House would relent upon some of the restrictions it has introduced.

“We have seen the notice by the US Department of Homeland Security regarding the proposed rulemaking. I understand that stakeholders, including the industry, have one month to provide their comments,” MEA spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said.

The MEA and India's Embassy in Washington have been in active touch with the US administration on the issue of H-1B visas, and the restrictions issued last week.

“This is still an evolving situation and we remain engaged at various levels,” Jaiswal said. He added, “Skilled talent mobility and exchanges have contributed enormously to technology development, innovation, economic growth, competitiveness and wealth creations in the US and India.”

### Talking points

The MEA also spoke about a number of other issues

- The MEA slammed Nato Secretary-General Mark Rutte for his remarks that PM Narendra Modi phoned Russian President Vladimir Putin
- Said the Jaishankar-Rubio meet focused on trade, tariffs; Piyush Goyal, Jamieson Greer also joined the two
- On deportations, MEA said 2,417 Indians have been deported from US since January



To a question about External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar's meeting with US Secretary of State Marco Rubio in New York on September 22, Jaiswal said the “focus of the discussion was on trade and tariffs”. Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal and US Trade Representative Jamieson Greer had joined the two, Jaiswal said, adding other aspects of the India-US ties were also discussed.

**Rutte's comment on Modi ‘careless’**  
Jaiswal also slammed Nato Secretary-General Mark Rutte's for his “factually incorrect”, “entirely baseless”, “speculative” and “careless” remarks that Prime Minister

Narendra Modi phoned Russian President Vladimir Putin and sought Moscow's strategy on Ukraine in view of the impact of Washington's punitive tariffs on India.

Jaiswal said that at no point has the PM spoken with President Putin in the manner suggested. “No such phone conversation has taken place,” he said. “We expect the leadership of an important institution like Nato to exercise greater responsibility and accuracy in public statements,” he said, adding that “speculative or careless” remarks that misrepresent Modi's engagements or suggest conversations that never occurred are “unacceptable”.

Rutte told CNN on the margins of the UN General Assembly in New York that US President Donald Trump's tariffs on India are having a “big impact” on Russia and New Delhi is on the phone with Putin. “And Narendra Modi is asking him to explain his strategy on Ukraine because India is being hit with tariffs,” he claimed.

On the issue of India's import of Russian oil, Jaiswal said India's energy imports are meant to ensure predictable and affordable energy costs to the Indian consumer. “India will continue taking all necessary measures to safeguard its national interests and economic security,” he said.

The MEA also shared that since January, 2,417 have been deported from the US. India stands against illegal migration and it wants to promote pathways for legal mobility of people, the MEA spokesperson said.
