## NSE records all-time high turnover in derivatives segment

The National Stock Exchange of India Limited today recorded an all time high volume of Rs.1051.79 crores in the derivatives segment.

The previous highest was Rs.1034.17 crores, recorded on January 7, 2002.

S&P CNX Nifty Futures recorded a volume of Rs.145.10 crores, S&P CNX Nifty Options a volume of Rs.24.44 crores whereas Options on Individual Securities recorded a volume of Rs.251.88 crores and Futures on Individual Securities a volume of Rs.630.37 crores.
