NSE records highest turnover in the Derivatives segment

The Exchange today recorded all-time high volume of trades in the derivatives segment viz. Rs. 201.15 crores. The previous highest turnover was Rs. 163.69 crores which was recorded on August 14, 2001.

S&P CNX Nifty futures recorded a volume of Rs. 100.61 crores. S&P CNX Nifty options recorded a volume of Rs. 19.99 crores and Options on individual securities recorded a volume of Rs. 80.55 crores.

The top 5 securities in which most options contracts were traded were SATYAMCOMP, RELIANCE, INFOSYSTCH, L&T and STROPTICAL.
