With reference to the captioned subject, we would like to inform you that the Company has received an order from the Office of the Principal Commissioner of Customs, Bangalore, imposing a penalty amounting to Rs. 8,01,26,745/- (Rupees Eight crore one lakh twenty-six thousand seven hundred forty-five) and Redemption fine of Rs.9,00,00,000/- (Rupees Nine Crore) under section 28(4) and 125 respectively of the Customs Act, 1962.

Based on the Company's assessment, an appeal will be filed against the said order, and the Company is hopeful of a favourable outcome at the appellate level and does not reasonably expect the said Order to have any material impact on the Company.

The Order dated 23.02.2026 has been received by the Company on February 23, 2026, 1:20 PM.
