GUN LICENCE 'SCAM'

After sanction from Govt, &K revenue secy to face trial

Comes after J&K HC's criticism of 'selective prosecution' in the case

ARUN SHARMA JAMMU, DECEMBER 31 The CENTRAL government has allowed the CBI to prosecute B&K Revenue Secretary Kumar Rajeev Ranjan for alleged irregularities in granting gun licences, making him the first IAS officer against whom a prosecution sanction has been granted in the case.

According to sources, the case to prosecute the IAS officer was granted through an order dated November 28, 2024, in a case registered by CBI under Prevention of Corruption Act, 2006.

The CBI is probing irregularities in granting over 7.74 lakh gun licences between 2012 and 2016 — when J&K was still a state — by district magistrates (DMs), deputy commissioners and other enforcement authorities for "monetary considerations". Sources estimate the alleged scam to run into more than ₹100 crore.

In October, the CBI told the court it was still awaiting prosecution sanction against 16 erstwhile District Magistrates (13 IAS officers and three KAs officers) who, during their posting in different districts of the erstwhile J&K state, had issued gun licences "illegally" to "ineligible people" across the country.

Moradabad district admin reopens temple shut 'since 1980 communal violence'

LAKHNAU, DECEMBER 31

THE MORADABAD district administration has reopened a century-old temple that had been shut since 1980, when communal violence erupted in the city.

Gauti Shankar Temple is situated in the Nagdani area. During restoration, the administration excavated the inner sanctum of the temple and claimed to have discovered some damaged idols of deities. Renovation work is underway and plans to reinstate the temple to its "original state".

the PM and Kerala CM have the same view. It is the CPI(M) stand that prompted the BJP to spit communal venom. The minister said the CPI(M) in Kerala had alleged that a communal Muslim alliance was behind her and her brother's victories. Two weeks ago, CPI(M) politburo member A Vijayaraghavan said in a party convention that without the support of the communal Muslim alliance, Rahul would not have reached Delhi (won the LS seat), referring to Priyanka's victory in Wagnad by-election. Vijayaraghavan said the worst extremist elements were in her procession.

The CPI(M) leader's reference to Wagnad went in line with the change in the approach of the

CP(M) after the LS polls, during which the party faced a backlash over its bid to woo minority voters.

In 2019, when Rahul won his first election in the Wagnad, the BJP national leadership had invited Pakistan. Before he fled the nominations at the time, green flags of Congress ally IUJM were seen flying alongside the tricolor. The then chief Minister Amit Shah had said: "When a procession is taken out, you cannot make out whether it is an India or a Pakistan procession."

In November this year, when Priyanka contested in Wagnad, CPI(M) raked up a controversy over Muslim voters in the seat. Vijayan then said she was contesting with support of Jamaat-e-Islami, which is not in favour of democratic system. The CM said the Jamaat-e-Islami stood for an "Islamic regime" and the "extremist section" was "trying to gain control over the IUJM."

raiganj, Amarnath Upadhyay, acted with malicious intent, and as part of a larger conspiracy, demolished the house on September 13, 2019, without issuing any notice or providing compensation.

Akash alleged that the action was taken in retaliation against a complaint he had filed earlier, highlighting irregularities in the construction of a 21-km stretch of NH-730, police said.

The case was lodged at the Kotwali police station in Maharaigaj Monday evening against 26 named and several unidentified persons. Apart from the DM, the persons named included an Additional DM, an Additional SP, engineers, private contractors, inspectors, and sub-inspectors.

Maharaigaj SP Somendra Meena said no arrests have been made so far. He also said the investigation was being transferred to the UP Police's Crime Branch, as directed by the court. The then DM Upadhyay is currently posted as Special Secretary in the UP Employment of Persons With Disabilities Department.

Akash, said, "The Supreme Court on November 6 directed an inquiry and disciplinary action against officials within a month. When the government failed to take action, I sent an email to Chief Secretary stating I would file a contempt plea. On Monday evening, the case was filed. I will wait for action and if no action is taken in 90 days, I will move the SC to transfer the probe to CBI."

EX-PRESIDENT ON WASHINGTON POST REPORT

No talk with me, India won't back any regime change move in Maldives: Nasheed

NEW DELHI, DECEMBER 31

HOURS AFTER a report in The Washington Post claimed that the Indian intelligence explored a plan with the Maldives Opposition to oust President Mohamed Muizzu following his election last year, Mohamed Nasheed, the island nation's former President, said he does not believe India will be willing to assist in a regime change and "never had any such conversation with me."

Citing a document titled 'Democratic Renewal Initiative', the Post claimed that the Maldivian Opposition proposed bringing 40 MPs, including those from Muizzu's own party, to vote to impeach him, and also paying 10 senior army and police officers. He claimed the plotters failed to gather enough votes to impeach Muizzu, and India did not pursue or finance an attempt to oust him.

Reached for comment, former President Nasheed told The Indian Express that India is the world's largest democracy and a society ruled by law. In a statement, Nasheed said, "I have had over 20 years of close association with all levels of Indian government and institutions. I find that India respects the other point of view when you are disagreeing. It does not dictate its perceptions and beliefs to other countries, political parties or political leaders. In my conversations with India I have found that it is India's view that strengthening

Madives democratic process, institutions and its economy is not only in the best interest of Maldives, but also in the interest of India. The Democratic (MDP) Party is the first democratic political party in the Maldives and the movement that brought democracy to the Maldives. Therefore, it is understandable that MDP enjoys a healthy relationship with India and MDP leadership might find it easy to make any manner and number of requests from India, but that is not to say that India will be willing to fulfill all MDP requests," he said.

In a post on X, Nasheed said he was not aware of any plans to overthrow Muizzu's administration, and accused some of always engaging in conspiracy theories. "India will not support such an action. They have always respected democracy in Maldives. India has never dictated ways on us," he wrote.

There was no response from the Maldives government — either the President's office or the Maldives High Commission in New Delhi — to requests for comment on the Post report. The Indian government too did not comment on the report. But sources in New Delhi rejected the report, calling it a "figment of imagination".
