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Meta to share details of child abuse cases with Indian agencies

AstaGuru opens new Southeast Asia home

In a first for any social media platform in India, Meta has agreed to share with Indian law enforcement agencies child sexual abuse cases and details of repeat offenders, senior government officials said.

A spokesperson for Meta confirmed the development and said that the details would be shared directly with the cybercrime division of the Indian Cybercrime Coordination Centre of the Ministry of Home Affairs.

"Details of accounts such as the name, email id associated with the account, the IP (internet protocol) address, and others will now be shared with law enforcement agencies, which will help track down offenders faster," an official said. Up until now, all US-headquartered social media platforms, including Meta, have shared instances of child sexual abuse material (CSAM) only with the National Centre for Missing & Exploited Children (NCMEC), a private US non-profit organisation. The NCMEC would then share the details of repeat offenders or others such online accounts with

the law enforcement agencies in their respective domains. Slow data sharing delayed critical CSAM investigations in India, leaving children unprotected while exploitation was actively happening, the official said.

"The details were two aspects to it. One that NCMEC is a private organisation. Therefore, it is unfair that a law enforcement agency has to wait for data and

information from a private organisation. Second, it is a US-based organisation that has little or no presence in India," the official added. Meta and all US-headquartered social media companies must report all instances of CSAM to NCMEC under the US Federal Law, failing which they face criminal liabilities, financial penalties, and loss of safe harbour provisions.

The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), led by Ashwini Vaishnaw, had raised this issue with Meta's Chief of Global Affairs Joel Kaplan, when the latter had flown down to New Delhi in August this year.

The government had summoned Kaplan to India after a video of Prime Minister Narendra Modi addressing students protesting the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (Net) question paper leak was inadvertently taken down from Facebook for more than five hours.

During meetings with Kaplan, MeitY asserted that CSAM instances and repeat offender details must be sent directly to Indian law enforcement for swift action, bypassing NCMEC routing delays.

The ambition is to widen the scope beyond artworks and collectibles from India alone. "Much as with London, we see an opportunity to bring in international works and cross-category collectibles here, while continuing to

champion South Asian art as a distinct and important category within that mix," Kwan said.

The auction model will, however, remain digital-first, giving collectors across the world equal access, regardless of geography, explained Aparna Batra, chief business officer, AstaGuru Auction House.

Acknowledging that collecting is a personal experience, and that people want to see, understand and engage with an artwork or object before they acquire it, Batra said, "As in India and London, Singapore will have a physical presence through previews, exhibitions, private viewings and events. The model is, therefore, deliberately hybrid: Physical access, digital execution and a global collector base."

The demand for Indian artists has come mostly from collectors within India. But galleries and auction houses have noticed a shift in recent

years: A growing interest among collectors from outside India.

"We are seeing this particularly at the top end of the market, where artists such as Husain, Raza and (FN) Souza are increasingly entering the global art narrative, rather than treating them as a separate regional story," Batra said.

The context around Indian artists is also changing. "International museums, galleries and exhibitions are placing Indian modern and contemporary artists within a broader global art narrative, rather than treating them as a separate regional story," Batra said.

"That naturally creates a new audience. 'We are still at an early stage compared with markets such as Chinese or Latin American art, but the direction is clear,' she added. Police to question Google over 500K fake Gmail IDs linked to bomb hoax

The Indian police will question Google over a lack of safeguards after smashing a criminal network that set up and managed more than 500,000 fake Gmail accounts to send hoax bomb threats to government offices, a police official told Reuters on Tuesday.

India is one of Google's largest markets by users, where the US tech giant is already under scrutiny after authorities found a pattern of criminals misusing its web development platform, Firebase, for financial scams.

Police in the western state of Gujarat broke up an email network this week that they described as sending "inter-state" bomb threats and arrested two individuals,

uncovering 513,847 Gmail IDs and passwords being used since 2022.

Reuters is the first to report that Google itself figures in the investigation. The scale of fake Gmail accounts in use is unprecedented, Vivek Bheja, a senior cybercrime official of the Gujarat police, told Reuters. "We will write to Google, ask them to make some policy changes so (safeguards) cannot be bypassed," Bheja said, adding that police planned to formally designate Google as a subject of the investigation soon. Google, owned by Alphabet Inc, did not immediately respond to a request for comment. It was not immediately clear what legal charges or penalties, if any, Google could face.

India's burgeoning cybercrime causes losses running

into more than \$2 billion a year from financial scams, and its law enforcement has increasingly tackled technology platforms seen to have been exploited to enable such crimes.

The Gujarat investigation began after a bomb threat email received by the state government on September 10, days ahead of the recent New Delhi summit of the Brics grouping.

It also threatened countries cooperating with India during the summit, police said in a statement.

The threats proved false, Bheja said, adding that one of those arrested was in contact with a buyer in Bangladesh who purchased batches of the accounts and paid partly in crypto currency to send the fake emails.

HC seeks reply from OpenAI on ANI's challenge

The Delhi High Court on Tuesday sought a response from OpenAI on a challenge by news agency Asian News International (ANI) to an order denying it internet protection in its copyright infringement suit against the ChatGPT maker.

A Division Bench of Justice Anvesh Jhingani and Justice Manmeet Prasad Singh Arora directed OpenAI to respond to

ANI's appeal and listed the matter for further hearing on December 5.

ANI, which became the first Indian media organisation to take OpenAI to court over alleged copyright infringement, had filed the suit in 2024. The news agency has accused OpenAI of using its copyrighted material without authorisation to train and operate ChatGPT.

The agency had sought an interim injunction restraining OpenAI from storing, reproducing, publishing or otherwise using ANI's copyrighted content.

Justice Anil Bansal, however, declined to grant the interim relief in July this year, observing that such an order would not be in the public interest.
