Natural Heritage. It won Silver Award in Access for the Differently Aabled - Age Travellers, Employees and Holiday Makers category. In order to make Madhya Pradesh green, the Bharatiya Janata Yuva Morcha (BJYM), an associate organisation of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), will organise a plantation fortnight from September 17 to October 2. Under this, 1 lakh 35 thousand saplings will be planted in three phases. This campaign will start on September 17. As it is the birthday of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and a target has been set to plant 45,000 saplings on this day in the second phase also 45,000 saplings will be planted. This phase will take place on September 25, as it is the birth anniversary of one of the founding members of Jana Sangh, Pt Deendayal Upadhyay. The third phase of the plantation will be carried out on October 2

that is Gandhi Jayanti. Application software has been developed for the plantation campaign at the state level, in which photos will have to be uploaded after planting saplings. Along with planting saplings, an oath will also have to be taken to facilitate the plant to grow. With the help of the Ujjain Municipal Corporation, these saplings will be made available to the common man. BJP city president Vivek Joshi on Wednesday told media that from September 17 to November 26, a contact campaign would also be conducted in the settlements and camps would be set up in each ward. Efforts will be made to provide benefits of government schemes to the beneficiaries through the camp. Mayor Mukesh Tatwal was also present during the press conference.
