Hegseth hails India's...

Outlining the US Indo-Pacific strategy, he said Washington seeks "a genuinely stable equilibrium" and a durable balance of power in the region where no country, including China, can impose its hegemony.

Hegseth assured regional partners of continued US engagement despite challenges in other parts of the world, including West Asia. He also called for greater burden-sharing among allies, saying the era of the United States subsidising the defence of wealthy nations was over.

Hails pak's diplomatic...

Hegseth said an "unexpected development and a true friendship" was emerging between the United States and Pakistan. He added that the improving relationship was reflected in President Donald Trump's efforts to help ease tensions between India and Pakistan during their military confrontation last year. The US defence chief also acknowledged Pakistan's involvement in facilitating discussions between Washington and Tehran, describing the evolving partnership as a significant development, PTI reported.

CBI to recreate...

The dummy will reportedly be suspended in a manner similar to the circumstances described by the accused, allowing investigators to assess how the body could have been brought down and what the scene may have looked like at the time of the incident.

During the exercise, Giribala Singh may be asked to demonstrate how she allegedly loosened or un-tied the ligature (gymnast belt), while Samarth Singh will be asked to explain how he supported and lowered the body. The CBI is also expected to examine the strength and load-bearing capacity of the ligature material used in the incident. The reconstruction could help CBI officials determine whether the events described by the accused align with forensic findings and the physical conditions at the scene. The exercise is also expected to provide insights into whether the belt could have supported the weight and whether the actions described by the accused were consistent with the evidence.

Box: Doctors summoned to probe pregnancy termination, mental health aspects- The CBI has also issued summons to the doctor who allegedly advised Twisha Sharma to undergo a Medical Termination of Pregnancy (MTP) and to the psychiatrist who was treating her. Investigators are expected to examine the circumstances under which Twisha Sharma terminated her pregnancy and whether the decision was taken voluntarily or under any form of pressure.

The agency is also likely to question psychiatrist Dr Satyakant Trivedi regarding Twisha Sharma's mental health condition, the nature of the psychological issues she was facing, and the treatment she was receiving. Sources indicate that statements from both medical professionals could provide crucial leads in the investigation and may help the CBI piece together key aspects of the case.

BJP MLA opens front...

Shakya also targeted the in-charge minister of Guna, Govind Singh Rajput, saying he considers himself greater than the 'Maharaja'. "He does not let anyone walk with the 'Maharaja' and removed me from the air-

strip, saying, 'Go away,' Shayka said, adding that he did not win the election because of the minister, but the people elected him.

Shakya further said he had nothing to do with Gwalior, the citadel of the Scindias, but he was connected to Guna, where people had elected him.

The farmers were demanding electricity because the moong crop was getting damaged due to lack of water, but nobody listened to their problems, he said.

A situation may occur because of poor power supply that might defame the Mohan Yadav-led government, Shakya said.

"If you are incapable, you should leave the chair, but if you are holding a position, you should justify it," Shakya said.

Bomb found during...

Considering the seriousness of the situation, police also informed the Indian Army and requested the Bomb Detection and Disposal Squad to safely remove and defuse the explosive.

Officials said the object is believed to be an unexploded ordnance (UXO), a bomb that did not explode when it was originally used or fired. The area is located close to several army establishments, including ordnance factories, depots, infantry units and weapons manufacturing facilities.

We understand that 3,765 candidates who were present and had completed biometric registration chose to leave before the examination could restart. For these candidates, NTA will conduct a rescheduled examination as a one-time measure," the agency said in a post on X.

The disruption triggered widespread frustration among students and parents, many of whom took to social media to express their anger. A third user said students and parents had left home as early as 6 am to reach far-flung examination centres, only to be left waiting for hours after the examination failed to begin on time.

SPEEDING UP JUSTICE| Probe duration in rape cases drops to 42 days, POCSO cases to 40 days, says minister

Rajasthan sets pace in fast-tracking rape cases

For years, delays in the investigation and disposal of rape and POCSO cases have remained one of the biggest concerns in India's criminal justice system.

Long investigations often add more to the trauma of survivors and weaken public confidence in the trial process.

Rajasthan, however, is now presenting a different story, one where speed, sensitivity and accountability are increasingly shaping the justice framework.

Recent crime review figures suggest that the state has made notable progress in reducing investigation timelines and improving case disposal in crimes involving women and children, positioning Rajasthan among states attempting to strengthen time-bound justice mechanisms.



As per Rajasthan Minister of State for Home Jawahar Singh Bedham, "The average investigation time in rape cases has witnessed a dramatic decline. While rape investigations took an average of 107 days in 2023, that period has reduced to just 42 days in 2026, up to March. A similar trend has been recorded in cases registered under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act,

where the average investigation period has fallen from 103 to 40 days."

Bedham said the improvement reflects both administrative efficiency and a more sensitive approach towards victims of such crimes.

"Ensuring time-bound justice has become a key priority for the administration. Sensitive cases involving women and children are now being handled with greater urgency, seriousness and accountabil-

Rain, gusty winds lift Delhi's air quality

The national capital saw a further drop in the minimum temperature on Saturday, as the air quality improved to the satisfactory category, amidst heavy winds and light to moderate rain in several parts of the city.

A yellow alert issued by the India Meteorological Department (IMD) remained in place for Saturday and Sunday as well.

According to data from Centre for Research on Energy and Clean Air (CREA), May 2026 was also Delhi's cleanest May in five years, since 2021. This data considers pollution levels till May 29.

Rain brings relief to sweltering UP

Uttar Pradesh, which has been reeling from extreme heatwave conditions, experienced relief as rainfall brought the temperature down in parts of the state.

State capital Lucknow recorded a maximum tempera-

ture of 34 degrees Celsius, 6.1 degrees below the normal mark, and a low of 24.5 degrees Celsius, 1 degree below the normal mark, the meteorological department said on Saturday.

Rainfall was recorded in Bahraich (18.0 mm), Muzaffarnagar (12.2 mm), Lakhimpur Kheri (5.0 mm), Najibabad (3.0 mm), Meerut (0.6 mm) and in traces in Moradabad.

Rainfall hit several areas of Punjab and Haryana on Saturday, providing relief from the intense heat that had affected the region in recent days.

Maximum temperatures dropped significantly below normal in both states.

Showers were reported from Mohali (17 mm), Pathankot (5 mm), Hoshiarpur (3.5 mm), Rupnagar (19 mm), Amritsar (7.2 mm), Ludhiana (32.6 mm), Patiala (19.6 mm), Fazilka (22.5 mm), Ferozepur (13.5 mm), in Punjab, according to a meteorological department report.

Centre launches drive for balanced fertiliser use

In the wake of the West Asia conflict, which has affected fertiliser supplies to India from the region, the Union Agriculture Ministry has decided to launch a nationwide Khet Bachao Abhiyan in June to create awareness about the judicious use of fertilisers.

Union Agriculture Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan on Saturday said the campaign would focus on the slogan: "Less fertiliser, right fertiliser, right advice", while promoting the balanced use of fertilisers.

The minister said the Abhiyan would be more than an awareness programme and would serve as a comprehensive national campaign connecting farms, farmers and villages. Apart from promoting balanced and judicious use of fertilisers, it will also provide timely advice on weather-related challenges.

Chouhan said the campaign, beginning on June 1, would not follow a top-down approach but would function as a partnership among panchayats, state governments

and the Centre.

On sensitising farmers to fertiliser use, he said they would also be educated about other agricultural inputs based on soil tests and encouraged to increase the use of green manure, organic products and bio-products. Live demonstrations of Integrated Nutrient Management (INM) will also be organised to enhance awareness.

With a strong El Nino expected to develop this year, the minister said farmers would be provided practical guidance to address weather-related concerns.

This would include advice on dos and don'ts, suitable crop choices, crop diversification and farming practices in conditions of water scarcity or climatic risk.
