2019-21: Over 27k cardiac deaths

Fatalities from heart attacks dropped during Covid; however, experts say they may have been accounted as pandemic deaths due to comorbidities

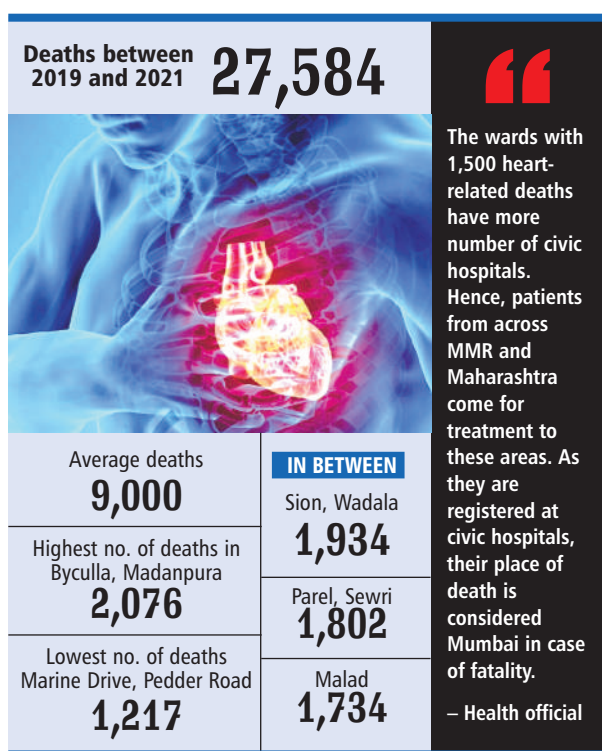

As many as 27,584 people in Mumbai have died of heart diseases or heart attacks between 2019 and 2021 across 24 wards of the city, revealed the reply to a Right To Information (RTI) application filed by activist Shaikh Faiyaz Alam. On an average, 9,000 people succumbed to heart attacks or related diseases between these years.

A heart attack or a myocardial infarction refers to a blockage or a blood clot being formed within the arteries, which blocks blood flow to the heart. Notably, the number of such deaths witnessed a marginal drop in each ward during two years of Covid. However, senior health officials reasoned that during pandemic, deaths from heart attack were considered as Covid fatalities due to comorbidities.

As per the data, E ward (Byculla, Madanpura) recorded 2,076 heart-related deaths followed by F-North ward (Sion, Wadala 1,934), F-South (Parel, Sewri 1,802), P-North (Malad 1,734), R-South (Kandivali 1,423), N ward (Ghatkopar 1,316) and D ward (Marine Drive, Pedder Road 1,217).

"The wards with over 1,500 heart-related deaths have more number of civic hospitals. Hence, patients from across the Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR) and Maharashtra come for treatment to these areas. As they are registered at the civic hospitals, so their place of death is considered Mumbai in case of fatality," said the health official. For instance, E ward, which comprises Byculla and Madanpura, has one state-run JJ Hospital and another civic-run BYL Nair Hospital so patients with heart ailments get admitted to either of these

hospitals, the official added.

He pointed out that there are several factors which need to be analysed before jumping to the conclusion that few wards have witnessed more heart attack deaths. "There is a procedure through which a patient's history and complete profile is being checked. Even if the deceased is not from Mumbai, the death gets added to city data as the patient was admitted to civic-run hospitals," he said.

Senior health official said every year around 25,000-30,000 people die of heart-related ailments in Mumbai. However, the numbers which have been provided are of only civic-run hospitals. "Three factors which might be the main reasons for these deaths are classification of fatalities, delay in diagnosis

and thrombosis (blood clotting) post-Covid," he said, adding that deeper analysis is needed to understand the crux of the matter.

A senior cardiologist from a private hospital said, "Unfortunately, many young people are getting heart attacks which go unnoticed in our country. The cases of heart attack have gone up by 15% to 20% in the past two months. The reasons behind young adults suffering heart attacks are diabetes, sedentary lifestyle, air pollution, stress, heavy workout, steroids etc."

Also, Indians are genetically prone to develop heart attacks. On top of that, adoption of western lifestyle which leads to further mutation in that defective gene makes Indians more prone to heart attacks, he added.

BMC budget: Special care for women, trans, elderly

Apart from conventional upskilling programmes, stock market lessons have also been planned for women

In its 2023-24 budget, the BMC has planned a massive boost for women from economically-weaker sections besides differently abled people, senior citizens and transgender. From Rs40.38 crore gender budget in last fiscal, the civic body has hiked the corpus to Rs250 crore for this financial year.

Apart from utilising the funds for giving conventional training of sewing and making traditional goods, the BMC harbours the ambition of giving lessons on stock market and computer operation to the women. It



will also help women, who wish to travel abroad for job purposes, with legal formalities.

To be implemented by the civic body's planning department, the plan also aims to make the women well-versed with marketing, self-defence and professional cooking.

Providing assistance to the senior citizen women is also on the anvil.

To economically support the self-help groups (SHGs) and care for the homeless, the BMC has made a provision of Rs11.88 crore. It will also organise ward-wise and regional exhibitions to pub-

licise products made by the SHGs. Next, it will construct one hostel each for working women in seven zones for which a fund of Rs21 crore has been earmarked.

A massive outlay of Rs100 crore has been allocated for the financial assistance scheme. Under the initiative,

the BMC will provide sewing machines, flour mills, and spice-making and incense sticks machines to make the women self-dependent. Electric vehicles, including bikes and rickshaws, will also be allotted if the applicant fulfills the criteria.

For differently abled, the BMC has earmarked Rs25.32 crore which will be spent on buying self-employment machineries for these people. They will also not be charged for travelling in BEST buses. Another Rs2 crore will be utilised for the skill development of transgender, while Rs11.35 crore has been allocated for senior citizens.

Blaze doused after 9 hrs; fireman hurt

A 40-year-old station officer sustained injuries while dousing a fire that erupted at an under-construction high-rise in Prabhadevi on Monday. H S Narkar was immediately rushed to the KEM Hospital and discharged after treatment, informed officials, adding that the blaze was finally doused after nine hours.

According to the fire brigade department, the blaze erupted at around 8.40pm at the 55-storey India Bulls Sky Forest building located on Senapati Bapat Marg. Narkar was fighting the fire on the seventh floor.

Gradually, flames spread to building construction material, plywood, bamboo, packaging and sanitary material, galvanised iron sheets, office furniture, records and electric wiring stored in a godown at the seventh-floor podium.

"A compressed oxygen gas cylinder exploded in one of the godowns, thereby causing more spread of the fire," the official said. At least seven fire engines and other fire brigade vehicles were pressed into service and the blaze was doused by around 4am on Tuesday.

While the BMC engineer, Mohan Rathod, 42, works at the BMC's Bandra West office, the other person has been identified as Mohammad Shoaib Mohammad Raza Khan, 40, a resident of Malwani in Malad.

Kasturba Hospital to get disease surveillance lab

Learning lessons from Covid and measles outbreaks, the BMC has decided to set up a Metropolitan Surveillance Lab Unit (MSU) at the civic-run Kasturba Hospital. It will be established in coordination with the State and Central Governments. The MSU will be a combination of robust technology and expertise. In a high-tech lab, doctors, data analysts, and other staff will be hired for research and constant monitoring of diseases. Senior health official said the budget for setting up the MSU is under process for approval. A nodal officer will be appointed who will coordinate with the staff for the execution of the project.

The initiative was announced by the BMC in its budget for the financial year



2023-24. As per sources from the health department, the National Center for Disease Control has approved the location for this center. A memorandum of understanding (MoU) has also been signed between the BMC, State and Centre in this regard.

Dr Sanjeev Kumar, Additional Municipal Commissioner, said the main objective of setting up the MSU is to link private and public health facil-

ities through the Integrated Health Information Platform (IHIP). Moreover, it will also enable the surveillance and monitoring of infectious diseases in urban areas.

"It is the much needed unit for keeping real-time data and analysis to act on outbreak or pandemic which helps us to make strategies to tackle the health crisis. We will be hiring manpower who will be trained for data reporting on the IHIP. We will also aim at collecting relevant samples for zoonotic diseases," he said.

Health experts have welcomed this initiative citing that civic body should have taken this step beforehand. Considering the mutations in Covid virus, it's the need of the hour to set up such surveillance units across Maharashtra and India, they added.

Live cartridge recovered from flyer's baggage

The Sahar police recently booked a passenger for allegedly carrying a live cartridge in his baggage. The passenger had arrived from Doha and was on his way to fly to Kerala when airport officials found a suspected object in his check-in baggage which resulted in the recovery of the live cartridge. The police have initiated a probe to ascertain for which purpose the passenger had kept the cartridge, sources said.

The complainant in the case, MJ Jodgankar works as a senior officer (security) at the Mumbai airport. On Saturday, the airport officials came across an image of a suspicious object in one of the bags.

On closely checking the image, the officials suspected it to be a cartridge.

BMC engineer in ACB net over ₹9L bribe

The Mumbai Unit of the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) has arrested an assistant engineer of the Buildings and Factories Department of the H-West ward of the BMC, and another person, for allegedly demanding Rs9 lakh for allegedly not taking action against a man whose two-storeyed structure at Chapel Road was considered unauthorised.

While the BMC engineer, Mohan Rathod, 42, works at the BMC's Bandra West office,

the other person has been identified as Mohammad Shoaib Mohammad Raza Khan, 40, a resident of Malwani in Malad.

According to the ACB, the complainant has a ground-plus-two house at Chapel Road in Bandra West. On Jan 16, he received an eviction notice from the BMC, which termed the first and second floors as unauthorised. On receiving the notice, he visited Rathod's office to tell him that the construction was not unauthorised and requested him to not take action. The

complainant alleged that Rathod demanded Rs15 lakh for it. Not wanting to pay the bribe, the complainant approached the ACB and submitted a written complaint on Monday. A verification of the allegations was conducted by

the agency, which revealed that Rathod had allegedly demanded Rs9 lakh, which was settled at Rs8.50 lakh.

On Tuesday, a trap was laid by the ACB and Khan was caught red-handed while accepting Rs8.50 lakh from the complainant, on the alleged instructions of Rathod. The two have been booked under sections 7 (public servant taking gratification other than legal remuneration in respect of an official act) and 12 (abetment of offences) of the Prevention of Corruption Act.

Man hangs to death from Kalyan skywalk

A 25-year-old man from Beed district allegedly committed suicide on Tuesday by hanging himself from the railing of the skywalk in front of the Kalyan railway station. He took the extreme step at around 4am, right after calling his family and informing them about his heart-sinking decision.

His frenzied kin immediately gave a distress call to the Kalyan police. But the man had ended his life by the time cops reached the spot. A suicide note was found from his pocket which read that no one should be held responsible for his death. The incident also gave a rude shock to the locals as they were aghast after spotting the body while starting their day.

Subsequently, a team of cops from the Mahatma Phule Chowk police station and fire brigade officials reached the spot, brought

down the body and sent it to the government hospital for post-mortem.

Speaking with The Free Press Journal, Inspector Pradeep Patil said, "The deceased has been identified as Vitthal Ramu Misal, a resident of Beed district. Before committing suicide, he called his family and informed them that he is going to end his life and no one should be held responsible for it. The frenzied family contacted the Kalyan police but Vitthal had taken

the extreme step by the time cops reached."

With regards to the reason which pushed Vitthal to the brink, Patil said that depression might be behind the act but the actual problem of the deceased could be only ascertained after thorough probe.

The suicide note was found in the pocket of the deceased which read that no one should be held responsible for the suicide."

House painter found hanging in Juhu park

A man was found hanging by his neck from a tree in a Juhu garden on Tuesday morning. From his belongings – a bag with some painting material – he was identified as a local painter. The police said no suicide note was recovered and the body has been sent for post-mortem.

The disturbing sight was witnessed by passers-by, who

immediately informed the police. "His bag had material such as paints and ropes. He probably used the same rope to hang himself," a senior police official said. He added that a case of death by suicide has been registered but further probe is underway. The police, he said, will also look at CCTV camera footage from the area and enquire with other sources for a confirmed conclusion.

Two held for stealing loaded oil tanker

The Wadala police on Monday arrested two persons for allegedly stealing an oil tanker containing 25,000 litre of base oil that was parked near the BPT Hospital gate during the early hours of Feb 2.

The tanker has just been loaded with base oil, which is mostly used in automotive products including engine oils, gear lubricants and greases. The cost of the base oil amounted to Rs17,80,421, while the vehicle was worth Rs4,50,000, Lalchand Gupta, 67, told the police.

The police started scanning footage from CCTV cameras in the area. They then scanned through almost 70-75 cameras along city highways and neighbouring areas including Nashik Bypass, Mulund Toll



Naka and Bhiwandi. After spotting the vehicle in Bhiwandi, they traced its movement from Wadala to its location and scanned CCTV cameras in the vicinity. They finally traced the suspects to a local hotel where they had a meal that was paid for online. The police informed the cyber team which informed them about their movement towards Valsad in Gujarat. The police followed and arrested them.

मुंबई : गेले काही दिवस मुंबई शहरात बॉम्बस्फोट होणार असल्याच्या धमक्यांचे सत्र सुरुच असून या धमक्यांमुळे पोलिसांची चांगलीच तारांबळ उडत आहे. पंतप्रधान नरेंद्र मोदी हे शुक्रवारी १० फेब्रुवारीला मुंबई दौऱ्यावर येत आहेत. यादरम्यान शहरात कुठेही अनुचित प्रकार घडू नये, म्हणून एकीकडे पोलिसांनी कडेकोट पोलीस बंदोबस्त तैनात केला असताना दुसरीकडे मुंबई शहरात बॉम्बस्फोट होणार असल्याच्या निनावी कॉलमुळे मंगळवारी एकच खळबळ उडाली. गेल्या २४ तासांत अशा प्रकारच्या धमक्यांचे दोन कॉल मुंबई पोलिसांना प्राप्त झाले. या धमक्यांची वरिष्ठ पोलीस अधिकाऱ्यांनी गंभीर दखल घेत स्थानिक पोलिसांना तपासाचे आदेश दिल्यानंतर काही तासांत मुंबई आणि सहार पोलिसांनी धमकी देणाऱ्या दोन संशयितांना चौकशीसाठी ताब्यात घेतले. या दोघांची रात्री उशिरापर्यंत चौकशी सुरु होती. त्यांच्यावर अटकची कारवाई होईल, असे सांगण्यात आले. दोघांपैकी एका कॉलरने सकाळी दहा वाजता कॉल करून मुंबईतील छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराज आंतरराष्ट्रीय विमानतळावरील एअरपोर्ट कॉन्टॅक्ट सेंटरच्या क्रमांकावर घातपात होणार असल्याची धमकी दिली. संबधित व्यक्तीने त्याचे नाव इफ्रान अहमद शेख असल्याचे सांगून तो 'इंडियन मुजाहिदीन' या संघटनेचा सदस्य असल्याचे सांगितले. तो अतिरेकी, मुजाहिदीन तसेच अन्य काही संशयास्पद फ्रिक्वेसी कोडवर्डमध्ये बोलत होता. या कॉलनंतर तिथे उपस्थित अधिकाऱ्यांनी वरिष्ठ अधिकाऱ्यांसह मुंबई पोलिसांना ही माहिती दिली. या माहितीनंतर सहार पोलिसांसह एटीएस, गुन्हे शाखा, बॉम्बशोधक व नाशक पथकातील अधिकारी श्वान पथकासह घटनास्थळी दाखल झाले. संपूर्ण आंतरराष्ट्रीय विमानतळाची तपासणी करण्यात आली, मात्र कुठेही पोलिसांना काहीही संशयास्पद वस्तू सापडली नाही.

'अमूल'ने ३ फेब्रुवारीपासून दूधाच्या दरात लिटरमागे ३ रुपये वाढ केली. गोवर्धन दुधाचेही दर वाढले आहेत. दूध दारांबरोबरच दूधाचे इतर पदार्थही महाग झाले आहेत. दही, तूप, पनीर आदींच्या दरात अचानक वाढ झाली. या वाढत्या किंमतीचा सामना कसा करायचा हे अनेकांना समजत नाही. दूध दरांच्या वाढीव किंमतीचा काय परिणाम झाला यावर एक सर्व्हेक्षण करण्यात आले. देशातील १० पैकी ४ कुटुंबीयांनी दूधाचे प्रमाण कमी केले किंवा ते अल्प स्वस्त पर्यायांकडे वळले आहेत. तर अनेकांनी दूध किंवा दूधाचे उत्पादन घेणे बंद केले आहे, असे सर्व्हेक्षणत आढळून आले आहे. लोकलसर्व्हेक्सने देशातील ३०३ जिल्ह्यांमध्ये १० हजार कुटुंबांचे सर्व्हेक्षण केले.
