28-year-old kills self seven months after wedding

AHMEDABAD: A 28-year-old woman, Meena Sangar, hanged herself at her father's house on Sunday, just seven months after her wedding, allegedly because her husband and in-laws were tormenting her for dowry. The victim's father, 61-year-old Anand Kalind, a resident of Chandkheda, filed a complaint with police for abetment to suicide, cruelty and offences under the Dowry Prohibition Act against his son-in-law, Aditya Sangar, and his parents, Bhagmal and Anita Sangar.



In his FIR, Anand stated that his daughter had expressed her desire to marry Aditya Sangar a resident of Adalaj. He said Bhagmal and Anita had accepted the proposal and the wedding was set for February 17.

Anand said he made it

clear that he would not be able to furnish an extravagant dowry. The Sangars agreed, but just 10 days before the wedding, they demanded a car. He booked it in Meena's name, but it was not delivered by the wedding day. During the wedding, Aditya got agitated during a ritual and threatened to walk out of the wedding. After family elders intervened, the wedding went ahead.

Anand alleged that from the very next day of the wedding, Meena was being harassed by her in-laws, over the car. It was later delivered to them.

Anand said Meena told him that the Sangars told her she was not getting a dowry and too short and they could not introduce her to their relatives. He said Meena was being harassed over trivial issues. When he went to meet Meena in July, he realized she was sick and brought her to his home. The Sangars then refused to take her back. The complainant alleged that Aditya also demanded a flat, and was tormenting Meena, and was making several attempts to work things out with the Sangars, but they failed. On Saturday, Meena went to bed after dinner and did not come out for breakfast. When she did not emerge from her room till 2pm, the family broke open the door and found that she had hanged herself.

35% rise in animal and avian strikes at Ahmedabad airport



AHMEDABAD: After a brief lull in 2021-22, the number of bird strikes at the Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International (SVPI) airport in Ahmedabad has begun to rise again. Some 38 aircraft landing or departing from the city airport suffered bird hits in 2022-23, up 35% against 29 in 2021-22 - the lowest in a five-year period, suggests data by the Airports Authority of India (AAI).

implemented to control wildlife proliferation. "SVPI airport has deployed increased number of bird chasers located at strategic places near the runway equipped with specialized firecrackers, use of laser guns, zone guns and bio acoustic devices to mention a few of many measures implemented over last two years to ensure strengthening of aircraft safety. Multiple efforts are being put at

airport terminal to shoo the larvae away, which is being another safety concern. Reduced aircraft movement due to Covid-19 restrictions, in addition to these measures, led to a reduction in bird strikes. However, the alarming increase in the previous fiscal year is a grave concern according to aviation experts. Statistically, five of every 10,000 aircraft taking off or landing from the city airport suffer a bird hit. The SVPI airport witnesses a movement of some 220-230 aircraft every day, according to sources. Such incidents are typically reported after the onset of the monsoon season when the proliferation of insects is more. Due to this, many birds typically tend to hover around the airport," sources privy to the development told TOI. Even as the aviation watchdog, Directorate general of Civil Aviation (DGCA) issued fresh guidelines last year, the city airport saw no respite. When contacted, the airport operator remained tight-lipped about the reasons for an increase in the number of bird strike incidents in the previous fiscal year. Instead, an airport spokesperson talked about the measures

to reduce bird movement by catching insects like crickets, pentatomid bugs, moths, syrphid flies, and earwigs. Rosy starlings, mynas, swallows and swifts are among the birds whose activity is mostly restricted and reduced by this system. Last year, DGCA had urged all airports to review the Wildlife Hazard Management Plan. In fact, it has also been reiterated in the National Aviation Safety Plan 2018-2022. That - the management of all airports must take effective steps to mitigate wildlife hazard.
