POSTAL BALLOT NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with the provisions of Section 108 and 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') read with the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (including any statutory modification or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force), General Circular No: 9/2025 dated September 22, 2025 (in continuation to the circulars issued earlier in this regard) issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ('MCA Circulars'), applicable provisions of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('the Listing Regulations') and such other applicable laws and regulations, approval of the Members is sought for the resolution appended below, which are proposed to be passed by way of Postal Ballot through e-voting only (Remote e-voting). An Explanatory Statement in accordance with the provisions of Section 102 and 110 of the Act read with Rule 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, giving the material facts relating to the resolution, is set-out herein below. Further, additional information as required under the Listing Regulations, SEBI (Share Based Employee Benefits and Sweat Equity) Regulations, 2021 and Secretarial Standard is also provided in the said Explanatory Statement.

PROPOSED RESOLUTION:

1. Approval of the Alicon Castalloy Ltd. – Employees Stock Option Scheme-2026 (ESOS – 2026)

To consider and if thought fit, to pass the following Resolution as a Special Resolution:

“RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 62(1)(b) and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the rules made thereunder, including any statutory modification and re-enactment thereof for the time being in force, the Securities and Exchange Board of India

(Share Based Employee Benefits and Sweat Equity) Regulations, 2021 as amended and enacted from time to time read with all circulars and notifications issued thereunder (hereinafter referred to as “SEBI SBEB Regulations”), Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended from time to time read with the circulars issued thereunder (hereinafter referred to as “SEBI LODR Regulations”), the provisions of Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 and rules and regulations framed thereunder and any other applicable laws for the time being in force, the relevant provisions of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company and further subject to such other approvals, permissions and sanctions as may be necessary and subject to such conditions and modifications as may be prescribed or imposed, while granting such approvals, permissions and sanctions, the approval of the members of the Company be and is hereby accorded to the introduction and implementation of Alicon Castalloy Limited – Employee Stock Option Scheme - 2026 (hereinafter referred to as the “ESOS-2026”), authorising the Board of Directors of the Company (hereinafter referred to as the “Board”, which term shall be deemed to include any committee, including the Nomination and Remuneration Committee, which the Board has constituted to exercise its powers, including the powers, conferred by this resolution and under Regulations 5 of the SEBI SBEB Regulations) to create, offer and grant from time to time, in one or more tranches, not exceeding 3,00,000 (three lacs) Employee Stock Options (“Options”) to or for the benefit of such employee(s), who are in permanent employment of the Company, its subsidiary or associate companies whether in India or outside India, including any Director, whether whole-time or not, present or future, or for the benefit of such persons as designated by the Company for the employment within the meaning of the Scheme (other than Promoters of the Company or the persons

belonging to the Promoter Group of the Company, Independent Directors and Directors holding directly or indirectly more than 10% of the outstanding Equity Shares of the Company), as may be decided under ESOS-2026, exercisable into not more than 3,00,000 (three lacs) Equity Shares of face value of ₹5/- (Rupees five only) each fully paid-up, on such terms and in such manner as the Board may decide in accordance with the provisions of the applicable laws and the provisions of ESOS-2026.”

“**RESOLVED FURTHER THAT** the Equity Shares so issued and allotted as mentioned hereinbefore shall rank *pari passu* with the then existing Equity Shares of the Company.”

“**RESOLVED FURTHER THAT** in case of any corporate action(s) such as rights issues, bonus issues, sub-divisions, merger and sale of division and others, if any, additional Equity Shares are required to be issued by the Company to the Option grantees for the purpose of making a fair and reasonable adjustment to the Employee Stock Options granted earlier, the ceiling on the number of Options mentioned in the resolution above, shall be deemed to be increased to the extent of such additional Equity Shares issued.”

“**RESOLVED FURTHER THAT** the Board including the designated committee of the Board, be and is hereby authorized at any time to modify, change, vary, alter, amend, suspend or terminate the ESOS-2026 subject to the compliance with the applicable laws and regulations and to do all such acts, deeds, matters and

things as may at its absolute discretion deems fit, for such purpose and also to settle any issues, questions, difficulties or doubts that may arise in this regard without being required to seek any further consent or approval of the members and further to execute all such documents, writings and to give such directions and or instructions as may be necessary or expedient to give effect to such modification, change, variation, alteration, amendment, suspension or termination of the ESOS-2026 and to do all other things incidental and ancillary thereof.”

“**RESOLVED FURTHER THAT** the Board be and is hereby authorized to do all such acts, deeds, matters and things, as may, at its absolute discretion, deems necessary including authorizing or directing to appoint Merchant Bankers, Brokers, Solicitors, Registrars, Compliance Officer, Investors Service Centre and other Advisors, Consultants or Representatives, being incidental to the effective implementation and administration of ESOS-2026 as also to make applications to the appropriate authorities, parties and the institutions for their requisite approvals and to settle all such questions, difficulties or doubts whatsoever, which may arise and take all such steps and decisions in this regard.”

1. Pursuant to Sections 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and other applicable provisions setting-out material facts and reasons in relation to the proposed special resolution is appended hereto.
2. In compliance with the MCA Circulars, the Company is sending this Postal Ballot Notice to the Members in electronic form only. Accordingly, the communication of the assent or dissent of the Members would take place through e-voting only.
3. The Company has engaged the services of National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) as the agency to provide e-voting facility. Instructions for e-voting are provided in the postal ballot notice and members may cast their votes by following the instructions provided in the notes to the notice.
4. The Postal Ballot Notice is being sent via e-mail only to the Members of the Company, whose names appear in the Register of Members/ the list of Beneficial Owners, as received from National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) and Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) as on Friday, 20th February, 2026 ("Cut-off date"). EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013

Equity based compensation is considered to be an integral part of employee compensation across sectors, which enables alignment of personal goals of the employees with organizational objectives. Your Company believes in rewarding its employees including Directors of the Company for their continuous hard work, dedication and support, which has led the Company on the growth path. The Company intends to implement Employee Stock Option Scheme with a view to attract and retain key talents working with the Company by way of rewarding their performance and motivate them to contribute to the overall corporate growth and profitability.

Accordingly, the Nomination and Remuneration Committee of the Directors ('Committee') and the Board of Directors of the Company at their respective meetings held on 05.02.2026 and 13.02.2026 had approved the introduction of the Scheme called Alicon Castalloy Ltd. – Employees Stock Option Scheme-2026 ("ESOS-2026"/ "Scheme"), subject to approval of the members of the Company.

In terms of Section 62(1) (b) of the Companies Act, 2013 and rules made thereunder read with the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Share Base Employee Benefits and Sweat Equity) Regulations, 2021 ("SEBI SBEB Regulations"), the Company seeks members' approval in respect of ESOS-2026 and grant of Stock Options to the eligible employees of the Company.

The main features of the ESOS-2026 are as under:

a) Brief description of the scheme:

The Company proposes to introduce the ESOS-2026 with a primary view to attract, retain, incentivize and motivate the existing employees of the Company, new employees joining the Company and its Directors that would lead to higher corporate growth. The ESOS-2026 contemplates grant of Options to the eligible employees (including Whole-time Directors), as may be determined in due compliance of SEBI SBEB Regulations and provisions of the ESOS-2026. After vesting of Options, the eligible employees earn a right (but not obligation) to exercise the vested Options within the exercised period and obtain equity shares of the Company ("Equity Shares") subject to payment of exercise price and satisfaction of any tax obligation arising thereon.

The Nomination and Remuneration Committee shall act as Compensation Committee for the administration of ESOS- 2026. All questions of interpretation of the ESOS-2026 shall be determined by the Committee and such determination shall be final and binding upon all persons having an interest in ESOS-2026.

b) Total number of Options to be granted:

A total number of 3,00,000 (three lacs) Options exercisable into 3,00,000 (three lacs) Equity Shares would be available for being granted to eligible employees of the Company under ESOS-2026. Each Option, when exercised would be converted into one Equity share of ₹ 5/- each fully paid-up.

Options lapsed or cancelled due to any reason including the reason of lapse of exercise period or due to resignation of the employees/ Directors or otherwise, would be available for being re-granted at a future date. The Committee is authorized to re-grant such lapsed / cancelled Options as per the ESOS-2026.

Further, the SEBI SBEB Regulations require that in case of any corporate action(s) such as rights issues, bonus issues, sub-divisions, consolidations, merger and sale of division and others, a fair and reasonable adjustment needs to be made to the Options granted. In this regard, the Committee shall adjust the number and/or exercise price of the Options granted in such a manner that the total value of the Options granted under ESOS-2026 remain the same after any such corporate action. Accordingly, if any additional Options are issued by the Company to the Option grantees for making such fair and reasonable adjustment, the ceiling of 3,00,000 (three lacs) shall be deemed to be increased to the extent of such additional Options issued.

c) Identification of classes of employees entitled to participate in ESOS-2026

All permanent employees of the Company including Whole-time Directors (hereinafter referred to as 'employees') shall be eligible subject to determination or selection by the Committee. Following classes of employees/ Directors are eligible being -

1. an employee as designated by the Company, who is exclusively working in India or outside India;
2. a Director of the Company, whether a Whole-time Director or not, including a non-executive director, who is not a promoter or member of the promoter group, but excluding an Independent Director; or
3. an employee as defined in sub-clauses (1) or (2) of a Group Company including subsidiary or its associate company in India or outside India, or of a holding company of the Company;

but excludes –

- a. an employee, who is a Promoter or belongs to the Promoter Group;
- b. a Director, who either by himself or through his relatives or through any body corporate, directly or indirectly, holds more than ten percent of the outstanding equity shares of the Company.

d) Requirements of vesting and period of vesting

All the Options granted on any date shall vest as indicated in Para 7 of the ESOS-2026 or as may be determined by the Committee.

Options shall vest essentially based on continuation of employment and apart from that the vesting will be subject to individual performance parameters as the management may specify in consultation with Committee.

e) Maximum period within which the Options shall be vested:

All the Options granted on any date shall vest not later than a maximum of 4 (Four) years from the date of grant of options as may be determined by the Committee. The Committee subject to minimum and maximum ceiling of vesting period shall have the power to prescribe the vesting schedule for a particular grant.

f) Exercise price or pricing formula:

The exercise price shall be determined by the Committee subject to a maximum discount of 25% to a market price as on the grant date. Market price shall be as defined under the SEBI SBEB Regulations.

The pricing will be done on the stock exchange having the highest trading volume on which the shares of the Company are listed on the date immediately prior to the grant date.

g) Exercise period and the process of Exercise:

The exercise period would commence from the date of vesting and will expire on completion of 5 (Five) years from the date of respective vesting or such other shorter period as may be decided by the Committee from time to time.

The vested Option shall be exercisable by the Option grantee by a written application to the Company expressing his/her desire to exercise such Options in such manner and on such format as may be prescribed by the Committee from time to time. Exercise of Options shall be entertained only after payment of requisite Exercise Price and satisfaction of applicable taxes by the Option grantee. The Options shall lapse, if not exercised within the specified exercise period.

h) Appraisal process for determining the eligibility of employees under ESOS-2026:

The appraisal process for determining the eligibility shall be decided from time to time by the management in consultation with the Committee. The broad criteria for appraisal and selection may include parameters like tenure of association with the Company, performance during the previous years, contribution towards strategic growth, contribution to team building and succession, cross-functional relationship, corporate governance, expected role for corporate growth etc.

i) Maximum number of Options to be issued per employee and in aggregate:

The maximum number of Options that may be granted to any specific employee of the Company under the ESOS-2026 in any financial year and in aggregate under the ESOS-2026 shall not exceed 1,50,000 (one lakhs fifty thousand) Options. Further, no individual identified employee shall receive grant equal to or more than 1% of the issued capital of the Company unless a separate specific approval from shareholders of the Company through special resolution is obtained.

j) Maximum quantum of benefits to be provided per employee under the ESOS-2026:

Apart from grant of Options as stated above, no monetary benefit are contemplated under the ESOS-2026.

k) Route of ESOS-2026 implementation:

The ESOS-2026 shall be implemented and administered directly by the Company.

l) Source of acquisition of shares under the ESOS-2026:

The ESOS-2026 contemplates fresh/new issue of shares by the Company.

m) Amount of loan to be provided for implementation of the scheme(s) by the Company to the trust, its tenure, utilization, repayment terms, etc:

This is currently not contemplated under the present ESOS-2026.

n) Maximum percentage of secondary acquisition:

This is not relevant under the present ESOS-2026.

o) Accounting and Disclosure Policies:

The Company shall follow the IND AS/Guidance Note on Accounting for Employee Share-based Payments and/or any relevant Accounting Standards as may be prescribed by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India or any other competent authorities from time to time, including the disclosure requirements prescribed therein.

p) Method of Option valuation:

The Company shall adopt 'intrinsic/fair value method' for valuation Options as prescribed under Guidance Note or under any relevant accounting standard notified by appropriate authorities from time to time.

q) Terms and conditions for buy-back, if any, of specified securities/Options covered granted

Subject to the provisions of the then prevailing applicable laws, the Committee shall determine the procedure for buy-back of Options granted under the ESOS-2026, if to be undertaken at any time by the Company, and the applicable terms and conditions thereof.

r) Lock-in Period:

The shares issued pursuant to exercise of Options shall not be subject to any lock-in period instructions except such restrictions as may be prescribed under applicable laws including that under the Code of Conduct framed, if any, by the Company under the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Prohibition of Insider Trading) Regulations, 2015 as amended.

s) Declaration:

In case the Company opts for expensing of share based employee benefits using the intrinsic value, the difference between the employee compensation cost so computed and the employee compensation cost that shall have been recognized, if it had used the fair value of the Options and the impact of this difference on profits and on Earning Per Share ("EPS") of the Company shall also be disclosed in the Directors' report.
