**Sub : Intimation under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015**

In an unfortunate accident, a fire broke out in one of the manufacturing unit of Amara Raja Batteries Limited, located in Nunegundlapalli village, Chittoor District of Andhra Pradesh, on Monday, January 30, 2023) evening around 8.05 PM (IST).

"While there was damage to property, building and other industrial equipment located on the premises, there were no casualties or injuries due to this incident. Prompt action by the Company's on-site personnel ensured all employees were safely evacuated from the area. The affected area was cordoned off completely and efforts were made to contain the fire from spreading to other zones, while the authorities were informed of the incident. Fire brigade teams from Chittoor rushed to the spot and managed to bring the fire under control.

The cause for the fire accident is yet to be established. The company has adequate insurance coverage for recovery of actual loss due to the fire. As soon as we received information about the incident, our leadership team rushed to the spot and joined the fire control and employee safety operations. We are now in the process of ascertaining the cause of the accident and an investigation is underway. We are deeply committed to the safety and well-being of our employees and all our stakeholders. No injury or loss of life has been reported."
