Surat BJP leader’s daughter-in-law found dead, son booked for abetment

THE SON of a BJP leader in Surat has been booked for abetment to suicide after his wife was found dead at their home here on Tuesday.

Saurabh Singh, 26, is the son of Shashi Singh, former vice-president of the BJP women’s wing in Surat. A woman friend of Saurabh has also been named in the case.

Originally from Muzaffarpur in Bihar, Nidhi Singh, 24, married Saurabh Singh two years ago. Her family has alleged that Saurabh had an extramarital affair, which led to quarrels between the couple.

Shashi Singh told police that she returned home on Tuesday evening and found her daughter-in-law hanging in her bedroom. No one was at home at the time.

Shashi then called her husband, Sanjay Singh, and son Saurabh. She also informed the police. Her family has roots in

Bihar’s Sitamarhi but has lived in Surat for several years now.

Nidhi Singh’s brother Aditya Kumar rushed to Surat after learning of her death and filed a police complaint against Saurabh Singh and his friend. Based on the complaint, an FIR was registered at Kadodara police station.

Sections of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita related to abetment to suicide and cruelty by a husband or his relatives against a woman have been invoked in the case.

Aditya Kumar has alleged an affair between Saurabh Singh and his friend and that they were in a relationship even before he married Nidhi. “Nidhi learnt about her husband’s illicit relationship, after which quarrels erupted between them regularly. Nidhi also spoke about the issue with her parents and other family members who live in Bihar. Even after several warnings, Saurabh Singh continued his illicit relationship,” the complaint said.

Kadodara police inspector VA Desai said: “Based on the allegations made by Aditya Kumar, we have started a probe against Saurabh Singh and his woman friend. We are collecting evidence about their relationship. Allegedly, Nidhi warned him to end the relationship and not to bring her (Saurabh’s friend) home, but he continued to do so.”

“The doctor, while carrying out the post-mortem, found a suicide note hidden in her undergarments. Perhaps she hid the note because she did not want her in-laws to find it, fearing they would destroy it,” the police officer said.

Bharat Rathod, the chief of BJP’s Surat district unit, said, “We have checked with the Kadodara Police and found that Shashi Singh has not been named in the FIR. Shashi was the vice-president of the BJP women’s wing in Surat district in the last term. She is an active member of the BJP and takes part in all party events.”

Woman, 7-yr-old daughter killed as GSRTC bus strikes 3 down

A WOMAN and her 7-year-old daughter were killed after a Gujarat State Road Transport Corporation (GSRTC) bus ran them over on a pavement in Bhavnagar city on Wednesday, police said.

The bus struck the pedestrians and came to a stop only after crashing into the boundary wall of a cricket club while exiting the bus stand in Nilambga area of the city.

While Lalita Parmar (28) and her daughter Sonia died in the accident, another woman was under treatment, sources said.

Deputy Superintendent of Police RR Singhal said, “Dinesh Jambucha, who was driving bus number GJ18Z5080, drove negligently and crashed into the wall of the Bharuch Cricket Club. Three people who were standing there were hit by the vehicle, and two of them, Lata and her daughter, died in the incident.”

The bodies were sent for a postmortem examination, said the police.

The driver was booked and detained for further legal action.

‘PROMISED ONE BRIDE, MARRIED TO ANOTHER’ Not part of ‘looteri dulhan gang’: HC relief for marriage bureau head

GRANTING BAIL to a woman accused of cheating through a marriage bureau she ran, the Gujarat High Court remarked that the marriage she allegedly arranged was “real” and that she was not part of a “looteri dulhan” gang.

In an oral order on Tuesday, Justice HD Suthar granted bail to Kavita Soni, who has been in custody since March 27, noting that the investigation was complete, the chargesheet had been filed, and there was nothing further to be recovered from her.

The case was registered at Himmatnagar A Division police station in Sabarkantha district in March. The charges invoked included criminal breach of trust and cheating.

According to the prosecution, Kavita and her husband Manhar ran a marriage bureau called “Divya Shakti”. The complainant approached the bureau to find a match for his nephew.

The prosecution said the accused took Rs 2.10 lakh. Court records note that the complainant alleged that his nephew was married to a “different woman” and not the one initially agreed upon. It

was also alleged that the accused took money to be paid to the bride’s family, but did not do so.

The court recorded that, according to the prosecution, the accused received a total of Rs 5.10 lakh.

“But, the marriage is real and (the accused) got the marriage done; even if it is with another woman, it is real... She is not a member of the looteri dulhan gang...” Justice Suthar orally remarked during the proceedings.

Looteri Dulhan, a term that has gained currency of late, refers to an organized criminal syndicate that traps unsuspecting men into fake weddings, and the bride flees with cash, gold, and valuables shortly after the ceremony.

“If we accept the said allegation as it is, the role of the applicant was limited to giving a promise or solemnising the marriage of the complainant’s nephew,” the court said. The applicant’s counsel ar-

gued that she was innocent and had been falsely implicated. The state government opposed the bail plea, arguing she was “very much involved” in the offence and that, given the gravity of the allegations, she should not be granted bail. The prosecution also argued that she could flee.

Justice Suthar, however, noted that the investigation was over, the chargesheet had been filed, and that there was nothing more to be recovered from the accused.

The court also noted that while the accused has a criminal record, “she is presumed to be innocent till proven guilty”.

It observed that the trial would take time and that the prosecution had failed to establish why the accused’s detention is required.

Citing Supreme Court rulings, the court granted Kavita regular bail on a personal bond of Rs 25,000 with one surety of the same amount.

101 new state transport buses flagged off

THE STATE government on Wednesday launched 101 new Gujarat State Road Transport Corporation (GSRTC) buses ahead of the Raksha Bandhan festival.

Deputy Chief Minister Harsh Sanghavi flagged off the buses from Gandhinagar. On the occasion, women GSRTC conductors celebrated the festival in advance by tying rakhis to Sanghavi. “On the occasion of Raksha Bandhan, the Gujarat Government has launched 101 new GSRTC buses as a special gift of improved public transportation facilities for women across the state,” according to an official release.

The buses, including 71 super express services, 20 mini buses and 10 sleeper coaches, have been deployed as part of special transportation arrangements for Raksha Bandhan, it said. Minister Arjun Modhwadia, other ministers, and office bearers were present.

US: Suspect in murder of Gujarati store owner caught after high-speed chase

POLICE IN the United States have arrested a suspect in connection with the murder of Gujarati businessman Suresh Patel, 56, who was allegedly shot dead inside his liquor store in Jackson, Tennessee, following an armed robbery on August 20.

Corey Houge was apprehended by the Jackson police following a dramatic car chase on the afternoon of August 23. The pursuit ended when Houge wrecked his sedan outside a Burger King outlet on Christmasville Road, nearly 11 km from the crime scene on Ridgecrest Road, according to a Jackson police release on Facebook. Houge allegedly attempted to escape through the back door of the restaurant and carjack a customer in the parking lot before officers caught him.

Houge faces charges of first-degree murder, aggravated robbery, and unlawful possession of a weapon. Investigators also recovered key evidence from his vehicle, including a firearm, clothes, and a mask consistent

with the attire worn during the crime.

Multi-agency investigation

After the murder, working alongside the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), Jackson police gathered surveillance video from nearby businesses and residential properties.

Announcing the arrest, the department stated, “Utilizing the recovered video collected and Flock (Automated License Plate Reader) cameras, a Buick Lucerne was identified as a potential suspect vehicle. During the course of the investigation, Corey Houge was developed as a potential suspect. On Sunday, August 23, just after 1.30 pm, investigators with the Jackson Police Department, FBI, and ATF located Corey Houge operating his Buick Lucerne... The officers attempted to initiate a traffic stop on Houge on a previous outstanding warrant, at which time Houge fled from pursuing officers at a high rate of speed.”

Patel killed days after taking over business

Patel, a native of Akhaj village in the Mehsana district of Gujarat, was working at his store, Ridgecrest Cellars Wine and Spirits, on the night of August 20 when a masked gunman entered.

“The suspect demanded money from the three employees working at the business,” the Jackson police said in the statement. “After the employees turned the money over to the gunman, the suspect shot Suresh Patel multiple times and fled the business.”

Among those present inside the store during the incident was Patel’s 19-year-old daughter, sources from his home village told The Indian Express.

Patel had migrated to the US nearly 30 years ago. He previously operated a liquor store in Chicago and had taken over Ridgecrest Cellars in Jackson City just a week before the shooting. He was the youngest of six brothers, all settled in the US, and is survived by his siblings.
