Defense Ministry declares 2025 as 'Year of Reforms'

New Delhi : The Defense Ministry has decided to celebrate 2025 as the 'Year of Reforms' to accelerate existing and future reforms. Its aim is to transform the armed forces into a technologically advanced combat-ready force capable of multi-domain integrated operations. Defense Minister Rajnath Singh said that the 'Year of Reforms' will be an important step in the journey of modernization of the armed forces. This year will lay the foundation for unprecedented progress in defense preparedness as well as ensure India's security and sovereignty amid the challenges of the 21st century.

The Defense Minister held a meeting with all the Secretaries of the Ministry of Defense on the eve of New Year to review the progress of various schemes, projects, reforms and the way forward. The meeting identified broad areas for focused intervention in 2025. The meeting said that the aim of the reforms should be to

further strengthen jointness and integration initiatives and facilitate the establishment of integrated theater commands. These reforms should focus on new areas like cyber and space and emerging technologies like artificial intelligence, machine learning, hypersonic and robotics. Associated strategies, techniques and processes required to win future wars should also be developed.

It was also discussed in the meeting that these reforms aim to enhance India's defense capabilities, ensure readiness for future challenges and promote innovation and leadership on the global stage. The three armies should develop a shared understanding of operational requirements and joint operational capabilities through inter-service cooperation and training. Acquisition processes need to be simplified and made time-sensitive, so as to facilitate faster and robust capability development. Apart from this, the focus should

be on facilitating technology transfer and knowledge sharing between the defense sector and civilian industries and promoting public-private partnerships.

It was decided in the meeting that efforts will be made to establish India as a reliable exporter of defense products, promote research and development and partnerships between Indian industries and foreign original equipment manufacturers. Apart from this, emphasis was laid on promoting confidence in achieving global standards through indigenous capabilities as well as adopting best practices from modern armies to suit the conditions of the country. Major initiatives this year include the establishment of integrated theater commands for streamlined operations, adoption of emerging technologies like AI and robotics, promotion of indigenous defense production and exports and strengthening global partnerships.

SC TO RULE ON 1991 PLACES OF WORSHIP LAW PLEA

New Delhi : The Supreme Court of India is set to hear a plea on January 2, filed by the chief of All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen, Asaduddin Owaisi, regarding the implementation of the 1991 places of worship law.

This law states that the religious character of a place must be maintained as it existed on August 15, 1947. The plea was filed on December 17, 2024, through Owaisi's

advocate Fuzail Ahmad Ayyubi. However, a few days earlier on December 12, a bench led by Chief Justice Sanjiv Khanna had issued an order restraining all courts from hearing any new cases or passing interim or final orders in pending cases related to reclaiming religious places. This includes mosques and dargahs, which have been at the center of a controversy regarding their ownership and religious significance.
