KORBA (CHH GARH) MBBS student dies by suicide

A first-year MBBS student died by suicide in his hostel room on the premises of the Government Medical College in Chhattisgarh's Korba city on Saturday, the police said.



A suicide note, purportedly written by him, was found at the spot. It read, 'Mujhe nahi ho paya, I am sorry, papa (I couldn't do it, I am sorry, papa)', they said. Himanshu Kashyap, 24, was found hanging in his hostel room on the college campus within the jurisdiction of the Civil Lines police station, City Superintendent of Police Bhupinder Ekka said.

CHODAVARAM (AP) Two inmates escape from AP prison

Two undertrials have escaped from a prison here in Anapali district after attacking the jail head warden, an official said on Saturday. "Two remand prisoners, Ramu (27) and Kumar (30), escaped from Chodavaram sub-jail around 4 pm on Friday after hitting the jail head warden with a hammer," Anapali Superintendent of Police Tuhin Sinha said.

GODDA Man kills wife, ends life by hanging

A 30-year-old man allegedly stabbed his wife to death and injured his in-laws before hanging himself in Jharkhand's Godda district, police said on Saturday. The incident happened at Lathari village under Poreyhat police station area on Friday night following a scuffle between husband and wife over consumption of liquor, they said.

WAYANAD Brain infection claims 1 more life in Kerala

Sengottaiyan removed from AIADMK posts

All India Anna Dravid Munnetra Kazhagam general secretary Edappadi K Palaniswami on Saturday relieved M.L.A. K. Sengottaiyan from all the posts in the party with "immediate effect".



"I'm not sad. I'm happy that I've been relieved from party responsibilities. I urged unity with expelled leaders because I want dharmam to win."

Sengottaiyan, who was the District Organisation Secretary and District Secretary of the Erode Suburban West District, has been removed from the post. "In the All India Anna Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (AIADMK) Erode Suburban West District, Thiru. K.A. Sengottaiyan, M.L.A., who has been holding the responsibilities of District Organisation Secretary and District Secretary of the Erode Suburban West District, is hereby relieved of these responsibilities with effect from today," AIADMK said in an official communication.

Responding to the issue, Sengottaiyan expressed happiness with the decision taken against him by AIADMK high command. The decision comes after AIADMK general secretary Palaniswami held a meeting for over an hour with seven senior party leaders and former ministers in a hotel in Dindigul earlier today. Former ministers Dindigul

He said soon after the Lok Sabha election results were announced, senior leaders of the party met AIADMK's general secretary Edappadi K Palaniswami and asked for bringing back the leaders who left the party. But EPS did not heed the suggestion, he said. "I am working to ensure a united AIADMK. Since 2016, the election results have not been in our favour. If we had an alliance with the BJP, we would have won 30 seats in the Parliament election," Sengottaiyan said in a press conference here.

"Despite whatever efforts we made, we could not achieve success and win. After we lost the election, we senior leaders met with EPS and offered our suggestions. EPS was not able to listen to and follow our suggestions," he added. He said AIADMK can only win elections if it brings back the expelled leaders.

Manjhi hits out at Paswan over seat-sharing

Union MSME Minister and Hindustani Awam Morcha (HAM) patron Jitan Ram Manjhi on Saturday launched a sharp attack on Bihar over the last two weeks' grapples with seat-sharing talks ahead of the Bihar Assembly polls.

As soon as he arrived in Patna, Manjhi was asked about Chirag's recent remarks on seat expectations. Responding, he said, "Chirag Paswan says first he will contest on 137 seats, then on 43 seats, and now demands somewhere in between. I knew Chirag's character since 2020, so I don't want to say anything more about him."

Earlier, Arun Bharati, LJP (RV) MP from Jhansi and Chirag Paswan's No. 2 leader after Chirag, had clarified the party's stance. LJP contested 43 seats in 2015 and 137 seats in 2020. Therefore, the party expects a respectable number of seats between 43 and 137 in 2025.

Tejashwi steps up attack on Nitish government

Bihar Leader of the Opposition Tejashwi Yadav launched a fresh offensive against Chief Minister Nitish Kumar on Saturday, accusing him of failing Bihar over the last two weeks. Speaking ahead of the INDIA Bloc meeting, Tejashwi said that seat-sharing discussions would be the top priority in Saturday's deliberations.

"We all sit together in meetings and talk. This time, the most important issue will be seat sharing," he said.

Tejashwi slammed Nitish Kumar's long tenure, claiming, "Crime has increased, the education and health system has collapsed, and corruption is at its peak. What have those who have been in power for 20 years done? And when I make promises, these people only copy them. It makes no difference."

On the NDA's recent pension hike, he said, "Why was the pension not increased by more than Rs 400 for 20 years? Now, when we say it, the same promises are repeated."



Vijay Kumar Chaudhary's allegation of fake forms being filled under the RJD's Maan Behan Samman Yojana, Tejashwi countered.

"This allegation is baseless. Forms are being filled out through the Public Education Department with full security. Their ground has slipped, that's why they are saying such things."

Taking a dig at PM Narendra Modi after US President Donald Trump praised him, Tejashwi quipped: "Is the tariff going to increase here by 50 to 70 per cent now?"

The RJD leader also sharpened his attack on the state of education. He alleged that 20 vocational courses running in Patna University two decades ago had been discontinued under Nitish-Modi rule, and this has happened due to a lack of teachers, labs, libraries, grants, and placement facilities.

Vaishnav: GST reforms likely to add Rs 20 lakh crore to country's GDP

Union minister Ashwini Vaishnaw on Saturday expressed the hope that if due to the Goods and Services Tax (GST) reforms, that would kick in from Navratri's beginning September 22, the consumption would increase by up to 10 percent, it will add around Rs 20 lakh crore to the nation's GDP.

Addressing a press conference at the BJP headquarters, Vaishnaw said, "This GST reform will further push India's economy." Elaborating on the extent of the perceived gains, he said, "Our GDP is currently at Rs 3.30 lakh crore, of which Rs 2.02 lakh crore is our consumption. Even if our consumption rises by 10%, we will have Rs 20 lakh crore extra consumption, contributing to the GDP."

The union minister said the Next-Gen GST reforms, first spoken about by Prime Minister Narendra Modi during his Independence Day speech and then announced by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on September 3, have provided "immediate relief" and a great gift to middle-class families."

BIGGEST REFORM

Farmers are set to benefit with tractor tyres and parts moving from 18% to 5%, and tractors themselves from 12% to 5%. The healthcare sector, too, has received significant relief, with individual health and life insurance policies now fully exempt from GST. Medical products including thermom-

eters, oxygen, diagnostic kits, reagents, glucometers and test strips will be taxed at 5% instead of 12%, while corrective spectacles also fall under the 5% slab. Education items such as maps, charts, globes, pencils, sharpeners, crayons and pastels are now fully exempt, with notebooks, exercise books and erasers also shifted to the nil slab.

has brought significant relief to the lives of 1.4 billion citizens of our country". He insisted that "before 2014, there was such a web of taxes that multiple types of taxes were imposed on every item... which placed a huge burden on ordinary families, the common man, and middle-class families. Today, the way the Prime Minister and Finance Minister have reformed GST will have a positive impact on the lives of every individual."

The union minister insisted that the tax pressure on "roti, kapda, and makaan... all three has been reduced."

He said the GST rate changes which involve both rationalisation and improvement in procedures seek to simplify the tax system and boost the economy.
