4-year-old's finger gets stuck in bench at railway station, inquiry launched

Railway, fire, and emergency staff and doctors were on their toes to free the child's finger amid tense moments

AS A FOUR-YEAR-OLD was grievously injured on Sunday morning when her finger got stuck in the perforation of a steel bench at the Vadodara Railway Junction, the freak accident had the railway officials, fire and emergency services staff, and the doctors at SSG Hospital on their toes to free the child's finger and give her medical treatment. An inquiry has been initiated into the incident.

The young girl was rushed to the SSG Hospital after fire officials used a cutter to remove the part of the bench plate where the finger got stuck. At the SSG Hospital, several initial attempts to release her finger in the emergency ward failed. She was administered general anaesthesia and rushed into an operation theatre in a bid to prevent gangrene, officials said.

Dr Pulkit Maniyar, Associate Professor and Head of E-Unit, Orthopaedics, told *The Indian Express*, "The child was brought into the emergency ward between 7.30 and 8 am. According to her parents, the incident occurred at around 6.30 am when the child was playing at the station, where they had been waiting after their arrival. When her right index finger got stuck, the

parents as well as the railway staff, and then the fire officials tried to remove it but it only resulted in aggravating the wound further as the blood supply was disrupted due to constriction. The fire officials had cut out a part of the bench to bring the child to the hospital but we advised them to further reduce the metal to the size of a one-inch ring around the finger."

When attempts to free the child's finger failed in the emergency ward, Dr Maniyar added, it was decided to rush her into surgery. "Our priority was to remove the constriction as soon as possible so that it does not lead to necrosis or gangrene. We decided to administer general anaesthesia to the child and conduct the procedure which took about 45 minutes... Around 9.45 am, we removed the metal constriction from around her finger by using specialised metal cutters..." he said.

According to the hospital, the parents of the child, who hail from Haryana's Gurugram, chose to seek a discharge on Sunday afternoon to return home. "The parents arrived in Vadodara on Sunday to appear for competitive exams and were keen on returning to Gurugram. Since the wound was not life-threatening, we discharged the child although as per protocol, we prefer to keep a patient of GA

under 24 hours observation... As far as the injury is concerned, the child should recover within a week with ice application and medicines prescribed. Any constriction that lasts longer than six hours can give rise to gangrene, which luckily was not the case here," Dr Maniyar said.

Railway officials said that the mother of the child was appearing for the Central Teachers' Eligibility Test while the father had to appear for a test to pursue Masters in Business Administration. The couple was residing in Vadodara earlier when they chose their examination centres. On Sunday, the fire officers helped the mother reach her examination centre in time after the successful procedure was conducted on the child at SSG Hospital while the father appeared for his online test from the hospital.

An inquiry into the incident has been initiated. "We have these perforated benches installed across the Western Railways zone; we have not come across such complaints. However, since this accident has occurred, we are inquiring into it in order to decide the further steps as far as passenger safety is concerned," Jitendra Singh, Divisional Railway Manager, Vadodara, told *The Indian Express*.

Tathya's father denied interim bail in ISKCON Bridge accident case

AN AHMEDABAD DISTRICT court Monday refused to grant temporary bail to the father of the key accused in the SG Highway accident case that killed nine people last month.

The plea moved by Nilam Patel, the wife of key accused Pragnesh Patel, sought that her husband be released on temporary bail for 30 days as he "is suffering from cancer since long and his treatment is going on in Mumbai" and he has to go to Tata Memorial Hospital every month for his treatment. Nilam also submitted that she is "in a helpless condition in the absence of her son and husband."

Her son Tathya Patel — the driver of the Jaguar that mowed down nine persons and injured 13 others on the ISKCON Bridge — is the other key accused in the case. The court of principal district judge DM Vyas rejected the temporary bail plea after taking into account the opinion of the resident medical officer of the Gujarat Cancer and Research Institute (GCRI) who had stated that the treatment is available at the institute. The court also directed GCRI to provide necessary treatment and produce a medical report of the accused within 10 days. Opposing the grant of the temporary bail, the investigating officer submitted before the court that Pragnesh had previously taken treatment on November 4, 2019 "and for the last three years and nine months... has not taken

any treatment". It was further pointed out that there is no evidence that any physical check-up of the accused was conducted at the Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai after February 2019.

It was also submitted that the appointment slip dated May 15 fixing an appointment at Tata Memorial Hospital for August 23, as produced by Nilam, appears to be "a doubtful one and appears to have been produced with an intention to get temporary bail". It was also pointed out that in the regular bail application, filed earlier and rejected by the Ahmedabad district court, there was no mention of such ailment.

Both Pragnesh and Tathya are facing charges under sections 279 (rash driving), 337 and 338 (hurt and grievous hurt caused by rash and negligent act), 304 (culpable homicide not amounting to murder), 308 (attempt to commit culpable homicide), 504 (intentional insult with intent to provoke breach of peace), 506 (2) (criminal intimidation), 114 (abatement) and 188 (disobedience to order promulgated by public servant) of the Indian Penal Code. They have also been charged under sections 177 (breaking traffic laws), 184 (dangerous driving) and 134 (b) (duty of driver in case of accident and injury to a person) of the Motor Vehicle Act.

Number of financed private projects in Gujarat plateaued over last 2 yrs: RBI bulletin

THE NUMBER of private projects financed by banks and other financial institutions in Gujarat has plateaued over the last two financial years, highlights a bulletin published by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) this month.

While Gujarat stands only second to Uttar Pradesh as far as the total cost of projects funded by banks and financial institutions (FI) is concerned, the RBI bulletin underlines that 82 projects in Gujarat got funds sanctioned from banks in 2022-23, which is similar to the number of projects that got funding the previous financial year (2021-22). In comparison, there is an increase in number of projects in larger states like Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra, Karnataka and Odisha, that have got similar support from banks and FIs.

The data, which is part of an article titled "Private Corporate Investment: Performance and Near-term Outlook", also reveals that the highest number

of private projects to get bank funding in Gujarat in a single financial year was in 2016-17 at 102. The authors of this article are from the government's Department of Statistics and Information Management. The RBI bulletin, carrying the article, stated the study focused exclusively on projects that received funding from banks, FIs, ECBS (external commercial borrowing), and IPOs.

Projects costing Rs 10 crore and more, and where majority ownership lies with private companies, have been taken into account. Projects with central or state government majority holding and those initiated by trusts and educational institutions have also been excluded from the scope of the study. A total of

547 projects across the country got assistance from banks and FIs during 2022-23 with a record-high total project cost of Rs 2.66 lakh crore, compared to 401 projects with a project cost of Rs 1.42 lakh crore in 2021-22.

"The state-wise distribution revealed that the top five states viz., Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat, Odisha, Maharashtra, and Karnataka, together account for 57.2 per cent share in total project cost during 2022-23, higher than 43.2 per cent share during 2021-22. In 2022-23, Uttar Pradesh accounted for the highest share (16.2 per cent) in the total cost of projects sanctioned by banks and FIs, followed by Gujarat, Odisha, Maharashtra, and Karnataka," states the bulletin.

"The share of Uttar Pradesh and Odisha in the total cost of projects improved significantly from the previous year as well as the average share recorded during the period 2013-14 to 2020-21," it added. However, if only the number of projects are taken into account, then Gujarat has the highest number of projects that have received funding from banks during this period.

PM Modi degree row: Ahmedabad court adjourns hearing on Kejriwal, Singh's review pleas to Sept 16

AN AHMEDABAD court Monday adjourned two revision applications that challenged and sought to quash the summons issued against Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and AAP MP Sanjay Singh by a magistrate court in relation to a criminal defamation complaint filed against both by the Registrar of Gujarat University in the case

linked to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's degree.

The adjournment was granted following a request from Gujarat University. Advocate Amit Nair, on behalf of the varsity, submitted that the plea by

the two accused has been recorded and kept for evidence in the criminal defamation case before the Ahmedabad magistrate. The submission further stated that the advocate has only filed his vakalatnama Monday.

The matter will be taken up next by the court of sessions judge AV Hirpara on September 16. Meanwhile, Kejriwal and Singh moved applications before the sessions court Monday seeking expeditious hearing of the revision applications. They submit-

ted that matters pertaining to MPs or MLAs are to be prioritised and heard expeditiously. The court has reserved its decision on these applications for Tuesday, said advocate Aum Kotwal.

The defamation complaint, moved by Registrar Piyush Patel, has accused Kejriwal and Singh of defamation based on their statements to the media in response to the Gujarat High Court's decision to set aside an order of the Central Information Commission that had directed the Gujarat

University to "search for information" regarding Prime Minister Narendra Modi's degrees.

According to the complaint, the statement was made before the media and broadcast through Twitter, now X, with the intention of damaging the reputation of the university, despite knowing that such utterances would be defamatory. According to Patel, Kejriwal made defamatory utterances at a press conference on April 1 and Singh before the media on April 2.
