No chappal throwing on devotees, warns HC

FPJ News Service CHENNAI

The Madras High Court recently observed that preserving temple festivals is itself a constitutional value and that miscreants throwing chappals at devotees during religious processions must be dealt with "with an iron hand".

Justice L. Victoria Gowri of the Madurai Bench made the observation while directing the Madurai police to intensify security during the Chithirai Festival and prevent such acts during the Lord Kallazhagar ceremonial procession.

The Court added that throwing chappals at devotees during a divine procession could not be treated as ordinary disorderly conduct.

"Throwing chappals at devotees in the midst of a procession is not merely an act of disorder; it is an affront to faith, and an assault upon customary religious practice," the Court observed.

Vande Mataram insult to draw punishment

The Union Cabinet has approved a proposal to amend the Prevention of Insults to National Honour Act, 1971 to make any obstruction to the singing of the national song Vande Mataram a punishable offence.

This gives Vande Mataram the same statutory protection as the national anthem Jana Gana Mana.

The Act, at present, protects the national anthem, the national flag and the Constitution from any insults.

Burning, mutilating, defacing, trampling, etc., of the national flag or the Constitution or intentionally causing disturbance during the singing of the national anthem can attract a prison term of up to three years or a fine of both, according to the Act.

Officials said the proposed amendment to the Act, after Parliament's nod, will impose punishment on causing any

deliberate obstruction to the singing of Vande Mataram.

In January, the Union home ministry had directed that all six stanzas of the Vande Mataram, written by Bankim Chandra Chattopadhyay, shall be sung first when the national song and the national anthem are to be played together.

In the order, the ministry issued the first set of protocols for singing the national song, directing that six stanzas, totalling 3 minutes 10 seconds, shall be sung at official functions such as the arrival of the President, the unfurling of the tricolour, and governors' speeches.

"When the National Song and the National Anthem are sung or played, National Song will be sung or played first," the order read.

The assembly where the national song is sung shall stand in attention, it said.

In March, the Supreme Court refused to entertain a plea against the circular on singing of Vande Mataram at official events and schools,

saying the directive was not mandatory.

A bench of Chief Justice Surya Kant and justices Joymalya Bagchi and Vipul M Pancholi noted that there was no penal consequence prescribed for not singing the song and termed the plea as "premature".

The Centre is observing the 150th year of Vande Mataram.

Gor's 'strong ties' message before Rubio's visit to India

Ahead of Secretary of State Marco Rubio's visit to India, US envoy Sergio Gor on Wednesday said Washington deeply values its growing partnership with New Delhi and remains committed to build even stronger ties that will benefit both the nations and the world.

In a post on X, the US ambassador to India also shared an old photograph of him with Rubio.

"Looking forward to welcoming my good friend Secretary Rubio to India! The United States deeply values our growing partnership with India, and we are excited to build even stronger ties that will benefit both our nations and the world. See you soon, Mr. Secretary!" he posted.

In April, Gor said that Secretary Rubio looks forward to visiting India next month.

The announcement was made after Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri met Rubio at the White House.

"Welcome to the White House @VikramMisri! Productive meeting with @SecRubio that focused on our bilateral relationship, especially trade, critical minerals, defence and the Quad," Gor had posted on X.

India top in overseas remittances: Report

India is the world's top receiver of remittances from workers overseas, getting \$137.7 billion in 2024, up from \$83.2 billion in 2020, according to the International Organisation for Migration (IOM).

Overall, the IOM's International Migration Report for 2026 released here on Tuesday, said the US is the top source of remittances to all countries, sending out \$103.2 billion, followed by Saudi Arabia, a distant second, with \$46.6 billion.

The report said that South Asia was expected to have the highest growth in remittances, at 11.8 per cent in 2024.

The world's fifth-largest "migration corridor" -- or the direction of migration -- is from India to the United Arab Emirates (UAE) and is made up mainly of migrant workers, it said.

It said that there were more than 3 million Indians there -- the top nationality in the UAE. (A previous report gave a more precise number, 3.47 million in 2020).

The India to US migration came next, with about 3.2 million Indian migrants living there in 2024, making up the second largest foreign-born group after Mexicans.

"The number of international migrants from India has increased continuously and significantly over the last several decades, with many arriving in the United States as highly skilled workers or international students", the IOM said.

In Oceania, the second largest migrant route was from India to Australia, with about 876,000 Indians there.

India ranked second for students abroad, with over 620,000, the report said.

"When graduates return home", it said, "they can spur innovation, improve industry

practices and contribute to economic and social development".

The report emphasised the need for overcoming "mobility inequalities" through "geographic free-movement arrangements" for "safe, orderly and regular migration globally".

UP's 'I love Muhammad' man gets bail

The Allahabad High Court has granted bail to a man booked for allegedly posting on his Instagram handle that he could get his head severed and sever heads for "I Love Muhammad".

Granting bail to the accused Nadeem, a resident of Muzaffar Nagar, Justice Rajiv Lochan Shukla observed that the "supposed objectionable" post made by the applicant does not name any particular caste or community.

He was booked by Uttar Pradesh police last year for allegedly making sensitive remarks on his Instagram profile.

Appearing on behalf of the accused, his counsel argued that a charge sheet has been submitted and there is no likelihood of the trial being concluded in the near future. The accused has no criminal antecedents, he said.

Opposing the bail, the state counsel submitted that the accused had posted an "insensitive" comment saying "I love Muhammad ke hiye garden katwa bhi sakte hain aur kaat bhi sakte hain (For 'I love Muhammad', we can have our head severed and can sever heads too)".
