## **Artemis' Consolidated Revenue from Operations up 13.8% in Q2 (YoY); EBITDA up 17.2%; Net Profit up 35.6%**

November 11, 2025: The Board of Directors of Artemis Medicare Services Ltd today approved the company's financial results for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter (Jul to Sep) for the financial year 2025 – 26.

For the quarter ended September 30, 2025 Artemis Medicare Services Ltd, on a consolidated level, registered a revenue from operations of Rs 27,470 Lacs, an increase of 13.8% over the same period last fiscal year.
