It posted a net profit of ₹3,359 crore on revenues of ₹64,668 crore for the quarter, the company said in an exchange filing post market hours. The company booked orders worth ₹16,300 crore at the group level in the three months through December, up 53% from a year earlier and its highest on record for a quarter.

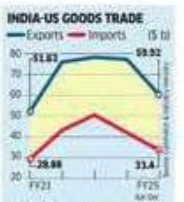

US and Japan reached a trade agreement regarding market access for certain agricultural and industrial goods. During a call with Modi on Monday, Trump "emphasised the importance of India increasing its procurement of American-made security equipment and moving toward a far bilateral trading relationship" according to a White House statement. India is also likely to seek investment commitments from the US similar to those in its trade pact with the European Free Trade Association (EFTA), which includes a binding commitment of investments worth \$50 billion and the creation of one million direct jobs in India by EFTA bloc companies. Trump's recent executive order on his administration's America First trade policy has prompted India to look at the potential of a limited trade agreement.

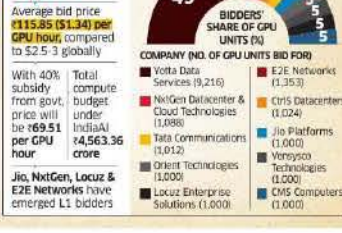

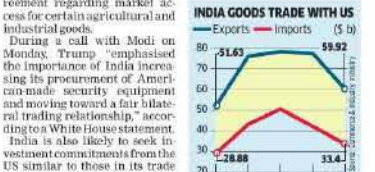

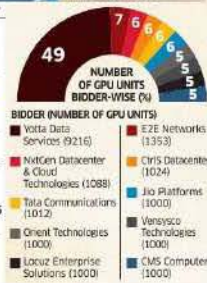
