Details of the Violation(s) / Contravention(s) committed or alleged to be committed	The Authority has alleged that the Company has erroneously been sanctioned refund under Section 54 of the CGST Act read with Rule 96(10) of the CGST Rules, in spite of the Company availing duty free imports under Advance Authorization.
5.	Impact on financial, operation or other activities of the listed entity, quantifiable in monetary terms to the extent possible.	In the opinion of the Company, the tax liability against the Company has been erroneously levied and hence is not maintainable.  The impact may be to the tune of Rs. 4,111.55 Lakh, payable along with interest thereon and penalty.  The Company proposes to challenge the said Show Cause Notice before the higher authority(ies) / court(s) within the prescribed time period.
