Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Para A of Part A of Schedule III of SEBI (Listing obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“Listing Regulations”), we wish to inform you that in the matter of complaint filed by CJ Holdings North America, LLC (“Plaintiff”) against the Company in the Oakland County Circuit Court, State of Michigan, the Oakland County Circuit Court has passed the Judgment on February 17, 2026 which received to the Company on February 18, 2026.

The brief details of the litigation was disclosed to the Stock Exchanges on November 20, 2024 at the time of institution of complaint by the Plaintiff. The litigation is concluded at Circuit Court, State of Michigan and the disclosure is being provided below pursuant to Regulation 30 of the Listing Regulations read with SEBI Circular No. SEBI/ HO/49/14/14(7)2025-CFD-POD2/I/3762/2026 dated January 30, 2026:

The Circuit Court entered Judgment in favor of the Plaintiff in the amount of USD 1,037,903.38, plus simple interest of 6% per annum and compounded default interest of</p>

		<p>0.50% per month to be accrued on this Amount and attorney fees.</p> <p>This Judgments is passed by the court in non-reciprocating territories is not directly executable in India and is subject to a fresh judicial process in India by way of institution of fresh suit as per the jurisdictional and procedural rules applicable to original suit under CPC. The Company is analyzing the judgment and framing the further strategy including domestication process of foreign judgement.</p>
