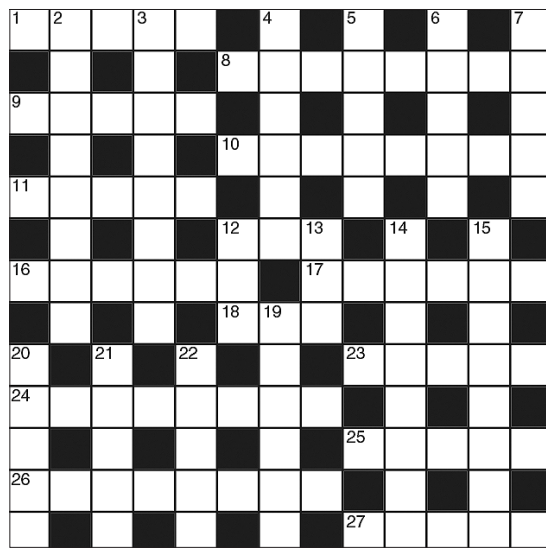

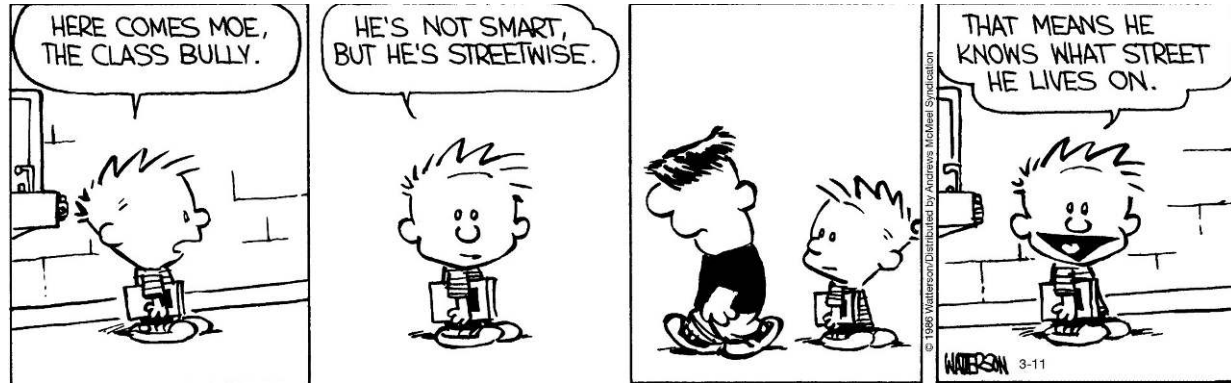

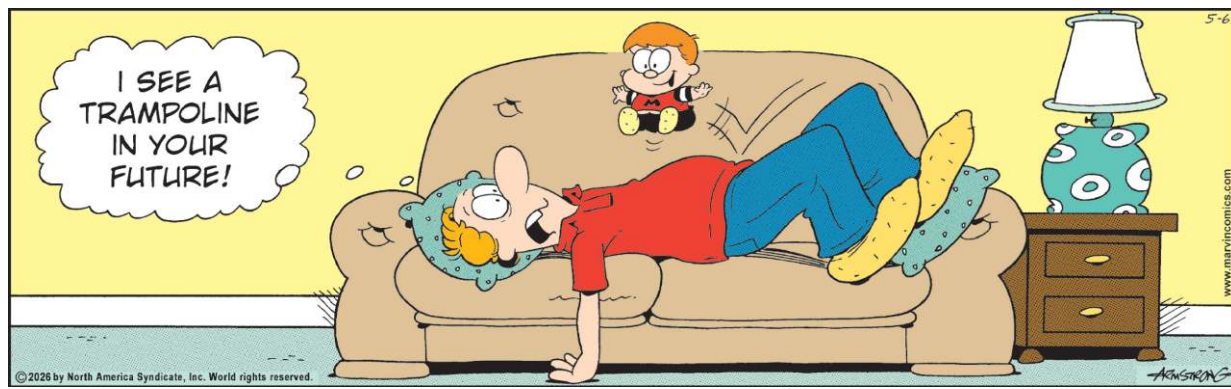

Remote e-voting and e-voting during AGM
 Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Act and Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended and Regulation 44 of the SEBI Listing Regulations, the Members are provided with the facility to cast their votes on all resolutions as set forth in the Notice convening the AGM using electronic voting system ("Remote e-voting") provided by CDSL. The voting rights of Shareholders shall be in proportion to the equity shares held by them in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on **Tuesday, June 30, 2026. (cut-off date)**.
