

AWL Signs MoU with SEA and Solidaridad to Lead National Mustard Model Farm Initiative, a step towards Aatmanirbhar Bharat

- ~ *The agreement, signed for two years, will be effective from September 2025 to August 2027*~
- ~ *Leads sponsorship to establish 3,000 model farms across key mustard-growing states* ~

Mumbai, September 24, 2025: AWL Agri Business Ltd. (AWL), one of India's leading agri-business and FMCG companies, today announced its partnership with the **Solvent Extractors' Association of India (SEA)** and **Solidaridad Regional Expertise Centre (SREC)** to advance the **Regenerative Mustard Mission – Sustainable Mustard Farm Project**.
