# India, Maldives sign two currency swap agreements

Two nations agree to discuss FTA

New Delhi, 7 October

Confronted with the prospect of a debt crisis and repayment of past loans from China, visiting Maldivian President Mohamed Muizzu on Monday thanked India for its offer of financial assistance to the Indian Ocean archipelago. The two countries also agreed to discuss a bilateral free trade agreement (FTA).

India extended two currency swap agreements to the Maldives, including an agreement worth \$400 million and another worth ₹3,000 crore, to help the island nation's access to foreign currency. The two countries also adopted a comprehensive economic and maritime security partnership, which has added a strategic dimension to the bilateral ties, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said after his talks with the visiting leader.

Modi and Muizzu launched the RuPay card in the Maldives, virtually inaugurated the new runway at the Hanimaadhoo

International Airport, and agreed to further strengthen bilateral relations that had hit a rocky patch last year. "In the future, we will work to connect India and the Maldives through the Unified Payments Interface as well," Modi said.

The island nation's debt is

estimated at 110 per cent of its gross domestic product. Earlier this year, India had come to the assistance of the Maldives by agreeing to roll over the treasury Bills subscribed by State Bank of India amounting to \$100 million in May and September for a further period of one year.

"I am thankful to the Indian government for providing support in the form of ₹3,000 crore, in addition to the \$400 million bilateral currency swap agreement, which will be instrumental in addressing the foreign exchange (forex) issues we are facing right now," Muizzu said after wide-ranging talks with Modi at Hyderabad House here.

"Yaarana jaari rahega (friendly ties will continue)," Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri said later at a briefing when asked how India managed to bridge the sharp divide in the bilateral ties that had emerged last year.

Muizzu, on a five-day visit to India, his first after winning the presidential election last year on the back of a campaign that sought to curb New Delhi's influence in the island nation's affairs, phrased 'India Out', and strived to draw closer to Beijing. He had also asked New Delhi to withdraw its military personnel posted in the archipelago nation by May this year.

The Indian foreign secretary said that the relationship between India and the Maldives was based on several substantive pillars.

Leaders in J&K trade barbs over electoral process ahead of results today

With almost all exit polls predicting a Congress win in Haryana, the party's Sira MP Kumari Selja on Monday indicated that she was in the race to be the chief minister. She added that the decision of the Congress high command would be final. Former CM Bhupinder Singh Hooda said he was "neither tired nor retired", and that the final decision of the high command on the CM pick will be acceptable to all.

In Jammu and Kashmir, exit polls have predicted a hung Assembly, with the National Conference-Congress alliance likely to fall short of the majority. On the eve of the counting, the Congress alleged that the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) was taking 'malicious steps' through a 'malafide exercise of power' to negate the people's verdict. On the possible nomination of five MLAs by the Lieutenant Governor, Congress state unit chief Tariq Hameed Karra and Peoples Democratic Party (PDP)'s Iltija Mufti said that would amount to 'rigging the poll results'.

NC leader Omar Abdullah said Lok Sabha member Sheikh Abdul Rashid's suggestion for delaying government formation till restoration of statehood was playing into the hands of the BJP.

# Rural women facilitate business worth ₹27K cr

Lucknow, 7 October

Enterprising women business correspondents, known as BC Sakhis, have facilitated transactions worth ₹27,000 crore in Uttar Pradesh, earning ₹75 crore in commission over the past four and a half years.

BC Sakhis, appointed under the nationwide women empowerment programme, are members of self-help groups (SHGs) who are trained and certified to provide banking and financial services in rural areas.

Since the programme's official launch in May 2020, nearly 40,000 BC Sakhis have played a pivotal role in driving financial inclusion in the unbanked and under-banked regions of Uttar Pradesh, a senior state government official said. There were 36,000 BC Sakhis in the state in September 2023.

Uttar Pradesh leads the nation in the number of BC Sakhis, followed by Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan with nearly 19,000 and 10,000 correspondents, respectively.

The initiative, which operates in partnership with various banks, such

as State Bank of India, Bank of Baroda, and Union Bank, provides livelihood opportunities for literate women in rural areas while offering doorstep banking services in the absence of physical bank branches. Women from families of ex-servicemen, bankers, and teachers are given priority when being recruited as BC Sakhis.

The programme is credited by the central government with keeping the non-performing assets (NPAs) of women SHGs down compared to the overall NPAs of the public-sector banks. The central government aims to appoint at least one BC Sakhi in each of India's nearly 250,000 gram panchayats.

Earlier this year, Union Rural Development Minister Giriraj Singh had said institutional finance and interest waivers for women SHGs have improved loan repayment rates. Since 2013-14, SHGs have accessed ₹6.96 trillion in bank credit, according to the Union ministry.

Under the National Rural Livelihood Mission, the government is prioritising financial literacy for women.

Muizzu, on a five-day visit to India, his first after winning the presidential election last year on the back of a campaign that sought to curb New Delhi's influence in the island nation's affairs, phrased 'India Out', and strived to draw closer to Beijing. He had also asked New Delhi to withdraw its military personnel posted in the archipelago nation by May this year.

The Indian foreign secretary said that the relationship between India and the Maldives was based on several substantive pillars.

Leaders in J&K trade barbs over electoral process ahead of results today

With almost all exit polls predicting a Congress win in Haryana, the party's Srisa MP Kumari Selja on Monday indicated that she was in the race to be the chief minister. She added that the decision of the Congress high command would be final. Former CM Bhupinder Singh Hooda said he was "neither tired nor retired", and that the final decision of the high command on the CM pick will be acceptable to all.

In Jammu and Kashmir, exit polls have predicted a Hindu Assembly, with the National Conference-Congress alliance likely to fall short of the majority. On the eve of the counting, the Congress alleged that the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) was taking 'malicious steps' through a 'malafide exercise of power' to negate the people's verdict. On the possible nomination of five MLAs by the Lieutenant Governor, Congress state unit chief Tariq Hameed Karra and Peoples Democratic Party (PDP)'s Iltija Mufti said that would amount to 'rigging the poll results'.

NC leader Omar Abdullah said Lok Sabha member Sheikh Abdul Rashid's suggestion for delaying government formation till restoration of statehood was playing into the hands of the BJP.

## Rural women facilitate business worth ₹27K cr

Lucknow, 7 October

Enterprising women business correspondents, known as BC Sakhis, have facilitated transactions worth ₹27,000 crore in Uttar Pradesh, earning ₹75 crore in commission over the past four and a half years.

BC Sakhis, appointed under the nationwide women empowerment programme, are members of self-help groups (SHGs) who are trained and certified to provide banking and financial services in rural areas.

Since the programme's official launch in May 2020, nearly 40,000 BC Sakhis have played a pivotal role in driving financial inclusion in the unbanked and under-banked regions of Uttar Pradesh, a senior state government official said. There were 36,000 BC Sakhis in the state in September 2023.

Uttar Pradesh leads the nation in the number of BC Sakhis, followed by Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan with nearly 19,000 and 10,000 correspondents, respectively.

The initiative, which operates in partnership with various banks, such

as State Bank of India, Bank of Baroda, and Union Bank, provides livelihood opportunities for literate women in rural areas while offering doorstep banking services in the absence of physical bank branches. Women from families of ex-servicemen, bankers, and teachers are given priority when being recruited as BC Sakhis.

The programme is credited by the central government with keeping the non-performing assets (NPAs) of women SHGs down compared to the overall NPAs of the public-sector banks. The central government aims to appoint at least one BC Sakhi in each of India's nearly 250,000 gram panchayats.

Earlier this year, Union Rural Development Minister Giriraj Singh had said institutional finance and interest waivers for women SHGs have improved loan repayment rates. Since 2013-14, SHGs have accessed ₹6.96 trillion in bank credit, according to the Union ministry.

Under the National Rural Livelihood Mission, the government is prioritising financial literacy for women.
