**Sub: Disclosure under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements), Regulations 2015- Demand Notices received from State Authorities of Jharkhand and Interim Order of Revisional Authority**

Dear Sir/Madam,

This is in continuation to the disclosures made in the Offer Document of the Company and financial statements, in relation to demand notices amounting to ₹ 17,344.46 Crores in respect of 47 Projects/Mines/Collieries pursuant to the judgment dated August 02, 2017 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. (Civil) No. 114 of 2014 (Common Cause vs. Union of India & Ors.).

The earlier demand notices were challenged by the Company and were set aside vide order dated November 03, 2022 passed by the Joint Secretary & Revisional Authority, Ministry of Coal under Section 30 of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957.

Subsequently, fresh demand notices/show cause proceedings have been initiated on various dates by the State Authorities of Jharkhand in respect of the aforesaid matters.

Aggrieved by the same, the Company has filed Revision Applications Nos. 42-48, 50-75 & 84-97 of 2026 before the Revisional Authority, Ministry of Coal.

The Revisional Authority, vide order dated April 29, 2026, has admitted the said Revision Applications and directed the Respondents/State Authorities of Jharkhand not to take any coercive action against the Company pursuant to the impugned notices pending further proceedings.
