Rolls-Royce unveils road map for India

New Delhi, 12 February

A day after meeting Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Rolls-Royce CEO Tufan Erginbilgic on Thursday unveiled a strategic road map to scale up the company's Indian operations across defence, energy and civil aviation domains including plans to co-develop an aero-engine for India's next-generation combat jets with full intellectual property transfer.

Under the initiative, Rolls Royce is looking at more than doubling the size of its workforce to approximately 10,000 people in India and a 10-fold increase in local supply chain sourcing with a long-term goal to position the country as a global hub for its high-tech manufacturing.

"As we grow our participation in programmes across India's defence, aviation and energy sectors, we will expand our ecosystem in India, as we have done successfully in other countries," Erginbilgic said.

Besides meeting the Prime Minister, Erginbilgic also held separate talks with National Security Advisor Ajit Doval and Commerce Minister Piyush Goyal.

"We welcome Rolls-Royce's enthusiasm towards scaling up



its activities in India and partnering with our innovative and dynamic youth," Modi said on social media last night.

The leading aero-engine maker has been focusing on making India its third 'home market' outside of the UK in line with its strategy to unlock the full potential of opportunities in development of jet engine, naval propulsion, land systems and advanced engineering.

"Our ambitions for India are built on the strong foundations of our decades-long presence in the country, our growing footprint, our deep industrial partnerships, and our competitively advantaged technologies," the Rolls-Royce CEO said.

"We are determined to partner India on its remarkable journey, by developing indigenous propulsion ca-

abilities, providing sustained power to critical infrastructure and industry, and expanding local manufacturing for global supply chains." Among the major defence projects, Rolls-Royce has been eyeing to develop a next-generation aero engine in India as a priority to power the combat jets that New Delhi will produce under the Advanced Medium Combat Aircraft (AMCA) programme.

Rolls-Royce with the UK government, has offered to co-develop a 120 kN class combat jet engine core that could be India's fastest route to an indigenous next-generation engine. The co-development will provide full technology transfer with IP (intellectual property) ownership for India, supported by a dedicated design complex and manufacturing capabilities.

Mahindra LMM bets big on e-rickshaws as Udo launch aims next EV growth phase

Mahindra Last Mile Mobility (LMM) is sharpening its focus on the fast-evolving e-rickshaw and electric three-wheeler market, with the launch of its new electric autrickshaw, Mahindra Udo, marking a step in the company's growth strategy.

Positioned as a mass-market product, the Udo ties in with LMM's belief that headroom exists in last-mile electrification, driven largely by the conversion of vehicles running on the internal-combustion engine (ICE) into electric vehicles (EVs), and the e-rickshaw segment becoming formalised.

Suman Mishra, managing director and chief executive officer, Mahindra LMM, said e-rickshaws had more than a 60 per cent share in the market for electric vehicles. This made the segment a natural growth engine for organised original equipment manufacturers (OEMs), Mishra said.

LMM expects the electrification rate among three-wheelers to rise to 55-60 per cent by 2030 from 35 per cent at present.



Suman Mishra, MD & CEO, Mahindra Last Mile Mobility, said e-rickshaws had over a 60 per cent share in the market for EVs.

"That indicates significant headroom for growth, which will come primarily from ICE-to-EV conversion," Mishra said. This transition, she noted, is shaping product strategy, including the launch of the Udo with a higher

range, improved driveability and more features than existing offers.

Range anxiety remains one of the biggest adoption barriers, especially for cargo and passenger operators.

"Once you cross the 200-km mark, the psychology changes," Mishra said.

"Even if customers use 150 km, they still feel comfortable knowing there is sufficient reserve."

Contrary to popular perception, Mishra said EV adoption in this category was not limited to metros. "These vehicles do not require fancy charging infrastructure. Shared parking and home charging make EV adoption easier in semi-urban and rural areas," she said.

With no immediate capacity constraints and a new battery plant at Zaheerabad (Telangana) capable of scaling up to 200,000 vehicles annually, LMM is positioning itself to ride the next phase of growth in e-rickshaws and electric three-wheelers — starting with the Udo.

"As the largest commercial EV player in the country, with over 300,000 EVs on the road, we believe this product truly represents the future of last-mile

mobility in India," Mishra said.

In the e-rickshaw space, LMM sees an additional structural shift underway — from lead-acid batteries to lithium-ion. "This category has traditionally been lead-acid-based, but it is now steadily transitioning towards lithium-ion batteries," Mishra said, pointing to regulatory notifications mandating higher manufacturing standards and lithium-ion adoption over the next two years.

A faster charging time of four to five hours and improved reliability are accelerating this shift, even as the segment remains fragmented with many unorganised players.

As regulatory enforcement strengthens, Mishra expects greater formalisation. "As the category becomes more organised, it will open up opportunities to introduce better and more reliable products," she said. At a strategic level, LMM plans to grow its overall volumes sixfold by 2030 and electricity at least 50 per cent of its portfolio.

LMM sells a range of electric vehicles, including the Treo portfolio, Zor Grand and e-Alpha.

India 2nd-largest active installed base of smartphones globally

India has the second-largest active installed base of smartphones in the world, behind only China, according to a yet-to-be-released Counterpoint Research report based on 2025 data.

The country has an active installed base of over 740 million smartphones, more than half of its population of 1.45 billion.

Unlike shipment data, the active installed base reflects device longevity, user retention, and ecosystem loyalty, capturing the cumulative impact of years of sales combined with longer replacement cycles in mature markets.

India accounts for 14 per cent of the global installed base of smartphones. China remains at the top with a 19 per cent share, translating into around 1,005 million devices.

The total global active installed base of smartphones in 2025 is pegged at 5.285 billion.

In India, the average smartphone retention period currently stands at 42 months, slightly lower than the global average of 47 months.

In terms of brand leadership, the company with the largest active installed base in India is Chinese smartphone maker Xiaomi. This comes despite the company having lost market share in recent years as it shifted from its original strat-

egy of affordable, high-volume devices to a greater focus on the premium segment.

A senior Counterpoint executive said Xiaomi's older Redmi and Note series are still widely in use, having had long shelf lives before users upgraded.

Xiaomi's installed base also includes Poco, positioned as a budget-to-mid-range brand targeting young, tech-savvy consumers, which helped maintain volume.

Globally, Xiaomi has the third-largest active installed base of smartphones. Only two brands — Apple Inc. and Samsung — have crossed the 1 billion mark. Together, they control 44 per cent of the global

active installed base, with Apple accounting for one in every four active smartphones worldwide.

Eight brands have active installed bases exceeding 200 million units globally: Apple, Samsung, Xiaomi, Oppo (including OnePlus), Vivo, Honor, Transsion (which includes Tecno, Infinix), and

Huawei. Collectively, these brands control over 80 per cent of the global smartphone installed base.

Three other brands — Motorola, Realme, and Google — remain below the 200 million mark, though Motorola and Realme are close to reaching that milestone.

IDfy raises ₹476 cr to fund acquisitions

Risk and identity infrastructure platform IDfy has raised ₹476 crore in a Series F funding round led by Neo Asset Management and existing investors to fund the company's inorganic growth.

The freshly raised capital will be deployed towards ac-

quisitions and expanding presence in key international markets, said Ashok Hartharan, cofounder and chief executive officer, IDfy.

The funding round was a mix of primary and secondary, with existing investors such as Blume Ventures, Analog Capital, Elev8, Indiv-MART, and Kae Capital, participating in the round.

Backers such as Transnexus, Dream Incubator, early angel investors and existing and previous employees were part of the secondary in this round.

"We are not looking at it purely from how would it integrate into our products and how would those products fundamentally get enhanced," Hartharan told *Business Standard*.
