**NOTES:** (1) The National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) Indore Bench at Ahmedabad vide order dated 17th September 2020 (Insolvency Commencement Date) has initiated Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process (CIRP) u/s 9 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 (The Code) based on the application filed by an operational creditor of the Company, Mr. Navin Khandewal IP No. IBB/19A-001/IP-P00703/2017-18/11301 was appointed as an Interim Resolution Professional (IRP) to manage affairs of the Company in accordance with the provision of Code. Pursuant to the NCLT order for commencement of the CIRP and in line with the provision of the Code, the power of the Board of Directors stand suspended and is exercised by the IRP. Subsequently, Mr. Naveen Kumar Sood IP No. IBB/19A-001/IP-P00132/2017-18/10274 in place of Mr. Navin Khandewal IP No. IBB/19A-001/IP-P00703/2017 has been appointed as RP vide NCLT order no. 1A/12(1ND)2021 in CP/IB/9 of 2020 dated 28th January, 2021. Therefore, the above results were reviewed by the Management and the RP. These financial results for the quarter year ended 30th June 2022 have been prepared by the management of the Company in accordance with Regulation 33(2) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Rules, 2015. These unaudited financial results were placed before the Board of Directors in its meeting held on 9th August, 2022 for their consideration. Accordingly, the unaudited financial results were considered and recommended in the meeting. In the view thereof, the RP in reliance of such representations, clarification and explanation provided by the Management has approved the same. To the extent, these unaudited financial results indicate or confirm of events prior to the appointment of the Resolution Professional i.e. CIRP commencement date, the confirmation is being provided by the Management. The resolution professional is relying on the management representation for all information and confirmation in relation to the day to day functioning of the Company. The RP has approved these unaudited financial results only to the limited extent of discharging the powers of the Board of Directors of the company (suspended during CIRP) which has been conferred upon him in terms of provisions of Section 17 of the Code. (2) In accordance with the Code, public announcement was made calling the financial and operational creditors of the Company to submit their claims with RP / IRP. Accordingly, IRP / RP had collated the claims submitted by the creditors and reconciled the same with the accounts. Till the final outcome of CIRP process, no accounting impact in the books of accounts has been made for an excess, short or non-receipt of claims for operational and financial creditors (3) The carrying value of property plant and equipment and intangible as at 30th June 2022 is Rs. 13,937.09 lacs and 5.85 lacs respectively. As explained in note 1 above, the Company is under CIRP and accordingly resolution plans were invited from potential resolution applicants. Committee of Creditors ("CoC") has approved one of the resolution plans and the same has been submitted to NCLT for approval. The CIRP is not yet concluded and hence, the final outcome is not known. The Company has not taken in consideration any impact on the value of the asset, if any, in preparation Financial Results as required by IND AS 10 on "Event after the Reporting Period". The Company has not made assessment of impairment as required by IND AS 36 on Impairment of Assets, if any as at 30th June, 2022 in the value of property plant and equipment and intangible assets. (4) The Company has not been able to obtain confirmations from various debtors, loans and advances from, trade and other payables. Accordingly, adjustments if any arising out of reconciliation with these parties is not readily available. The Company has carried out its internal assessment and accordingly provided/ written off/ back certain receivables/ payables/ loans and advances. (5) During the quarter the company has provided an interest amounting to Rs. 309.65 Lacs as per the sanction letter stipulation, however the bank has not provided the same. Therefore, there exists a difference with regards to aforesaid amount as per balance confirmation provided by the banks and books of accounts. (6) During the quarter the company has accrued interest income on Fixed Deposits with Axis Bank amounting to Rs. 5.65 Lacs, however the bank has not provided the same. Therefore, there exists a difference with regards to aforesaid amount as per balance confirmation provided by the banks and books of accounts. # Taiwan holds drills to counter China threat

AGENCIES / Pingtung (Taiwan)

Taiwan's foreign minister said on Tuesday that China is using military drills to rehearse an invasion of the self-governing island democracy, while Taiwan's military began its own live-fire exercises in a show of readiness to thwart off a potential attack.

Joseph Wu said Beijing aims to establish its dominance in the Western Pacific and annex Taiwan, which it claims as its own territory. That would include control of the East and South China Seas via the Taiwan Strait and preventing the US and its allies from aiding Taiwan, he told a news conference in Taipei.

China says its drills were prompted by the visit to the island last week by US House Speaker Nancy Pelosi, but Wu said China was using her trip as a pretext for intimidating moves it has long had in the works. China also banned some Taiwanese food imports after the visit and cut off dialogue

with the US on a range of issues from military contacts to combating transnational crime and climate change.

The US has no formal diplomatic ties with Taiwan in deference to Beijing, but is legally bound to ensure the island can defend itself and to treat all threats against it - including a block-

ade - as matters of grave concern. That leaves open the question of whether Washington would dispatch forces if China attacked Taiwan. President Joe Biden has said repeatedly the US was bound to do so, in comments swiftly walked back by his staff.

The exercises show Chi-

na's "geostrategic ambition beyond Taiwan," Wu said.

"China has no right to interfere in or alter" the Taiwanese people's democratic process or interaction with other nations, he said, adding that Taiwan and the mainland are separate jurisdictions with "neither subordinate to the other."

# China closes Potala Palace as Tibet sees Covid outbreak

Following a recent outbreak of Covid in the Himalayan region, Chinese authorities closed the famed Potala Palace, the residence of Lamas in Tibet, local media reported.

A notice on the palace's Weixin social media site said the palace that was the traditional home of Tibet's Buddhist leaders would be closed from Tuesday (Aug 9), with a reopening date to be announced later, Focus Taiwan reported.

Potala Palace is a popular tourist spot, which has a major contribution to the economy of Tibet.

The action underscores China's continued adherence to its "Zero-Covid" policy, mandating lockdowns, routine testing, quarantines and travel restrictions, even while most other countries have reopened.

While China claims that its hardline "Zero-Covid" policy has been successful in preventing large-scale hospitalisations and deaths, critics including

the World Health Organization have decried its impact on the economy and society and said it is out of step with the changing nature of the virus and new methods of prevention and treatment.

On Tuesday, the Chinese mainland reported 828 new Covid cases of domestic transmission.

Southwest China's Xizang (Tibet) Autonomous Region reported 22 cases on Sunday, marking the end of the region's 920-day record of no cases.

# Nepal bars entry of Covid-infected tourists from India

Nepal has stopped the entry of people coming from India who test positive for Covid after four Indian tourists were diagnosed with fatal coronavirus infection and were sent back, amid a sharp surge in the number of cases in the Himalayan nation.

The four Indian tourists had entered Nepal via the Jhulaghat border point in the Baidati district in Western Nepal.

Bipin Lekhak, Information officer at the Health Office in Baidati, said the four Indian nationals tested positive for Covid and were told to return to India. "We have also ramped up COVID-19 testing on Indians," said Lekhak.

Many Nepali citizens who returned from India have tested positive for COVID-19, he said, adding that the officials have halted those Indian tourists who have coronavirus infection from entering the country.

# Zoonotic Langya virus found in China, 35 infected

AGENCIES / Taipei

Zoonotic Langya virus has been found in China with 35 human cases reported so far, Taiwan's Centers for Disease Control (CDC) said and noted that Taipei would establish a nucleic acid testing method to identify the virus. The henipavirus, which has been found in Shandong and Henan provinces, can be transmitted from animals to humans, reported Taipei Times. Taiwan's CDC Deputy Director-General Chuang Jen-hsiang said human-to-human transmission of the virus has not been reported. However, at the same time he said that CDC has yet to determine whether the virus can be transmitted among humans and cautioned people to pay close attention to further updates about the virus.

Providing details of the serological survey conducted on domestic animals, he said that 2 per cent of the tested goats and 5 per cent of the tested dogs were positive.

The test results of 25 wild animal species suggest that the shrew (a small insectivorous mammal resembling a mouse) might be a natural reservoir of the Langya henipavirus, as the virus was found in 27 per cent of the shrew subjects, the CDC Deputy DG said. Moreover, a study titled "A Zoonotic Henipavirus in Febrile Patients in China" that was published in the New England Journal of Medicine on Thursday said that a new henipavirus associated with a fever-causing human illness was identified in China.

# Pakistan suspends TV channel

ISLAMABAD: Authorities in Pakistan suspended a mainstream television channel in what critics denounced as an illegal move to stifle media freedom in the country, the media reported. Private Pakistani cable operators were ordered by the Pakistan Electronic Media Regulatory Authority (PEMRA) to block the transmission of ARY News immediately "till further notice", VOA reported. The state regulator later sent a formal "show cause notice" to the broadcaster, accusing it of airing "false, hateful and seditious content".

# Israel troops kill 3 in West Bank raid

AGENCIES / Jerusalem

Israeli troops killed three Palestinians and wounded dozens in a shootout on Tuesday during an arrest raid in the city of Nablus in the occupied West Bank, the Palestinian Health Ministry said.

The shootout came a day after a ceasefire ended three days of fighting between Israel and the Palestinian Islamic Jihad militant group in the Gaza Strip.

Israeli police said security forces encircled the home of Ibrahim al-Nabulsi, who they say was wanted for a string of shootings in the West Bank earlier this year. They confirmed that al-Nabulsi and another Palestinian militant were killed in a shootout at the scene, and that troops found arms and explosives in his home. The Israeli military said

troops came under attack from Palestinians throwing rocks and explosives, and that soldiers responded with live fire. It confirmed Palestinians were shot, but did not elaborate on

their condition. Palestinian Health Ministry said 3 people were killed — al-Nabulsi, Islam Sabouh and Hussein Jamal Taha — and at least 40 were wounded.

# World must help Gaza civilians: Indian envoy to UN

NEW YORK: Expressing grave concern over the recent escalation across Gaza Strip, India's Permanent Representative to the United Nations Ruchira Kamboj said that the international community must keep providing humanitarian assistance to the civilian population in Gaza. "The delivery of humanitarian assistance to the Palestinian civilian population in Gaza must continue to remain the focus of the international community," the envoy said during a United Nations Security Council (UNSC) meet.

# First batch of Indian students to return 'soon': China

BEIJING: China on Tuesday said it has started the process for the return of Indian students stuck back home due to the Covid visa restrictions here and the first batch may arrive soon, raising hopes for the thousands of students waiting to rejoin their colleges in this country. "We are working intensively for the return of foreign students to China and this process for return of Indian students has begun," Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesman Wang Wenbin told media briefing here.

When asked about social media posts by some Chinese diplomats about opening of a new visa policy for all the foreign students soon.

"We believe we will see the return of the first batch of Indian students very soon and we will continue to pursue it with relevant work while ensuring the safety against Covid," Wang said.

Asked at what stage is the process of the list provided by the Indian Embassy here about the Indian students wanting to return, he said the relevant information will be released soon. China is currently processing the list of hundreds of Indian students wanting to return to the country to rejoin their colleges.

Over 23,000 Indian students, mostly studying medicine, are reportedly stuck back home due to Covid visa restrictions.
