Sub: Intimation under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015

In terms of Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and with reference to our earlier intimations dated 20th October 2023, 18th September 2024, 19th November 2024 and 25th July 2025, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) had directed BPCL to pay Environmental Compensation of Rs.1 crore for not installing Vapour Recovery Systems (VRS) at our Storage locations within the CPCB prescribed timelines i.e. by March 2024.

An appeal was filed with Hon'ble National Green Tribunal with a plea to issue an appropriate order quashing and setting aside the directions of CPCB. However, the Tribunal has asked BPCL to comply with CPCB directions, vide its order received on 7th April 2026 and pay Rs.1 Crore.

Further to the above, it is informed that VRS had been installed at all the 41 storage locations, as mandated by CPCB, by March 2025.
