The swinging sixties were the genesis of Goa's nightlife. In the late 1960s, the beaches of North Goa became a magnetic endpoint on the legendary Hippie Trail, drawing wanderers from across the globe to its moonlit shores. The state's first nightclub, Baghlaao, was set up on the crystal-white sands of Calangute beach. Then came Tito Henry D'Souza, who started modestly with live music evenings at his Baga home before going on to build Goa's first formal nightclub, Tito's, transforming the state's wild, organic nightlife into an institution.

The Night The Music Turned Off

For the next six decades, Goa's nightlife pulsed and grooved to everything from Bhangra to Shiva trance. Until Dec 6, 2025. That night, an inferno at Birch by Romeo Lane claimed 25 innocent lives and silenced the music. Preliminary investigations and eyewitness accounts suggest that electrical fireworks set off inside the club led to the blaze.

The fire has thrown a harsh spotlight on the murky underbelly of Goa's chaotic tourism industry, particularly the party culture known for celebrity-studded nights that roll straight into sunrise. Baga's Tito's Lane, a short 200-metre stretch, is a good example. Around 15 nightclubs are crammed into this short strip. While Tito's Lane is fairly well-

known, the larger nightclubs are perched along the cliffs of Ozran, Anjuna, Vagator and Arpora.

Beach Bonfires To Pyrotechnics

It is here that the transition from beach bonfires to pyrotechnics happened. The music scene evolved from techno to beats of Bollywood to finally take the shape of exotic dancers, electric fireworks, and fire dancers, turning the dance floor into a vulnerable tinderbox. With nightclubs jostling to pull in the biggest crowds, corners were cut, rules flouted, and norms shunned.

Till 2020, Goa had around 20 nightclubs, most built with brick and mortar. That number soon ballooned to over 200, including many illegal establishments operating under the guise of private shacks. Structures were built without occupancy certificates, licences were granted without proper scrutiny, and rent-seeking became the norm.

"These guys (owners) say that they want to open a restaurant and kitchen. But after they get the approval for a restaurant, they open a pub or a disco. Only when the fire NOC comes up for renewal is the change in occupancy identified. It then depends on the conscience of the regulators (what to do about it)," said Ashok Menon, chairman (operations) of the Fire & Security Association of India, and former director of Goa Fire Services.

High-Risk Tinderboxes

Panchayats allowed nightclubs in no-development zones, while the town and

country planning (TCP) department overlooked violations of the National Building Code. To stay within the letter of the law, club owners used grass, thatched roofs, bamboo sheets and wooden flooring to qualify as temporary structures in Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) and eco-sensitive areas.

"Fireworks without proper isolation distances present a severe and unacceptable fire risk," said Nitin Raiker, director of fire and emergency services.

Nightclubs, by design, are high-risk spaces. They use soundproofing foam, decorative drapes, and combustible materi-

Why Clubs Turn Into Death Traps

- Fireworks, electric pyrotechnics and fire dancers operate without safe isolation distances
- Dance floors turn into tinderboxes due to electric fireworks and open flames
- Soundproofing foam, decorative drapes and other combustible materials enable fire to spread rapidly
- Wooden interiors, false ceilings, thatched roofs, grass roofing and bamboo screens — often used to bypass CRZ rules — are highly flammable
- Single exit points and narrow passageways, created to maximise space or meet noise norms, become fatal bottlenecks
- Basement clubs lack natural ventilation and adequate escape routes
- Loud music, flashing lights, smoke machines, alcohol and low visibility delay reaction time
- Absence of sprinkler systems allows flames to spread unchecked
- Clubs operate without fire NOCs, occupancy certificates or structural safety clearances

What Must Change

- Ban indoor fireworks, pyrotechnics and fire performances, or strictly enforce isolation distances
- Enforce occupancy limits based on venue size and exits, with real-time monitoring
- Mandatory fire safety and evacuation training for all staff
- Clear, unobstructed pathways to all exits at all times
- Well-lit, illuminated exit signage visible even through smoke
- Smoke and fire detection systems linked to alarms that override music during emergencies
- Automatic sprinkler systems, emergency lighting and backup power for exit doors
- Immediate closure and penalties for violations
- Regular inspections to check fire norms, occupancy limits and misuse of licences

Fire and Emergency Services Act, any person intending to build a structure more than 15m high for business or commercial purposes must obtain a fire NOC. The Goa (Regulation of Land Development and Building Construction) Act, 2008, and regulations, 2010, stipulate the need for fire exits, ventilation, building codes, and access points. Most nightclubs fail to comply with these norms.

Many deadly nightclub fires have occurred in venues without automatic sprinkler systems. Research shows that automatic sprinklers are among the most effective in suppressing flames.

"Basements represent high-risk zones due to limited natural ventilation, delayed egress routes, and rapid

accumulation of toxic combustion products such as carbon monoxide, hydrogen cyanide, and carbon dioxide," noted the report by the Directorate of Fire and Emergency Services on the Birch fire.

Time and again, the high court stepped in to address sound pollution complaints. But the response was to convert open-air clubs into closed spaces, with narrow passageways and single exits designed to maximise commercial space and contain sound. This, said a fire station officer, is a perfect setup for disaster.

However, despite locals taking to the streets, authorities turned a blind eye as tourism is a major source of revenue for the state govt.
