Sub: Intimation under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015

In terms of Regulation 30(2) of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, and with reference to our earlier intimation dated 20th October 2023 and clarification dated 18th September 2024, we inform you that Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) has directed BPCL to pay Environmental Compensation of Rs.1 crore for not installing Vapour Recovery Systems (VRS) within the CPCB prescribed timelines.

Since the installation of VRS at all 28 locations as directed by CPCB is in progress and at advanced stages, BPCL shall be requesting CPCB to reconsider the direction for payment of environment compensation as above.
