Wheels India reports 4% rise in net profit, strong export demand drives growth

Chennai Aug 6: Wheels India Ltd. reported a 4% increase in net profit for the first quarter ended June 30, 2025, posting Rs. 26.44 crore compared to Rs.25.37 crore in the same period last year. Revenue for the quarter grew 9% year-on-year to Rs.1,187 crore, up from Rs.1,088 crore.

The company's export revenues saw a notable jump, rising to Rs.324 crore from Rs.259 crore in Q1 of the previous year, highlighting strong performance in international markets.

Commenting on the results, Srivats Ram, Managing Director of Wheels India, said, "The growth in revenue this quarter was primarily driven by demand from our export customers. Domestically, we also witnessed robust demand for our

air suspension systems, particularly from bus manufacturers." To strengthen its global footprint, Wheels India has established a new subsidiary in Europe with a share capital of 50,000 euros. This move is expected to bolster business

development efforts in the region. Speaking about the company's global strategy, Srivats Ram said, "Our subsidiaries in the US and Europe are part of our long-term plan to tap into both automotive and non-automotive opportunities in these key markets. We already have customers in these regions, and having a local presence will help us better serve their needs and lay the groundwork for sustained growth over the next 3-5 years." Looking ahead, he added, "Domestically, tractor demand is expected to remain strong, supported by favorable monsoons. On the export front, we're closely watching developments related to US tariffs. While short-term impacts remain uncertain, we remain optimistic about long-term growth prospects in international markets."
