NDA will ensure women's safety in TN, says PM at Tiruchi Rally

Tiruchi, Mar 12:

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday said that women's safety will be ensured if the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) comes to power in Tamil Nadu.

With the Tamil Nadu Assembly elections expected to be announced soon, political parties have intensified their campaign activities across the state. The NDA in Tamil Nadu is led by the All India Anna Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam and includes the Bharatiya Janata Party, Pattali Makkal Katchi and several other parties.

As part of the alliance's campaign, public meetings had already been held in Maduranthagam in Chengalpattu district and Tirupparankundram in Madurai district, where the Prime Minister addressed party workers and supporters.

On Wednesday, another major NDA campaign rally was held at Panchappur in Tiruchy district, where

Modi participated and addressed the gathering.

The Prime Minister was welcomed by AIADMK General Secretary Edappadi K. Palaniswami, AMMK General Secretary T. T. V. Dhinakaran, PMK President Anbumani Ramadoss, Tamil Maanila Congress leader G. K. Vasan, New Justice Party leader A. C. Shanmugam and IJK founder T. R. Paarivendhar along with other alliance leaders.

Tamil Nadu BJP President Nainar Nagendran and party functionaries also welcomed him. The leaders presented Modi with a commemorative plaque featuring Lord Ranganatha of Srirangam.

The meeting began with a welcome address by Nainar Nagendran, followed by speeches

from other alliance leaders.

Modi began his address by greeting the crowd in Tamil, saying "Vanakkam to everyone," before continuing his speech in English, which was translated into Tamil for the audience. **Praise for Tamil culture**

Recalling his visit to the Sri Ranganathaswamy Temple, Modi said he had the opportunity to bow at the feet of Lord Ranganatha, describing it as a divine experience. He also noted that listening to the Kamba Ramayanam in Tamil was a memorable experience that still resonates with him.

The Prime Minister described Tiruchy as a land of courage and hope, recalling the legacy of the Maruthu Brothers and paying tribute to Kargil war hero Major

M. Saravanan. Modi strongly criticised the ruling Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam government in the state, alleging that power is concentrated in a single family and accusing it of corruption.

He said farmers in the Cauvery delta were promised improved minimum support prices and modern grain storage facilities, but those promises had not been fulfilled. He also alleged that illegal sand mining was damaging rivers and the environment. **Women's safety**

The Prime Minister alleged that crimes against women had increased under the DMK government and assured that women's safety would be a priority if the NDA comes to power in the state. He said the alliance would ensure strong law

and order so that women can live without fear.

Highlighting welfare initiatives of the Union government, Modi said more than 570 million bank accounts had been opened under the Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana, with over 320 million accounts belonging to women.

He added that under the Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana, loans worth several lakh crore rupees had been provided to small entrepreneurs, including about Rs 16 lakh crore to women entrepreneurs.

Referring to the ongoing conflict in West Asia, Modi said it had disrupted global energy supply chains but assured that the Indian government would always prioritise the welfare of Indian citizens.

He urged people not to believe

rumours and to rely only on verified information.

Describing the upcoming Assembly election as crucial for Tamil Nadu's future, the Prime Minister said the people must choose between "dynastic politics and false promises" or "development and good governance."

He expressed confidence that the people of Tamil Nadu are seeking change and called upon them to support the NDA to build a prosperous Tamil Nadu and a developed India.

Union Ministers Piyush Goyal and L. Murugan, former Tamil Nadu BJP president K. Annamalai, actor-politician R. Sarathkumar and several other leaders also attended the rally.

Ashok Leyland begins EV battery plant construction

Chennai, Mar 12:

Ashok Leyland, the flagship company of the Hinduja Group and one of India's leading commercial vehicle manufacturers, has commenced construction of a greenfield battery pack manufacturing facility at Pillaipakkam near Chennai in Tamil Nadu.
