Jupiter Wagons Wins Orders Worth Over Rs. 211 Crore from JSW Port Logistics and Orissa Alloy Steel Private Limited

National: August 10, 2026: Jupiter Wagons Limited, a provider of comprehensive mobility solutions encompassing rail, road and marine transportation, has secured two significant orders worth over **Rs. 211 Crore from JSW Port Logistics Private Limited and Orissa Alloy Steel Private Limited (OASPL)**, reinforcing its position as a trusted partner in India's evolving freight logistics sector while strengthening its presence across the private wagon ownership and leasing ecosystem.

Jupiter Wagons has signed a **Rs. 147.11 crore Letter of Intent (LoI) with JSW Port Logistics Private Limited** for the manufacture and supply of **7 BOSM rakes** comprising **329 BOSM wagons**.
