KOTAK MAHINDRA CAPITAL SAYS 150 FIRMS PLAN TO GO PUBLIC

Over \$30 bn set to be raised via IPOs in next 12 months

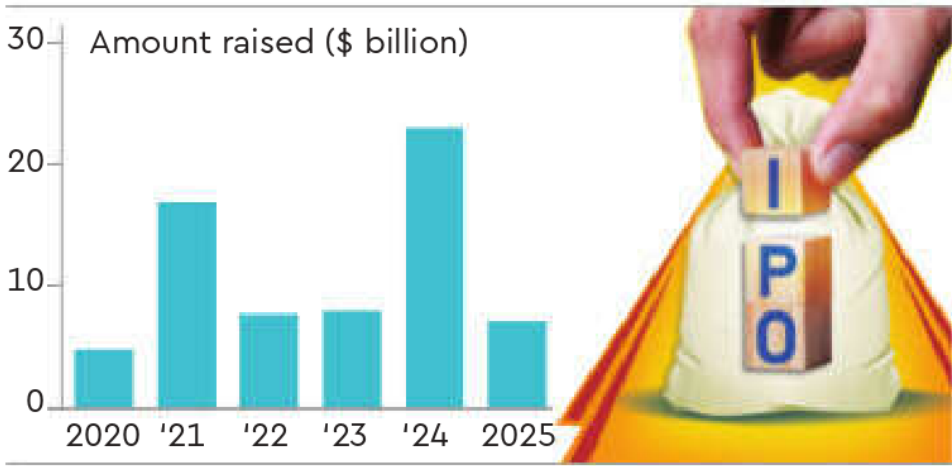

THE BOOM IN Indian initial public offerings (IPOs) is expected to continue, with companies poised to raise over \$30 billion in the next 12 months, according to Kotak Mahindra Capital.

Around 150 firms are planning to tap the equity market, V Jayasankar, head of investment banking at Kotak, the country's top arranger for equity deals this year, said in an interview. "The pace of IPO filings is robust, and it reflects the deepening confidence of issuers in India's capital markets," he said.

India's IPO market had a slow start to the year after a record \$21 billion in 2024. But activity has picked up in recent months. A number of

billion-dollar deals are on their way, with this month's solid debut by HDB Financial Services also boosting sentiment. The shadow lender's \$1.5 billion IPO was India's biggest in 2025.

Overall IPO proceeds for this year stand at \$7 billion, and Jefferies Financial Group expects up to \$18 billion to be raised in the second half.

"It's a reflection of our large, fast-growing economy,"

Jayasankar said. "Even if GDP isn't expanding at 8%, a 6%-plus growth rate still creates significant opportunities for businesses," he said.

Among firms gearing up to enter the market, Tata Capital is planning to raise about \$2 billion. The Indian unit of South Korea's LG Electronics is also looking to raise as much as \$1.7 billion.

While Jayasankar counted India's resilience to external geopolitical uncertainties as well as political stability among factors that should continue to underpin the bullish market sentiment, he also highlighted potential headwinds. A weak secondary market, declining domestic inflows, or a shift in foreign investor interest toward more attractively valued markets like China could challenge the IPO momentum, he said.

BCCI to come under new sports Bill; cricket body in wait-&-watch mode

THE GOVERNMENT IS all set to introduce the National Sports Governance Bill in Parliament on Wednesday, which will bring the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) under its preview along with the 45 National Sports Federations (NSFs). Once the Bill becomes law, the BCCI will have to be recognised by a proposed National Sports Board, sports ministry sources said.

"Like all National Sports Federations, the BCCI will have to comply with the law of the land once this Bill becomes an Act. They don't take ministry fund-

ing but an Act of Parliament applies to them... They will remain an autonomous body like all other NSFs but their disputes, if any, will also come to the

proposed National Sports Tribunal, which will become the dispute resolution body for sports matters ranging from elections to selection," the sources said.

The move is significant because the BCCI is an autonomous sports body registered under the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act, 1975. It is not among the 45 recognised NSFs, which includes major Olympic sports and also indigenous sports like Yoga, Kho-Kho and Atya Patya.

When contacted, BCCI secretary Devajit Saikia said: "The BCCI's official stand is that we

will wait for the Bill to be tabled in Parliament and get more details of its content. Then we will see what has to be followed."

The BCCI has in the past refused to come under the National Sports Federation category as it doesn't take funds from the sports ministry. In recent years, they have also pointed to how they have accepted the Lodha panel reforms on governance, mandated by the Supreme Court, which primarily stipulated that no office-bearer can have a tenure of more than six years at a stretch, with the maximum being nine.

IAF to phase out MiG-21 in Sept

AFTER PROTECTING THE Indian skies through all major conflicts over more than six decades, the legendary MiG-21 fighter jets are set to retire in September.

Sources in the military said the Indian Air Force (IAF) is set to retire the remaining Russian-origin MiG-21 fleet in a ceremonial decommissioning on September 19 at the Chandigarh airbase. Two squadrons of the MiG-21 Bisons are currently active.

India procured more than 700 MiG-21 aircraft of different variants, such as the Type-77, Type-96, BIS and the Bison, since the aircraft's induction into the IAF in 1963.

The phasing out of the aging MiG-21 fleet was originally scheduled to be con-

cluded by 2022, but was held up due to the delay in the planned induction of other fighter jets, including the indigenous Light Combat Aircraft Tejas, which are set to replace the MiG-21 squadrons.

Between 2017 and 2024, at least four MiG-21 squadrons were phased out. India has a sanctioned fighter squadron strength of 42, but has 31 active squadrons. The phasing out of the MiG-21 fleet will further bring down IAF's active fighter squadrons.

The MiG-21 Bison, which comprises the last two squadrons to be retired, is one of India's six fighter jets. The single engine, single-seater multi-role fighter/ground

attack aircraft has been a key fighter jet with the IAF. The Bison is the latest upgrade of the MiG-21 jets. Over 100 MiG-21s of the IAF have been upgraded to Bison in the last nearly three decades.

The MiG-21 Bison upgrades included avionics

and communication systems, electronics, multi-function display cockpits, the Kopyo light-weight multi-mode radar, radio sets, electronic warfare suite, inertial navigation system/GPS, a helmet-mounted display and a better windshield, among others. However, the engine performance and load carrying capacity of the jet could be not enhanced as part of the upgrades, with its airframe being the major limitation.

With a maximum speed of 2,230 km/hr, the jet carries one 23mm twin-barrel cannon with four R-60 close combat missiles. Initially developed as an interceptor, the supersonic jet was eventually upgraded to perform as a multi-role combat aircraft, including ground attacks.
