Parting with Plastic

AS PART of environmental conservation efforts, the Surat Municipal Corporation (SMC) has started a drive under which citizens can give one kilogram of plastic waste and get an idol of Lord Ganesha from collection centres at nine of its zones. The campaign has received an enthusiastic response from the people, officials said. The SMC's Health Committee chairman, Ashok Randeriya, said that since the launch of the drive, in the past seven days, over 1,200 kg of plastic waste has been collected and 750 idols of Lord Ganesha, made of mud, were given to the people. "Keeping in mind more demands from the public, we ordered 500 more such idols," he added.

HC quashes FIR against man accused of deceit after end of relationship with woman

OBSERVING THAT a prolonged consensual relationship cannot simply be treated as one based entirely on a false promise of marriage, the Gujarat High Court has quashed an FIR filed after a nearly two-year relationship between a man and a woman ended.

Justice MR Mengdey of the Gujarat High Court allowed a plea filed by a man from Kutch, seeking quashing of an FIR registered against him under the Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita for "sexual intercourse by employing deceitful means" and the criminal case pending before the Chief Judicial Magistrate of Gandhidham.

According to the FIR, the complainant, a widow in her 30s at the time when the case was registered, alleged that she had been in a relationship with the applicant between June 2023 and April 2025, during which the man had promised to marry her, telling her he would live with her even if their families objected.

The FIR further stated that the two would meet when the woman took her son with special needs to a hospital in the district. The woman also stated that they had, subsequently, travelled together and stayed in several guest houses, and that a ceremony for "tying mangalsutra" had also been held. She had approached the police after the man refused to marry her.

Appearing for the applicant, advocate Jigneshkumar Nayak

argued that the relationship was consensual and that the FIR was lodged only because the proposed marriage had not materialised. He submitted that it was the complainant who had gone to the applicant's house upon her return from Dubai and created a disturbance, prompting his father to approach the police, after which the FIR from the side of the woman also followed. Relying on two Supreme Court rulings, Nayak submitted that "a sourced relationship does not automatically translate into intercourse by deceit".

The state, represented by Additional Public Prosecutor Krina Calla, opposed the plea, contending that the applicant was already married when the relationship began and was therefore aware he could not marry the complainant, yet went ahead and established physical relations with her on a false promise, rendering her consent invalid in law. Advocate Mittal Patel, appearing for the complainant, also opposed the plea, telling the court that investigators had gathered guest house registers showing the applicant had taken the complainant to various loca-

tions "under the garb of marriage."

Examining the FIR itself, the court noted that the complainant had "categorically stated that there was love affair between herself and the applicant," and that she had "consented for physical relations with the present applicant after being promised for marriage". The court observed that the couple had "visited several places together and also stayed together at several guest houses."

Leaning on the Supreme Court's reasoning in a precedent, the HC cited the observation to state: "In a situation where the woman knowingly maintains the physical relationship for a prolonged period, it cannot be said with certainty that the said physical relationship was purely because of alleged promise made by the accused to marry her."

The court further recorded the apex court's finding that "even if it is assumed that a false promise of marriage was made to the complainant initially by the accused, the fact that the relationship continued for... long years would render the plea of the complainant that her consent for all these years was under misconception of the fact that the accused would marry her implausible."

Considering the submissions of the applicant, the HC held that the application "deserves consideration" and allowed it, quashing the FIR and all consequential proceedings arising from it.

CEC Gyanesh Kumar set to visit state on Sept 10-11

CHIEF ELECTION Commissioner Gyanesh Kumar will visit Gujarat on September 10 and 11, his first visit to the state after taking charge as the CEC, officials said on Wednesday.

During his two-day visit, Kumar will interact with prominent citizens, Booth Level Officers (BLOs) and members of Electoral Literacy Clubs (ELCs) as part of the Election Commission's initiative on "Transparency from Roll to Poll", the state Chief Electoral Officer's office said.

Kumar will begin his visit on September 10 by paying homage to Mahatma Gandhi at Sabarmati Ashram and touring the premises. He will later visit the historic Adalaj Stepwell in Gandhinagar as part of a programme highlighting Gujarat's cultural heritage.

In the evening, he will visit the Ahmedabad Management Association (AMA) campus, where he will interact with prominent citizens on the topic 'Conducting elections in India - The largest democracy in the World', according to the note.

On September 11, the CEC will interact with around 500 BLOs from across Gujarat at Atal Kalam Hall on the Gujarat University campus in Ahmedabad. He will later interact with more than 1,000 ELC members in the evening. The programme will include a presentation on the vision, mission and key features of the recently launched ELC 2.0.

All-night inferno in Surat textiles hub destroys cargo meant for Diwali delivery

THE MASSIVE fire that broke out in a sprawling textile trading market in Surat around midnight on Tuesday continued well into Wednesday (September 9) afternoon, destroying huge consignments of finished textiles goods ready for delivery to other states ahead of Dussehra and Diwali.

There were no human casualties in the fire at the multi-storey Shyam Sangini market on the eastern edge of Surat, the country's synthetic textiles capital. The fire spread on the vast stacks of synthetic, plastic, cardboard materials in the market, Fire authorities said.

"The fire began in a passage on the sixth floor of the market and spread in both directions, burning through parcels of fabrics that were packed and kept ready to be shipped. Due to synthetic materials, plastic packing bags, and cardboard boxes, these items burned to ashes. The fire also engulfed shops, burning all textile stocks and furniture in them," Chief Fire Officer of the Surat Municipal Corporation (SMC) Basant Pareekh said.

Fire officers were still carrying out cooling operations, Pareekh said on Wednesday afternoon. One fireman who was injured has been admitted to hospital, he said.

The Shyam Sangini market is a six-storey building with a total of 284 blocks comprising

large shops, each of area around 2,000 sq feet. On Tuesday night, shopkeepers had left the packed fabrics in the passage before leaving for their homes; delivery vehicles were supposed to pick up the consignments later in the night.

"The fire spread to a few shops on the fifth floor as well," Pareekh said. The Fire safety clearance for the market had been renewed recently, and the fire extinguishers were in working order, but the intensity of fire was very high, the officer said.

"Our teams broke the glass windows on the outside of the shops to let out the smoke. It was difficult to enter the fifth floor and sixth floors as the entire passage area was full of thick smoke. More than 150 firemen from the various zones of the SMC were involved in dousing the fire," Pareekh said.

The firefighting operations continued through the night, and the blaze was brought under control after a full 12 hours, he said.

"Cooling activities are pres-

ently in progress. The cause of the fire is still not known," Pareekh said.

Traders who own shops in the market rushed to the complex in the middle of the night hoping to save valuable items and important documents including order and account books and records of business, but were not able to enter, Anoop Jalan, the president of the Shyam Sangini Textile Market Association, said.

Hansraj Jain, president of the Federation of Surat Textile Traders Association, also went to the market. Top SMC officials, along with Mayor Mayaben Mavani and Standing Committee chairman Rajan Patel, visited the market and spoke to the traders.

"For the upcoming Diwali, Navratri, and other festivals, the traders had kept a huge stock of fabrics in the shops and go-downs in the market. The number of shops gutted in the fire and the quantum of loss will be known after the Fire officials complete their work," Jalan said.

2 pvt firm directors get 5-yr jail for cheating govt agency

A CBI court here on Tuesday convicted a Mumbai-based private company and its two senior officials for criminal conspiracy and cheating the National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC), a Grade-A GoI Enterprise under the Ministry of MSME.

The court imposed a fine of Rs 30 lakh on Kushal Diamonds Ltd. and sentenced its Chief Managing Director Bakul Zaveri and Director Mazhar S. Kapadia, to rigorous imprisonment (RI) for five years, said a

statement by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on Wednesday. Both officials were slapped with a fine of Rs 30 lakh each.

The CBI said it had registered the present case against Ahmedabad NSIC officials Virendra Kumar Sawhney, Rohit Dhingra, and Ram Avatar Agarwal (all public servants) on March 15, 2000. All of them were later acquitted in the case.

The statement said, "It was alleged that V.K. Sawhney (then Joint Director), Rohit Dhingra (Joint Manager, Finance) and Ram Avatar Agarwal (then Regional General

Manager) had entered into criminal conspiracy with Directors of Kushal Diamonds Ltd, Mumbai. The investigation revealed that the NSIC had disbursed funds to Kushal Diamonds Ltd., under Bill Disbursement Facility and Raw Material Assistance Scheme to the tune of Rs 2.34 crore. Out of the said amount, funds disbursed but adjusted against past outstanding, payments received by cheque/DD, payments received from overseas buyer and amount of earnest money deposit adjusted were to the tune of Rs 1,34,88,717 and the final outstanding amount from

M/s. Kushal Diamonds Ltd, as on March 31, 1996, was Rs 99,96,364 and the said amount was wrongful loss to NSIC Ltd."

After the trial, all four public servants, Virendra Kumar Sawhney, Rohit Dhingra, Ram Avatar Agarwal and Rajesh Arora were acquitted of the charges leveled against them.

Of the private persons accused in the case, Subhash Chhanana died during the trial and the case against him was abated, while the other two directors of M/s. Kushal Diamonds Ltd were convicted and sentenced by the court.
