CENSUS 2027: HOUSE LISTING FROM JUNE 1

Self-enumeration set to begin in state on May 17

Ahmedabad, May 12

ACCESS TO Internet, smartphone, packaged/bottled water and the main cereal consumed in the household – These are the four new questions introduced in the Census to be conducted after a gap of 15 years that will commence with the self-enumeration of House Listing Operations (HLO) set to begin on May 17 in Gujarat.

For the first time, citizens will be able to fill in the details through self-enumeration with the help of an online portal introduced in the Census that will be conducted digitally this time in 16 languages, including Gujarati, on Android and iOS apps to be held in the state from May 17 till 31, Director of Census Sujal J Mayatra said on Tuesday.

"Every individual is legally bound to provide true and complete information and there is also a provision of penalty-fine or to register an FIR for refusal to provide information," added Mayatra.

Following the household listing Census, the second phase involving population enumeration will be conducted in February next year. The Census was earlier scheduled for April (last month) but was postponed due to the local body elections.

The self-enumeration will be followed by House Listing Operations (HLO) via door-to-door data collection will be done by the appointed Census functionaries from June 1 till June 30, 2026, in Gujarat state through House Listing Mobile Application (HLO App) designed especially for Census field enumeration.

tions to be asked during the House Listing Operations (HLO), access to Internet, smartphone, bottled water and the main cereal consumed in the household are the four new questions which were not there in 2011 census," reiterated Mayatra.

The set of 33 questions include housing status, family details, source of drinking water, toilet facilities and other assets.

The Census includes 1,10,598 House Listing Blocks (HLBs), 1,09,038 enumerators and 18,254 supervisors. Trading is being provided to enumerators, supervisors and other census officers in three phases. Assuring about data security, the Commissioner said that all personal information collected under the provisions of the Census Act, 1948 and the Census Rules, 1990 will be kept confidential and cannot be used for legal or tax purposes.

More than 1.10 lakh personnel, including supervisors and enumerators, would be involved in the exercise across Gujarat's 17 municipal corporations, 34 districts, 268 talukas, 18,117 villages, 197 towns and 17 municipal corporations, the official said.

Each enumerator has 30 days for an estimated 700 to 800 individuals adding that the timeline was adequate for completion of the exercise.

Elaborating on the phases, Mayatra said, "For the first time, citizens will have the opportunity to participate in the Census through the Self Enumeration portal (<https://se.census.gov.in>) introduced by the Government of India. Under this initiative, people can voluntarily submit their details about their houses, amenities available in their household, assets etc online in a simple, secure and convenient manner. This citizen-centric initiative aims to promote digital participation, accuracy and ease in Census operations."

Mayatra also appealed to all citizens to "actively participate and provide accurate information". It was also emphasised that all information collected during Census operations remains strictly confidential

under the provisions of the Census Act, 1948.

The Self enumeration ID received will have to be given during the visit of the enumerator. After confirming the self-enumeration data, the enumerator will include it in the original database. This process will make data collection faster and reduce the burden of manual work, he added.

The 33 questions

The 33 questions divided into sub-questions include type of floor (mud, wood, bamboo, bent brick, stone, cement, mosaic/floor tiles), wall (grass/thatch/bamboo, plastic/polythene, mud, unburnt brick, wood), roof (grass/thatch/bamboo/wood/mud, plastic/polythene, hand-made tiles, machine made tiles, burnt brick, stone, slate, concrete, total number of persons normally residing in this household, SC or ST or other, ownership status of the house, main source of drinking water (tap water from treated source, tap water from untreated source, well, hand pump, tubewell/borewell, spring, river/canal, tank/pond/lake, packaged/bottled water), main source of lighting, access and type of latrine, waste water outlet, bathing facility available within the premises, availability of kitchen and LPG/PNG connection, main fuel used for cooking (firewood, crop residue, cowling cake, coal/lignite/charcoal, kerosene, LPG/PNG, electricity, bio-gas, solar), radio/transistor, television, access to internet, laptop/computer, telephone and mobile phone/smartphone, bicycle and scooter/motorcycle/moped, car/jeep/van, main cereal consumed in the household.

'Harassed' by alcoholic son, Valsad man seeks permission to die with wife, daughter

A 66-YEAR-OLD MAN in Gujarat's Valsad district has approached the local administration seeking permission to die with his wife and specially abled daughter.

Suresh Nayak, a retired Railways employee who now works as a priest, said his 43-year-old son was an alcoholic and had been torturing the three of them. He said the physical and mental harassment had now become unbearable.

A resident of Abrahma in

Valsad town, Nayak approached district collector Bhavya Verma, stating that his son Hemant Nayak (43) had been an alcoholic for 20 years and usually came home drunk and fought with his parents and sister, who is wheelchair-bound.

The sexagenarian said that for the past 20 years, he and his family members had been suffering from Hemant's "torture", and now that it had become unbearable, he stated that despite the police's intervention, Hemant's violent behaviour continued.

Nayak, who originally hails from Nandurbar district in Maharashtra, came to Valsad in 1989 for his Railways job. He stayed here after retirement. He has now requested authorities to either relocate the three of them or allow the three to die.

Valsad collector Bhavya Verma told The Indian Express that deputy superintendent of police AK Verma and another officer were asked to visit Nayak's residence, examine the situation and give a warning to Hemant. "If he continues such behaviour even after the warning,

then we will deal with him strictly and file a criminal complaint."

Valsad DSP AK Verma said, "Suresh Nayak is involved in religious activities. Hemant is his youngest son and has a private job. We have warned him that if he continues to mentally and physically torture his family members, then we will take strict action. We will also send a police team daily for a week or more to check whether his behaviour has changed. His elder brother is also helpless and is a victim of the younger brother's harassment."

Wife's career ambition not cruelty or desertion, says SC

IN A significant verdict, the Supreme Court held on Tuesday that a qualified woman's decision to pursue her career, and ensure a stable and safe environment for her child cannot be branded as "cruelty" or "desertion".

The top court said the "feudalistic" approach of a family court in holding a woman's pursuit of her professional career as a dentist as "cruelty" and "desertion" was "regressive" and "ultra-conservative".

The family court's decision was upheld by the Gujarat High Court.

A bench of Justices Vikram Nath and Sandeep Mehta set aside the "regressive" findings of the courts below and said a wife's professional identity is not subject to an "implied spousal veto".

Deciding the cross-pleas filed by the estranged wife and the husband, the bench took

note of the submissions of the woman that she was no longer hopeful of a patch-up and upheld the decree of divorce granted by the courts below on the ground of an irretrievable breakdown of the marriage and not on the basis of cruelty and desertion by her.

It also took note of the fact that the man has remarried and refused to allow the husband's plea that his wife be prosecuted for the offence of perjury.

It, however, expunged the observations made by the family court against the woman with very strong observations.

"We are well into the 21st century and yet an attempt by a qualified woman to pursue her professional career and to secure a safe and stable environment for the upbringing of her child has been treated as an act of cruelty and desertion by the courts below," Justice Mehta, who authored the verdict, said.

The bench criticised the observations of the family court,

which were affirmed by the high court, and said those are "not only legally unsustainable but also deeply disquieting".

"The endeavour of the appellant to establish her own dental clinic at Ahmedabad, rather than allowing the professional qualification she had earned through years of effort to lie dormant and go waste, has been viewed with disapproval, merely because her stance did not conform to the expectation of the husband and the in-laws that she must abandon her aspirations and reside with her husband at a remote location on account of his posting as an Army officer," the verdict said.

'Caught in vortex,' four drown in river

FOUR PERSONS drowned in a river near the Kakrapar dam in Surat district, police said on Tuesday.

Kaushik Chaudhary (23) took his cattle to the river on Monday morning and did not return till late in the evening, said inspector Jayesh Valvi of Mandvi police station.

His brother, an uncle and a friend found his clothes on the riverbank. Thinking that he might have drowned, they jumped into the river, but were caught in a vortex and drowned themselves, Valvi said.
