Indian Bank Q1 net up 24%, driven by non-interest income

State-run Indian Bank's first-quarter 2025-2026 net profit increased 23.69% year-on-year to ₹2,973 crore driven by growth in non-interest income and lower slippages. Net interest income increased by 2.93% to ₹6,359 crore. Net interest margin declined to 3.23% from 3.44% on repo rate cuts by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). Gross Non-Performing Asset (NPA) slid 76 basis points to 3.01% while Net NPAs declined to 0.18% from 0.39%, the bank said.

Coromandel Intl to add \$8 mn stake in Senegal's BMCC

Coromandel International will buy an additional 17.69% stake for \$7.70 million in Senegalese rock phosphate miner Baobab Mining and Chemicals Corporation (BMCC). This will take its stake in BMCC to 71.51%, the agriculture solutions firm said. The board also approved the setting up of a 3,888 TPD bagging plant at Kakinada facility for ₹137 crore. For the quarter ended June, the firm's consolidated net profit grew 62% to ₹501.59 crore while total income rose 49% to ₹7,126.04 crore.

Canara Bank Q1 net rises 22% as non-interest income grows

Canara Bank reported a 21.69% year-on-year increase in first quarter (FY26) net profit to ₹4,752 crore. The bank said a significant rise in non-interest income drove the growth. The lender's Q1 net interest income fell 1.7% to ₹9,009 crore, however, other income jumped 32.7% to ₹7,060.48 crore. Gross non-performing assets ratio improved to 2.69% from 4.14% while Net NPA ratio bettered to 0.63% from 1.24%.

Centre releases new telecom policy draft

Aims to build quantum-secure communications and develop AI for cyberspace

The government will soon release a new National Telecom Policy, seven years after the last one was put out. The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) on Thursday published the draft text for comment, with a vision statement emphasizing a "telecom product nation that is driven by innovation and that universally connects its citizens meaningfully, securely and sustainably." The terminology is back to "telecom" from 2018's National Digital Communications Policy, with a sector-specific focus on increasing connectivity, modernising the domestic telecom supply chain, and adding 10 lakh jobs in the industry (a fourth of the NDCP's four million target), while "upskilling" existing workers. The policy also emphasises on reducing the sector's carbon footprint by 30% and improving cybersecurity of telecom firms.

manufacturing should increase 150% by 2030, the document states. The draft encourages the use and development of AI specifically for cyberspace, such as in cybersecurity, where AI is touted as both a challenge in offensive terms (such as through generative AI-fueled bots attacking telecom networks), and in defensive strategies, like systems that use AI to detect large attacks and thwart them at an early stage. It also suggests using AI in complaint resolution "through unified portal and use of ... chatbots".

The focus on security is carried on from the 2018 policy, with specific strategies to "monitor Indian and foreign satellites and improve mitigation of satellite carrier interference," and "increasing monitoring ... along the border areas to reduce cross-border spillage". Some of the objectives are activities where work has already begun, such as the mobile number validation service, to allow institutions to verify an individual mobile user's identity.

The "lawful interception" language from the 2018 policy has been eliminated in Thursday's draft, and focuses instead on building quantum-secure communications. On sustainability, the new policy also adds the "circular economy" imperative of recycling materials from telecom equipment in use.

The Centre has also proposed a boost to local research and development (R&D) efforts in telecom, and increased Indian participation in global standardisation discussions, particularly on 6G. Domestic

India U.K. trade deal likely to boost farm export growth by 20%

The India-United Kingdom CETA 'sharpens' India's competitive edge on a number of agricultural and food-related items, according to an official

The government expects the India-U.K. Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA) signed by the two countries on Thursday to lead to substantial benefits for a variety of Indian export-oriented sectors such as agriculture, textiles, leather, chemicals, and engineering goods, according to officials who are aware of the calculations.

Under the deal, the U.K. will benefit from a 12 percentage point average tariff reduction - from the current average of 15% to a new average of 3% - for exports to India. It will see a removal or reduction of tariffs on 90% of the tariff lines, covering 92% of the items currently exported from the U.K. to India.

Among the items that will find cheaper access to the India market from the U.K. are whiskey, items related to aerospace, automobiles and electrical machinery.

The economic and trade deal was signed in the UK by Union Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal and the U.K.'s Secretary of State for Business and Trade Jonathan Reynolds, in the presence of

the Prime Ministers of both the countries.

"In agriculture, India exports \$36.63 billion globally, while the U.K. imports \$37.52 billion, but imports just \$811 million from India, showing room for growth in high-value agri products," a government official said. "Duty-free access is expected to raise agriculture exports by over 20% in next three years."

No sensitive sectors India has not provided the U.K. access to its most sensitive sectors such as dairy products, apples, oats, and edible oils.

"These exclusions reflect India's calibrated trade strategy - one that prioritises food security, domestic price stability, and vulnerable farming

communities," according to the official.

Apart from this, the deal "sharpens" India's competitive edge on a number of agricultural and food-related items, the official explained. For example, in the export of fresh grapes to U.K., the deal provides India an advantage over Brazil and brings it on par with top exporters such as Egypt and South Africa.

In processed food preparations, the deal helps India gain ground on the U.S., China, and Thailand.

"Notably, in the processed food sector, tariffs on 99.7% of lines have been slashed from as high as 70% to zero, offering a major boost for Indian exporters," the official said.

Engineering, textile MSMEs set to benefit

Two major sectors that have a dominant presence of Micro, Small and Medium-scale Enterprises (MSMEs) and are expected to gain immensely from the India-U.K. Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA) are textiles and engineering.

Elimination of tariffs on textiles and garments from the earlier average 12% will remove the duty disadvantage that the Indian exporters faced in the U.K. with competitors such as Bangladesh and Cambodia, said government officials.

The segments poised for exponential growth include ready-made garments, home textiles, carpets, and handicrafts. While the U.K.'s total imports of \$26.95 billion of textile and clothing are lower than India's global exports of \$ 36.71 billion, India still supplies only \$1.79 billion to the U.K.



Ready-made garment exports are likely to get a fillip.

With the CETA promising duty-free access and removal of trade barriers, this sector is well-positioned to increase its footprint in the U.K. market, they said.

In engineering, 1,659 tariff lines have been made duty-free giving a major export boost. The expectation is duty-free engineering goods exports will double in five years to \$7.5 billion by 2029-2030. U.K. is India's sixth largest export market for engineering goods with a growth of 12% in 2024-2025.

Ajay Seth appointed as IRDAI chairman
