This is with reference to our earlier communication dated May 03, 2024, regarding an Order received from the Commercial Tax Officer, CHIDAMBARAM – I, Cuddalore, Tamil Nadu towards GST Assessment conducted for the year 2018-19 for the state of Tamil Nadu to Sudarshan Colorants India Limited (formerly Heubach Colorants India Limited) (“the Company”).

The said Order is appealable and Company is in the process of filing the appeal before the appropriate authority. Hence, we believe that there will not be any material impact on the financial, operation or other activities of the Company due to issuance of the aforesaid Appeal Order.
