SC hears DA contempt appeal

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Tuesday began hearing the Bengal government's appeal against the initiation of contempt proceedings in Calcutta High Court by state employees challenging the state's ban on implementation of the dearness allowance (DA).

A panel of Justices Sunjay Karki and Santosh Kumar Misra, which heard the hearing on Tuesday, will continue on Wednesday.

On June 27, citing financial constraints, the Bengal government approached the Supreme Court for a 'six-month' extension of the deadline fixed by the Central government on the state to pay 25 per cent of dearness allowance within three months' to the government, which had filed the present appeal.

The state has asked the court to stay the DA until the date of the hearing.

The State Government Employees Union, the Kamarhati Paribartan Samiti and others were the three petitioners in the high court.

In view of the high court's decision to stay the state's DA, the central government has directed its employees on the pay commission to deduct 25 per cent of dearness allowance from their salaries.
