This is in continuation to our disclosure made on 14th August 2024, regarding the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (NCLAT), Chennai order wrt. Coffee Day Enterprises Limited vs IDBI Trusteeship Services Ltd - the effect and operation of the impugned order of NCLT Bangalore under section 7 of CIRP has been kept in abeyance.

Further, IDBI Trusteeship Services Ltd approached Supreme Court, and the matter was listed on 31st January 2025 wherein the Supreme Court has directed the concerned NCLAT, Chennai to dispose of the appeal pending before it on or before 21.02.2025. In the event the appeal is not disposed of by then, the impugned order passed by the Appellate Tribunal shall stand vacated automatically.

The appeal is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
