Tata in talks with 3 states for \$300-mn semiconductor unit

Tata group is in talks with three states to invest up to \$300 million to set up a semiconductor assembly and test unit, two sources familiar with the matter said, as part of the conglomerate's push into high-tech manufacturing.

Tata is talking to Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, and Telangana and scouting for land for the outsourced semiconductor assembly and test (OSAT) plant, the sources said, declining to be identified as the matter is not public.

While Tata has previously said it would likely enter the semiconductor business, this is the first time news about the group's foray into the sector and its scale has been reported. An OSAT plant packages, assembles and tests foundry-made silicon wafers, turning them into finished semiconductor chips.

Tata has looked at some potential locations for the factory, one of the sources said, adding a venue was likely to be finalised by next month.

"While they (Tata) are very strong on the software side of things... hardware is something they want to add to their portfolio, which is very critical for long-term growth," the source said.

Tata group and the three states did not respond to requests for comment.

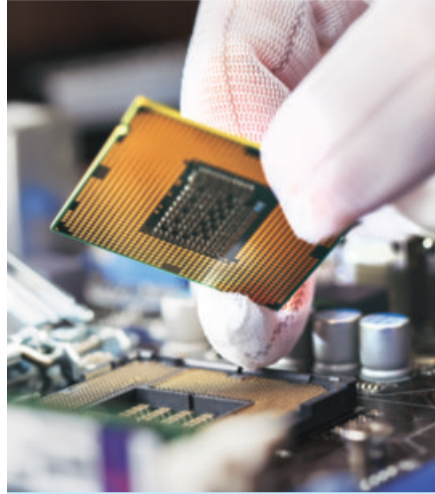
Tata's push will bolster Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Make in India drive for electronics manufacturing, which has already helped turn the South Asian nation into the world's second-biggest maker of smartphones.

The Tata group, which controls India's top software services exporter Tata Consultancy Services and has interests in everything from autos to aviation, plans to invest in high-end electronics and digital businesses, its Chairman N. Chandrasekaran has previously said.

Potential clients of Tata's OSAT business include companies such as Intel, Advanced Micro Devices, and STMicroelectronics.

The factory is expected to start operations late next year and could employ up to 4,000 workers, the source said, adding availability of skilled labour at the right cost was key to the long-term viability of the project. "Once Tata starts, the ecosystem will come around... So it's very critical to find the right place from a labour standpoint," the source said. Separately, Tata is building a high-tech electronics manufacturing facility in Tamil Nadu.

Semiconductor chips are used in a variety of functions, which play a critical part in the

production of internal combustion engines. Besides, they are an integral part of all kinds of sensors and controls in any vehicle. Passenger vehicle sales have been badly hit over the past few months owing to the shortage of semiconductors globally. Industry executives said while there is no certainty how long the shortage will last, they are better prepared to handle production, taking steps like reducing chips in cars.

Birla predicts decade of 'capex mahotsav'

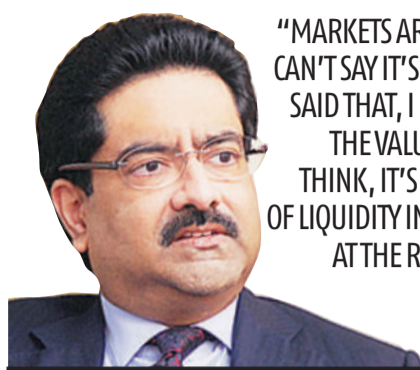
The coming decade will see an upsurge in capital expenditure (capex) across many sectors, said Kumar Mangalam Birla, chairman, Aditya Birla Group, addressing members of the Indian Chamber of Commerce (ICC) on Friday.

"I believe we have upon us a forthcoming decade of capex mahotsav," said Birla.

Birla, who believes that 2021 is the new 1991, shared visible markers of India's journey ahead. Increased capex is one of those and he made mention of both public spending and private sector-led capex.

"On one hand we have public spending, such as the National Infrastructure Pipeline (NIP), whose size at \$1.5 trillion is even larger than what is being undertaken in the US as part of their infrastructure stimulus. The infra plan covers all areas such as roads, ports, airports, waterways, electricity, and telecom. Imagine the impact of an execution pipeline of nearly \$300 billion every year, and what it would do to stimulate economic activity," he said.

But beyond infra push, he pointed out, bank and corporate balance sheets were in healthy shape. "The 'twin balance sheet' problem, with stress caused by excessive bad loans, and over leveraged corporates, is truly behind us. As capacity utilisation has risen, this is the time we will see a private sector led

capex revival, which will persist for several years," he said.

The Aditya Birla group, incidentally, is in the process of investing \$3 billion in the next 12 months across its various companies. Among the key growth drivers of the future for India, he mentioned "silicon and sunshine". Both digital economy (based on silicon chips) and a greening one based on solar, and hydrogen promise to provide tremendously powerful growth drivers to the economy, said Birla.

"A combination of solar and hydrogen has the promise of making India energy independent, or even an energy exporter," he said. "The force of reforms. The force of investment. The force of formalisation. The force of digital and green technology. And the force of youth and entrepreneurship. I am convinced that these five forces will

propel India's rise over the next several decades. India's position as an economic superpower is its inevitable destiny," Birla said.

Unicorn valuation

Responding to a question on valuation of unicorns and start-ups vis-à-vis traditional businesses, Birla said, "Markets are giving you valuations, you can't say it's wrong or it's right. Having said that, I definitely don't understand the valuation the market is giving. I think, it's a product of a huge amount of liquidity in the system and being there at the right place at the right time."

But he said some unicorns were truly delivering new customer proposition, widening the net of people to whom services and goods could be made available to. However, he added, "I see some bubbles in some places."

Ashok Leyland CEO Vipin Sondhi quits

Ashok Leyland — the flagship company of the Hinduja Group — announced on Friday that its managing director (MD) and chief executive officer (CEO) Vipin Sondhi had decided to step down with effect from December 31, citing personal reasons.

Dheeraj Hinduja, chairman of the Chennai-based auto major, has stepped in as the executive chairman of the company with immediate effect to assist in business continuity and ensure a seamless transition. According to a statement by the company, Sondhi expressed his desire to devote more time to take care of personal and family commitments for which he will need to stay in Delhi. Sondhi took charge of the company on

December 12, 2019 and was appointed for five years till December 11, 2024.

The company said the board extended its support to Sondhi's decision "respecting his personal reasons". Sondhi will support and facilitate a smooth management transition. The board will meet soon to identify the next CEO and MD.

"I consider it an honour to have led this great organisation. My decision is purely a personal one as I need to take care of my personal and family responsibilities, which have become a top priority," Sondhi said, adding that working with the Hinduja family and the leadership team at Ashok Leyland had been an enriching experience.

"We have been able to meet all the challenges head-on despite the global pandemic and continue on our growth path," he added.
